

# White Fancy-Work Bib Crochet Pattern



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MATERIALS: 1 skein TLC Amore Baby yarn in White, H hook or hook to obtain gauge, one snap, sewing thread and needle.

GAUGE: 3 sts = 1", 3 rows of pattern = 1-1/2"

FINISHED SIZE: 8-1/2" at widest pt and 18" long. Opening is 4-1/2" across and 6" wide.

BIB:

ROW 1: With yarn and H hook ch-5, sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, dc next ch, sc next ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 2: (Sc, dc) ea st across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 3: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across to last 2 sts, (sc, dc) last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

ROW 5: Rep row 3.

ROW 6: Sk 1<sup>st</sup> st, sc next, dc dec next 2, (sc next, dc next) across to last 4 sts, sk next st, sc next, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 7: Rep row 3.

ROW 8: Rep row 4. (12 sts)

ROW 9: Rep row 3.

ROW 10: Rep row 4. (16 sts)

ROW 11: Rep row 3.

ROW 12: Rep row 4. (20 sts)

ROW 13: Rep row 3.

ROW 14: Rep row 4. (24 sts)

ROW 15: Rep row 3.

ROW 16: Rep row 4. (28 sts)

ROW 17-23: Rep row 3.

ROW 24: Rep row 6. (24 sts)

ROW 25: Rep row 3.

ROW 26: Rep row 4. (28 sts)

ROW 27: (Sc next st, dc next st) 6 times, sl st next 4 sts, rep bet () 6 times, ch-1, turn. (24 sts not counting sl sts)

ROW 28: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, sk next st, sc next, dc dec next 2, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (12 st)

ROW 29: Sk 1<sup>st</sup> st, sc next, dc dec next 2, (sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

ROW 30: (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) twice, sk next st, sc next, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

ROW 31: Rep row 29. (10 sts)

ROW 32: (Sc next st, dc next st) twice, sk next st, sc next, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 33-40: Rep row 3.

ROW 41: (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 42: Rep row 3.

ROW 43: Rep row 41. (10 sts)

ROW 44: Rep row 3.

ROW 45: Rep row 41. (12 sts)

ROW 46: Rep row 3.

ROW 47: Rep row 41. (14 sts)

ROW 48-49: Rep row 3. End row 49 fasten off.

ROW 50: With yarn and H hook join in last st end row 28, ch-1, (sc, dc) same st as beg ch-1, (sc, dc) next st, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, sk next st, sc next, dc dec next 2, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (12 st)

ROW 51-71: Rep row 29-49. End row 71 do not fasten off, ch-1, turn.

RND 72: Evenly sc around entire outer edge of bib and working (sc, ch-2, sc) in ea corner, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.

LACE EDGING:

ROW 1: With yarn and H hook join in end st outside edge of bib, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, (sk 3 sts, ch-4, sc next st) across so that you have 38 lps, turn.

ROW 2: Ch-4 (1<sup>st</sup> dc + ch-1), (dc, ch-1) 4 times in next lp, dc same lp, \* ch-3, sc next lp, ch-6, sl st 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of ch-6, ch-3, sc next lp, ch-3, (dc, ch-1) 5 times next lp, dc same lp, \* rep bet \*\* across ending with ch-3, sl st last lp, fasten off.

Sew snap to back of bib.
