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Ripple Petal Rug
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MATERIALS:

1 skein Red Heart Super saver yarn in White, 1-1/2 skeins in Soft Navy and size J hook or hook to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 3 hdc sts = 1", 2 rows hdc = 1".

FINISHED RUG: about 29" diameter

RUG:

Please note, the rug is worked with 2 strands same color yarn throughout.

With White and J hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, work 12 hdc in ring, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

RND 2-3: (2 hdc next st, hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)(27 sts)

RND 4: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) around, join Navy, fasten off White, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)

RND 5: (2 hdc next st, sk next st, 2 hdc next st, 3 hdc next st) 9 times, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (63 sts)

RND 6: Hdc 1st st, (3 hdc next st, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st) 8 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next st, 2 hdc next, sk next 2 sts, 2 hdc last st, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (81 sts)

RND 7: Hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts) 8 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc last st, join White, fasten off Navy, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (81 sts)

ROW 8: First Petal: Hdc next 2 sts, 3 hdc next, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next, hdc next 2 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 9: Sk 1st st, hdc next 2 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, do not work last st, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 10: Rep row 9. End row 10 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 11-13: Rep row 9. End row 13 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 14-16: Rep row 9. End row 16 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 17-19: Rep row 9. End row 19 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 20-22: Rep row 9. End row 22 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 23-24: Rep row 9. End row 24 fasten off.

SECOND PETAL:

ROW 1: With right side facing you and working counter clock wise, join 1st st left over end 1st petal with White and J hook, ch-1, sk same st as beg ch-1 and next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, hdc last st, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, hdc next st, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, leave last st unworked, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 3: Sk 1st st, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, leave last st unworked, join Navy, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Rep row 2.

ROW 5: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 6: Rep row 2. End row 6 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 7: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 8: Rep row 2.

ROW 9: Rep row 3. End row 9 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 10: Rep row 2.

ROW 11: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 12: Rep row 2. End row 12 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 13: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 14: Rep row 2.

ROW 15: Rep row 3. End row 15 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 16: Rep row 2.

ROW 17: Rep row 3. Fasten off end row 17.

THIRD PETAL:

ROW 1: With right side facing you and working counter clock wise, join 1st st left over end 2nd petal with White and J hook, ch-1, sk same st as beg ch-1, hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (19 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, do not work last st, ch-1, turn. (15 sts)

ROW 3: Sk 1st st, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, do not work last st, join Navy, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Rep row 2.

ROW 5: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 6: Rep row 2. End row 6 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 7: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 8: Rep row 2.

ROW 9: Rep row 3. End row 9 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 10: Rep row 2.

ROW 11: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 12: Rep row 2. End row 12 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 13: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 14: Rep row 2.

ROW 15: Rep row 3. End row 15 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 16: Rep row 2.

ROW 17: Rep row 3. End row 17 fasten off.

FOURTH PETAL:

ROW 1: With right side facing you and working counter clock wise, join 1st st left over end 3rd petal with White and J hook, ch-1, sk same st as beg ch-1, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (15 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, do not work last st, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Rep row 2. End row 3 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 4-6: Rep row 2. End row 6 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 7-9: Rep row 2. End row 9 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 10-12: Rep row 2. End row 12 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 13-15: Rep row 2. End row 15 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 16-17: Rep row 2. End row 17 fasten off.

LAST PETAL:

ROW 1: With right side facing you and working counter clock wise, join 1st st left over end 4th petal with White and J hook, ch-1, hdc sa st as beg ch-1, hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, sl st last st, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Hdc 1st st, 2 hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, join Navy, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Rep row 2.

ROW 5: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 6: Rep row 2. End row 6 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 7: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 8: Rep row 2.

ROW 9: Rep row 3. End row 9 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 10: Rep row 2.

ROW 11: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 12: Rep row 2. End row 12 join White, fasten off Navy.

ROW 13: Rep row 3, no color change.

ROW 14: Rep row 2.

ROW 15: Rep row 3. End row 15 join Navy, fasten off White.

ROW 16: Rep row 2.

ROW 17: Rep row 3. End row 17 fasten off.

EDGING:

RND 1: With Navy (2 strands still) and J hook join in between and petal, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, (Work 6 hdc across 1st White section edge of petal, work 6 dc across next Navy section, work 8 trc across next White section, work 6 dc across next Navy section, work 6 hdc across next White section, work 3 hdc across next Navy section, turn, sc across top of petal. Work 3 hdc across side 1st Navy section, work 6 hdc across next White section, work 6 dc across next Navy section, work 8 trc across next White section, work 6 dc across next Navy section, work 6 hdc across last White section of petal, sc bet this petal and next petal) rep bet () around entire outer edge of rug ending with sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 2: Sc in ea sc, hdc in ea hdc, dc in ea dc, trc in ea trc around working 2 sc in ea turn across top of petal, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.



Rose Ripple Rug

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MATERIALS:

1 skein Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Cloud (white) and 1-2½ skeins in Tutti Frutti and size K hook or hook to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 2 hdc sts = 1", 2 rows hdc = 1"

FINISHED FLOWER: about 24" diameter

RUG:

With Tutti Frutti and K hook and yarn ch-7, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, work 16 sc in ring, sl st top beg sc, do not turn. (16 sts)

RND 2: Ch-1, (dc next st, sk 1 sts, ch-3) 8 times, sl st top beg sc, do not turn. (8 lps made)

RND 3: Ch-1, sl st next ch lp, (dc, 4 trc, dc) in ea lp around, sl st top beg dc, do not turn. (48 sts)

RND 4: Ch-1, working behind the petal (dc in top dc made in rnd 2, ch-4) around, sl st top beg dc, do not turn. (8 lps made)

RND 5: Ch-1, sl st next ch lp, (dc, 5 trc, dc) in ea lp around, sl st top beg dc, do not turn. (56 sts)

RND 6: Ch-1, working behind the petal (dc in top dc made in rnd 4, ch-4) around, sl st top beg dc, do not turn. (8 lps made)

RND 7: Ch-1, (dc, 6 trc, dc) in ea lp around, sl st top beg dc, do not turn. (64 sts)

RND 8: Ch-1, working behind the petal (dc in top dc made in rnd 6, ch-4) around, sl st top beg dc, fasten off, do not turn. (8 lps made)

RND 9: With Cloud (White) and K hook join in any ch lp around, ch-1, work 9 hdc in ea lp around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (72 sts)

RND 10: (3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts) 8 times, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (72 sts)

RND 11: Hdc 1st st, 2 hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, 3 hdc next st, (hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next st, 3 hdc next st) 7 times, hdc last st, join Tutti Frutti, fasten off White, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (88 sts)

RND 12: Hdc next 2 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 4 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (88 sts)

RND 13: 2 hdc 1st st, hdc next st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc last 2 sts, join White, fasten off Tutti Frutti, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (104 sts)

RND 14: Hdc next 2 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 5 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 5 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 5 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc last 3 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (104 sts)

RND 15: Hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st hdc next 2 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc last st, join Tutti Frutti, fasten off White, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (120 sts)

RND 16: Hdc next 4 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 6 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (120 sts)

RND 17: Hdc 1st st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc last 2 sts, join White, fasten off Tutti Frutti, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (136 sts)

RND 18: Hdc next 6 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 7 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc last st, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (136 sts)

RND 19: Hdc sa st as join, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 st, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc last 2 sts, join Tutti Frutti, fasten off White, sl st top beg hdc, sh-1, turn. (152 sts)

RND 20: Hdc next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 8 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 8 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 8 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 8 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (152 sts)

RND 21: Hdc 1st st, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts, (3 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts) 7 times, 3 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts, 2 hdc next st, hdc last 2 sts, sl st top beg hdc, fasten off.

To make the rug larger you continue in the same pattern: Rnd 22 no increase at end join 2nd color. Rnd 23 increase by 1 sts either side of sk 2 sts, etc.



Sunflower Applique
Rug
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MATERIALS:

Lion Brand Homespun yarns: 4 skein Waterfall, 2 skeins Colonial, 1 skein Sunshine State and small amounts of Black and Bridge Red, needle to take yarn and size N hook or hook to obtain gauge.

FINISHED SIZE: 26" X 40-1/2"

Gauge: 2 sc = 1", 2 rows sc = 1"

RUG:

RND 1: With two strands Waterfall and N hook ch-47, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (46 sts)

RND 2-75: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End rnd 75 fasten off.

EDGING:

RND 1: With 2 strands Colonial and N hook join in any st on rug, ch-1, sc sa st as beg ch-1, even sc ea st and end of ea row around working (sc, ch-1, sc) in ea corner st, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (210 sts)

RND 2: Sc ea st around working (sc, ch-1, sc) in ea corner ch-1 sp, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (248 sts)

TRIANGLES:

ROW 1: With 2 strands Colonial and N hook ch-5, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, sc next 3 sts, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 3: Sk 1st st, sc next 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

ROW 4: Sk 1st st, sc next st, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

ROW 5: Sc next st, fasten off.

Make 43 triangles. Keeping a 2" boarder around outer edge of rug sew on triangles alternating point up with point down.

PETAL:

ROW 1: With 2 strands Sunshine State and N hook, ch-2, sc 2nd ch from hook, ch-1, turn.
(1 sts)

ROW 2: Sc, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3-4: 2 sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)(4 sts)

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 6: Sk 1st st, sc next 2 sts, sl st last st, ch-1, turn. (2 sts + 1 sl st)

ROW 7: Sk sl st, sc next st, sl st next st, ch-1, turn. (1 st + 1 sl st)

ROW 8: Sk 1st sl st, sc next st, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

ROW 9: Sc, fasten off.

Make 24 petals. Arrange petals in three groups of eight on rug in a circle and sew to secure.

FLOWER CENTER:

With 2 strands Black and N hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, work 6 sc in ring, join Bridge Red, sl st top beg sc, do not turn, fasten off black. (6 sts)

RND 2: 2 sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (12 sts)

Make three centers. Sew one in ea center of flowers on rug.





Loop Flower Rug
By
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MATERIALS: Red Heart 4 ply yarn in the following: 4-6oz skeins Wedgwood, 1-8oz skein Rose Pink, 1-8oz skein Soft White and 4oz of Country Rose, Needle to take yarn, and size H hook or hook to obtain gauge.

FINISHED SIZE: 28" X 31"

Gauge: 4 hdc = 1", 3 rows hdc = 1", 3 rows hdc and 3 rows lp = 1"

RUG CENTER:

ROW 1: With Rose Pink and H hook ch-82, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (80 sts)

ROW 2-58: Hdc ea st across, ch-2, turn. At the end of row 58 fasten off.

LOOP SIDE STRIP (MAKE TWO):

Row 1: With Wedgwood and H hook ch-17, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, turn. (15 sts)

ROW 2: Sl st next st, (ch-8, sl st next 2 sts) across, turn. (7 lps)

ROW 3: Press lps to back of work, ch-2, hdc ea st across, turn.

ROW 4: (sl st next 2 sts, ch-8) across, sl st last st. (7 lps)

ROW 5: Rep row 3.

ROW 6-105: Rep row 2-5. At the end of row 105 fasten off.

With needle and yarn sew one strip to ea side of rug.

TOP STRIP:

ROW 1: With rt side of rug facing you and working across long side of rug join Wedgwood in 1st st, (ch-8, sl st next 2 sts) across, turn. (56 lps)

ROW 2: Press lps to back of work, ch-2, hdc ea st across, turn. (110 sts)

ROW 3: (Sl st next 2 sts, ch-8) across, sl st last st, turn. (56 lps)

ROW 4: Rep row 2.

ROW 5: Sl st next lp, (Ch-8, sl st next 2 sts) across, turn. (56 lps)

ROW 6-22: Rep row 2-5.

ROW 23: Rep row 2, fasten off.

BOTTOM STRIP:

Rep as you did for the top of the rug across the bottom.

PETAL:

ROW 1: With white yarn and H hook ch-2, sc 2nd ch from hook, turn. (1 st)

ROW 2: Ch-8, sl st in st, turn.

ROW 3: Press lp to back of work, Ch-1, 2 sc in st, turn. (2 sts)

ROW 4: * Ch-8, sl st next st * rep bet ** across, turn.

ROW 5: Press lps to back of piece, ch-1, sc next st, 2 sc next st, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 6: Rep row 4.

ROW 7: Press lps to back of piece, ch-1, 2 sc next st, sc ea st across, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 8: Rep row 4.

ROW 9: Press lps to back of work, ch-1, sc across, turn.

ROW 10: Rep row 4.

ROW 11: Press lps to back of piece, sk 1st st, ch-1, sc ea st across, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 12: Rep row 4.

ROW 13: Press lps to back of work, ch-1, sc next st, sk next st, sc next st, turn. (2 sts)

ROW 14: Rep row 4.

ROW 15: Press lps to back of work, ch-1, sk next st, sc last st, fasten off. (1 st)

-Make six petals for ea flower. 5 flowers = 30 petals

CENTER:

With Country Rose yarn and H hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, work 8 sc in ring, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

RND 2: *Ch-8, sl st next st * rep bet ** around, turn.

RND 3: Press lps to back of piece, ch-1, 2 sc in ea st around, sl st top beg sc, turn. (16 sts)

RND 4: Rep rnd 2,

RND 3: Press lps to back of piece, Ch-1, sc next st, (2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) around, fasten off. (21 sts)

-Make 1 for ea of the 5 flowers.

With needle and matching yarn sew to center portions of the rug forming flowers.



Flower Bath Rug
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What's so nice about this bath rug is the ease of being able to launder it frequently.

MATERIALS:

6 ozs Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Aquamarine, 6 ozs Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Cloud (white), 6 ozs Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Blue sky, J10\6.00mm size hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle, matching thread.

FINISHED SIZE: 25" x 34 1/2"

Gauge: 1 square = 9" X 9"

SQUARE FOR RUG:

CENTER: With J10\6.00mm hook and color A yarn ch-4, sl st to form a ring, ch-1, 15 sc in ring, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (15 sts)

PETAL:

With J10\6.00mm hook and color B yarn, join in any st on center, ch-3 (1st dc), 4 dc sa st, turn, ch-3 (1st dc), work 1 dc in the top of ea st keeping last lp of ea st on hook, yo and pull through all lps on hook, ch-1 to close, fasten off.

Sk 2 sts on center and rep Petal for a total of 5.

BLOCK:

RND 1: With J10\6.00mm hook and Cloud yarn join in top st of any petal, ch-1, sc sa st as beg ch-1, * Ch-4, trc in any st on center bet this petal and the next, ch-4, sc top st next petal, rep from * around ending with a sl st in beg st top 1st petal, ch-1, turn.

RND 2: Sl st to next ch-4 lp, ch-1, * 5 sc in lp, sc top next trc, sc in next lp, sc top next sc, rep from * around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (60 sts)

RND 3: * Sc next 13 sts, 2 sc next st, ch-2, 2 sc next st, rep from * around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (68 sts)

RND 4: Sc ea st around working (sc, ch-2, sc) in ea ch-2 sps, join Color A, sl st top beg sc, fasten off Cloud, ch-1, turn. (76 sts)

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RND 5: Sc ea st around working (sc, ch-2, sc) in ea ch-2 sps, join color B, sl st top beg sc, fasten off A, ch-1, turn. (84 sts)

RND 6: Sc ea st around working (sc, ch-2, sc) in ea ch-2 sps, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (92 sts)

Make 6 blocks with Blue sky center, Aquamarine petals, rnd 1-4 in Cloud, rnd 5 in Blue sky and rnd 6 in Aquamarine.

Make 6 blocks with Aquamarine center, Blue sky petals, rnd 1-4 in cloud, rnd 5 in Aquamarine and rnd 6 in blue sky.

With needle and matching thread sew the blocks tog in 3 rows of 4 blocks alternating blocks.





Bonus Pattern:
Flower Bath Pillow-Pad

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What's so nice about this bath pillow is the ease of being able to launder it frequently.

MATERIALS:

6 ozs Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Aquamarine, small amount Red Heart Baby Clouds yarn in Blue sky, J10\6.00mm size hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle, matching thread, 3 small suction cups.

FINISHED SIZE: Bath pillow: 14"x 15"

Gauge: 3 sts = 1"

BATH PILLOW:

With J10\6.mm hook and Blue sky yarn ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, 12 sc in ring, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

RND 2: (2 sc next st, sc next st) 4 times, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

RND 3-4: (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (20 sts)(25 sts)

RND 5: Sc next st, (2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) 8 times, join Aquamarine yarn, sl st top beg sc, fasten off Blue sky yarn, ch-1, turn. (33 sts)

RND 6: (2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (44 sts)

RND 7: (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (55 sts)

RND 8: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 9: (2 sc next st, sc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (66 sts)

RND 10: 2 sc next st, (2 sc next st, sc next 4 sts) 12 times, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (80 sts)

RND 11: Rep rnd 8.

RND 12: (Sc next 2 sts, hdc next 2, dc next st, 2 dc next st, dc next st, 2 trc next 2 sts, dc next st, 2 dc next st, dc next st, hdc next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts) 5 times, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (100 sts)

RND 13: (Sc next 2 sts, hdc next 2, dc next st, trc next 10, dc next st, hdc next 2, sc next 2) 5 times, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 14: (Sc next 2 sts, hdc next st, dc next st, 2 dc next st, trc next 2, 2 trc next st, trc next st, 2 trc next 2, trc next st, 2 trc next st, trc next 2, 2 dc next st, dc next st, hdc next st, sc next 2) 5 times, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (130 sts)

With needle and matching thread sew the three suction cups center top three petals on bath pillow. This will allow the "pillow" to stick to the both tub. If the suction cups you happened to have bought do not have a hole through the back you can easily make one using the point of a metal compass.

MATERIALS:

16 oz. Skipper Blue 4 ply Red Heart yarn, 4 oz. Light Blue 4 ply Red Heart yarn, J crochet hook or hook needed to obtain gauge.

FINISHED SIZE: 26" X 26"

Gauge: 3 hdc = 1", 2 rows hdc = 1"

RUG:

PLEASE NOTE: The rug is made using two strands of 4 ply yarn. Beg ch-2 in ea rnd does not count as a st.

With Light Blue yarn and J hook, ch-5, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-2, work 12 hdc in ring, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (12 sts)

RND 2: (Hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (16 sts)

RND 3: Hdc next st, (hdc next 2 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (21 sts)

RND 4: Rep rnd 2. (28 sts)

RND 5-7: Rep rnd 3. (37 sts) (49 sts) (65 sts)

RND 8: (Hdc next 4 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (78 sts)

RND 9: Hdc ea st around, join Skipper Blue, fasten off Light Blue, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn.

RND 10: (Hdc next 5 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (91 sts)

RND 11: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn.

RND 12: (Hdc next 6 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (104 sts)

RND 13: Rep rnd 11.

RND 14: (Hdc next 7 sts, 2 hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-2, turn. (117 sts)

RND 15: Rep rnd 11.

RND 16: Hdc next 5 sts, (hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st) 5 times, (hdc next 7 sts, 2 hdc next st) 9 times, (hdc next 3 sts, 2 hdc next st) 5 times, sl st top beg hdc, DO NOT FASTEN OFF, ch-2, turn. (136 sts)

1ST PETAL:

ROW 1: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 13 sts, hdc dec next 2 sts, leaving the rest of the sts unworked and you are now working in rows, ch-2, turn. (15 sts)

ROW 2-5: Hdc ea st across, ch-2, turn.

ROW 6-9: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across, ch-2, turn. At the end of row 9 you will have 11 sts.

ROW 10: Hdc ea st across, ch-2, turn.

ROW 11: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 7 sts, hdc dec last 2 sts, fasten off. (9 sts)

NEXT PETAL:

ROW 1: Join Skipper Blue yarn in next st after last st of row 1 of last petal made, ch-2, hdc dec sa st as ch-2 and next st, hdc next 13 sts, hdc dec next 2 sts, leaving the rest of the sts unworked, ch-2, turn. (15 sts)

ROW 2-11: Rep row 2-11 of 1st petal.

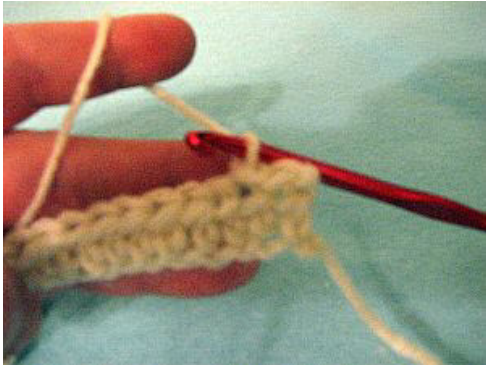
FINISHING:

With Skipper Blue yarn and J hook, join in any st in any petal of flower rug, ch-1, evenly sc in ea row and st around entire flower, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.

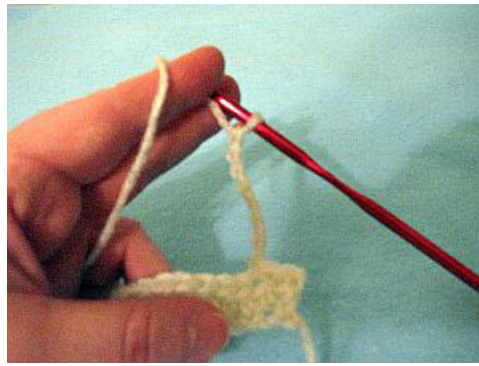

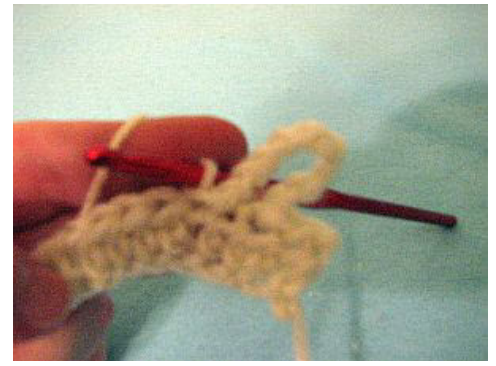
How To Make The Chain Loop Stitch Used In Loop Flower Rug

the loop



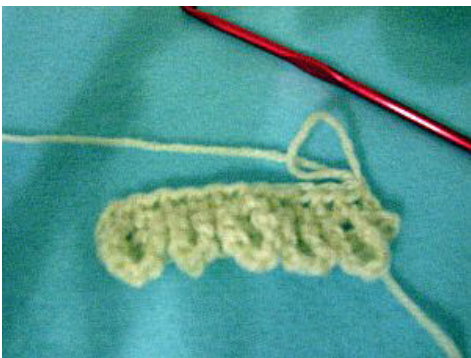
This is how a completed row

back of your work.



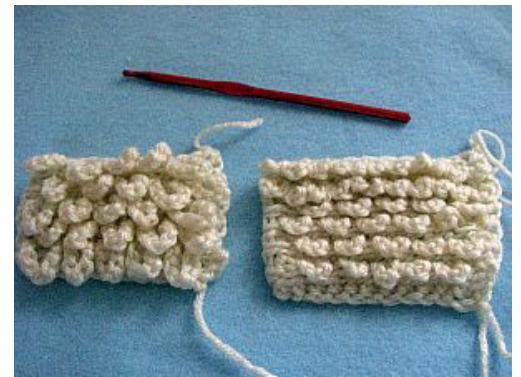
A solid row of stitches have
