CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL,
3 Ply, Art. E.277: 4 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 723 Baby Pink and 1 skein of No. 1 White.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook
No. 3.

3 yards of pink satin ribbon, $\frac{3}{8}$ inch wide and 1 yard, $\frac{5}{8}$ inch wide.

GAUGE: 6 dc make 1 inch; 3 rows make 1 inch.

SACQUE . . . Starting at neck with Pink, ch 59. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, (ch 1, dc in next 3 ch) 18 times; ch 1, 2 dc in last ch. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Dc in first dc, dc in next dc, * ch 1, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc (1 dc increased), dc in next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with 2 dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **4th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 1, dc in next 5 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **5th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **6th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, dc in next 2 dc, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook (1 dc decreased), dc in next 2 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **7th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, dec 1 dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **8th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 2, dc in next sp, ch 2, dc in next dc, dec 1 dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **9th row:** Skip first dc, dec 1 dc, * ch 2, 3 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, dec 1 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with ch 2, dec 1 dc over next 2 dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **10th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, * ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dec 1 dc over next 2 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **11th row:** Skip first dc, (dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in each dc of next group, making 2 dc in first and last dc of group, ch 2) 3 times; holding

back on hook the last loop of each dc, make dc in next dc, skip 8 ch-2 sps for armhole, dc in next dc, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook (joint-dc made), work in pattern across next 5 dc-groups. Complete other armhole and front to correspond. Ch 4, turn. **12th row:** Skip first dc, * dc in each dc of next group, making 2 dc in first and last dc of group, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **13th row:** Skip first dc, * dc in each dc of next group, making 2 dc in first and last dc of group, ch 1, skip next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **14th row:** Skip first dc, * dc in each dc of next group, ch 1. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **15th row:** Work as for last row, increasing 1 dc at center of each dc group. Ch 4, turn. **16th and 17th rows:** Repeat 14th row. **18th to 23rd rows incl:** Repeat last 3 rows 2 more times. Break off at end of 23rd row.

SLEEVE . . . 1st rnd: Attach yarn to joint-dc at base of armhole, ch 4, and work as for 11th row of body of Sacque, making ch-1 sps instead of ch-2, ending with ch 1, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-4. Turn. **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next sp and in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc around, making ch-1 sps over previous ch-1 sps. Join. Turn. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next sp and in next dc, ch 3, dc in same place as last sl st, work as for 13th row of body of Sacque, ending with ch 1. Join to top of ch-3. Ch 4, turn. **4th rnd:** Dc in next dc and work as for 14th row of body of Sacque. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4, sl st in next sp. Turn. **5th rnd:** Sc in same sp, * skip 2 dc, 4 dc in next dc (shell made), skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, skip 1 dc, shell in next dc, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

EDGING . . . Attach White to any sc, * sc in back loop of each dc of next shell, sl st in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. Work other sleeve the same way.

FRONT EDGING AND BEADING . . . Attach White to lower right corner, sc in same place, * ch 2, sc at base of next dc. Repeat from * across front, ending at neck edge, ch 4, ** skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1. Repeat from ** across neck edge, ending with dc in 3rd st from end, ch 4, skip 1 st, sc in next st. Complete other side of front as before. Break off.

FLOWER (Make 8) . . . Cut a strand of White 12 inches long. Holding the single strand along the length of pencil, wind another piece of White around pencil 20 times. Break off. Tie the single strand, slip off pencil, tie knot securely and cut ends of single strand closely.

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply, Art. E.232: 20 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 491 Pearl Grey, and

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) of No. 723 Baby Pink.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook
No. 6.

6 yards of pink satin ribbon, $\frac{5}{8}$ inch wide.

GAUGE: Each motif measures 4 inches in diameter.

FIRST MOTIF . . . Starting at center with Pearl Grey, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 12 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st. **2nd rnd:** Draw loop on hook out to measure $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches, (yarn over, insert hook in same place as sl st, yarn over, draw loop through and out to measure $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches) 3 times; yarn over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 to fasten (puff st made), * yarn over, insert hook in next sc and complete a puff st. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

SECOND MOTIF . . . Work as for First Motif until first rnd has been completed. **2nd rnd:** Make a puff st in same place as sl st, sl st in any sp between puff sts on First Motif, make a puff st in next sc on Second Motif and complete rnd as for First Motif (no more joinings).

Make 6 rows of 8 motifs, joining them as Second Motif was joined to First Motif, having 2 sps free between joinings.

FILL-IN-MOTIF . . . Starting at center with Grey, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, * dc in next sc, ch 2. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sc in next sp, ch 1, sl st in 2nd free sp following joining of any puff st motif, * ch 3, sl st in first free sp following joining on next puff st motif, ch 1, skip next sp on Fill-In-Motif, sc in next sp, ch 1, sl st in next free sp on same puff st motif. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

Work Fill-In-Motifs in this manner in all sps between joinings.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach Grey to first free sp of any corner motif, ch 4, tr in next sp, ch 3, dc in same sp as last tr was made, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in same sp as last dc was made and

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Place Flowers across front of Sacque and sew in place by making a Pink French knot in center of each Flower. Cut a piece of $\frac{3}{8}$ inch ribbon, 1 yard long. Lace through Beading at neck.

CAP . . . Starting at center of back with Pink, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** 6 sc in ring. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, dc in same place as sl st, ch 1, * in next sc make (dc, ch 1) twice. Repeat from * around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, ch 3, dc in same sp, * ch 1, 2 dc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, * 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th, 6th and 7th rnds:** Ch 3, * dc in each dc of dc-group, increasing 1 dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join (6 dc in each group on 7th rnd). Now work in rows as follows: **1st row:** Sl st in next 5 dc, ch 5, (dc in each dc of next dc-group, decreasing 1 dc at center of group, ch 2) 10 times; dc in next dc. Ch 6, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, work as for first row, making ch-3 between dc-groups instead of ch-2, ending with dc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first dc, * dc in next sp, ch 1, work across next dc-group as before, ch 1. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **4th row:** Dc in first dc, * ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, work in pattern across dc-group as before. Repeat from * across, ending with 2 dc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **5th row:** Dc in first 2 dc, * ch 1, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, dec 1 dc over next 2 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last dc, 2 dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **6th row:** Skip first dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, * ch 1, dc in each dc across next dc-group, increasing 1 dc at center, ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **7th row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, * dc in each dc of next dc-group, increasing 1 dc at center of group, ch 1, skip next dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 1, turn. **8th row:** Sc in first dc, in next 3 dc and in next ch-1 sp, * skip 2 dc, 6 dc in next dc, sc in next sp. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in last 3 sc, sc in top of turning chain. Break off.

Attach White to center back of neck and sc closely across to within sc preceding first shell, * sc in back loop of each dc across shell, sl st in next sc. Repeat from * across front, sc closely across other side of back. Join and break off.

Make 11 Flowers as before. Sew across front of Cap. Cut $\frac{3}{8}$ inch ribbon in half. Sew a piece to each side of Cap.

BOOTEE (Make 2)—Sole . . . Starting at center, ch 20 to measure $3\frac{1}{4}$ inches. **1st rnd:** 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in

next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, tr in next 6 ch, 9 tr in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain make tr in next 6 ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, 4 dc in same ch where 3 dc were started. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each st around, increasing as necessary across rounded ends to keep work flat. Join and break off.

UPPER—Instep . . . Starting at bottom, ch 7. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 8th rows incl:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. At end of 8th row, ch 30 for ankle, sl st at opposite end of last row. Now work in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** Sc closely around instep, making 3 sc in each corner, sc in each ch of ankle. Join. Ch 3, turn. **2nd rnd:** Dc in each sc around, making 3 dc in center sc of each corner. Join. **3rd, 4th and 5th rnds:** Dc in each dc around. Join. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 5th rnd.

Pin sole in place. Working through both thicknesses, attach Pink to back and sc closely around. Join and break off.

BEADING AND CUFF . . . 1st rnd: Attach yarn to center back of Bootee, ch 4, * skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1. Repeat from * around, having 18 sps. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4. **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, ch 3, dc in next 5 sts (dc or ch), (ch 2, skip next st, dc in next 6 sts) 4 times; ch 2. Join. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, * dc in each dc of dc-group, decreasing 1 dc at center of group, ch 3. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, * dc in each dc of group, decreasing 1 dc at center of group, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, * dc in each dc of group, decreasing 1 dc at center of group, ch 1, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 3, dec 1 dc over next 2 dc, * ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, work off next 3 dc as 1 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, 2 dc in same place as sl st, * sc in next sp, 4-dc shell in center dc of next dc-group, sc in next sp, shell in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

Attach White to any sc and work edging as before. Make 6 Flowers and sew 5 around cuff of Bootee and 1 to instep. Cut a piece of ribbon $\frac{1}{2}$ yard long, lace through beading and tie into a bow.

MITTEN (Make 2)—Back of Hand . . . Starting at center, ch 15. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch

across, 6 dc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain make dc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. **2nd and 3rd rows:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, increasing 6 dc evenly across rounded end. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 3rd row.

PALM . . . Work exactly as for Back. Holding both pieces together, attach yarn to bottom edge and, working through both thicknesses, sc closely across rounded end. Break off.

BEADING AND CUFF . . . Attach yarn to side at bottom, ch 4, * dc at base of next dc, ch 1, dc in next end dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around, having 18 dc. Complete exactly as for Bootee. Make 3 Flowers and sew in place on front of cuff.

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in next sp, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint-tr made), * ch 3, dc in same sp as last tr was made, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, dc in next sp, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in same sp as last dc was made and in each of next 3 free sps, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (another joint-tr made). Repeat from * around, working corners as before and ending with joint-tr over last 2 free sps. Join to 4th ch of ch-4. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, (4 sc in next sp, sc in next st) 3 times; 4 sc in next sp, 3 sc in next joint-tr (corner), * 4 sc in next sp, sc in next st. Repeat from * around, making 3 sc in each corner joint-tr. Join. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each sc around, making 5 dc in center sc of each 3-sc group. Join to the top of starting ch-3. **4th and 5th rnds:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around, making 5 dc in center dc of each 5-dc group. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 4, * skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * to within next 5-dc group at corner, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, in next dc make (dc, ch 1) twice and dc; ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, complete rnd, working remaining corners as before. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4. **7th and 8th rnds:** Ch 4, * dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around, making (dc, ch 1) twice and dc in center dc at each corner. Join. **9th rnd:** Ch 3, * dc in next sp, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around, making 5 dc in center dc at each corner. Join. **10th and 11th rnds:** Work as for 4th and 5th rnds. Join and break off at end of 11th rnd.

FLOWER (Make 48) . . . Starting at center with Baby Pink, ch 2, in 2nd ch from hook make (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1) 5 times. Join and break off.

Sew a flower to center of each motif. Block to measurements given. Lace ribbon through center row of sps around border. Sew ends securely. Make 2 bows and sew in place.
