Snowman Rug Free Crochet Pattern

# MATERIALS:

2 skeins ea worsted weight Red Heart yarn in: Light Sage, Frosty Green and White, small amount of burgundy and Royal Blue 4 worsted yarn, small amount of brown and orange felt, black fabric paint, H crochet hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle to take yarn, White snowflake sequins and no-sew glue.

<u>Gauge:</u> 4 sts (sc, 5 dc shell) = 3", 4 rows of pattern = 3", sc, dc sts = 1", 4 rows sc, dc = 1"

## **RUG SECTION:**

<u>ROW 1:</u> With Lt Sage and H hook ch-43, dc 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc same ch as beg dc, (sk 2 ch, sc next ch, sk 2 ch, 5 dc next ch) across to last 3 ch, sk 2 ch, sc last ch, join Frosty Green, ch-3, turn, fasten off Lt Sage.

<u>ROW 2:</u> 2 dc 1<sup>st</sup> st, (sc 3<sup>rd</sup> dc of 5 dc shell, 5 dc next sc) across working sc top beg ch-3 of previous row, join Lt Sage, ch-3, turn, fasten off Frosty Green.

<u>ROW 3:</u> 2 dc 1<sup>st</sup> st, (sc 3<sup>rd</sup> dc of 5 dc shell, 5 dc next sc) across working sc top beg ch-3 of previous row, join Frosty Green, ch-3, turn, fasten off Lt Sage.

<u>ROW 4-26:</u> Rep row 2-3 alternating as established.

**RND 27:** Rep row 2, at the end of the row do not join next color continue working in Frosty Green, turn so you will now be working across the side of piece, \* (5 dc around ch-3 of end row, sk next row, sc in next ch-3, sk next row) across side ending with 5 dc last row; turn so you are now working across the bottom of the foundation row of row 1, (sk 2 ch, sc next ch, sk 2 ch, 5 dc next ch) across ending with sc last ch, \* rep bet \*\* twice, ending with 2 dc same st as beg 2 dc, sl st top beg ch-3, ch-1, turn.

<u>RND 28:</u> Sc same st as ch-1, \* 5 dc next sc, sc 3<sup>rd</sup> dc of 5 dc shell) 6 times, sk next dc, (5 dc next st, sc next sc, 5 dc next dc, sk next dc, sc next st), rep bet \*\* 6 times, rep bet (), rep bet\*\* 6 times, rep bet (), rep bet \*\* 6 times, rep bet (), end with sl st top beg sc, turn.

<u>RND 29:</u> Ch-3, 2 dc same st, (sc 3<sup>rd</sup> dc 4 dc shell, 5 dc next sc) around ending with 2 dc same st as beg 2 dc, sl st top beg ch-3, turn.

<u>RND 30:</u> Ch-1, sc same st as join, \* 5 dc next sc, sc 3<sup>rd</sup> dc of 5 dc shell, \* 6 times, (sk next dc, 5 dc next dc, sc next, 5 dc next, sc next) twice, rep bet \*\* 6 times, rep bet () twice, rep bet \*\* 6 times, rep bet () twice, rep bet \*\* 6 times, rep bet () twice, rep bet sc, fasten off.

-Make three then reverse the colors (Frosty Green for Sage) and make three more. With needle and Frosty Green yarn, sew two rows, three blocks ea, alternating colored blocks. Sew the rows tog to form the rug.

### Snowman (MAKE 6):

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White yarn and H hook ch-7, sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, dc next ch, (sc next ch, dc next ch) across, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

<u>ROW 2-5:</u> (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)(10 sts)(12 sts)(14 sts) <u>ROW 6-7:</u> (Sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn.

<u>ROW 8-9:</u> Sc next st, dc dec next 2 sts, sk next st, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)(10 sts) <u>ROW 10-13:</u> (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)(14 sts)(16 sts)(18 sts) <u>ROW 14-16:</u> (Sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 17-18: Sc next sc, dc dec next 2 sts, sk next st, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)(14

sts)

<u>ROW 11-26:</u> (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)(18 sts)(20 sts)(22 sts)(24 sts)(26 sts)(28 sts)(30 sts)

ROW 27-32: (Sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 33-34: Sc next sc, dc dec next 2 sts, sk next st, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across, ch-1, turn. (28 sts)(26

sts)

<u>ROW 35:</u> (Sc next dc, dc next sc) across, fasten off.

With needle and white yarn sew one snowman to one rug block allowing the snowman to overlap the edges.

### LONG SCARF SECTION:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With yarn and H hook ch-3, sc  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (2 sts) <u>ROW 2-11:</u> Sc next st, dc next sc, ch-1, turn.

ROW 12: (Sc, dc) next sc, dc next st, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

<u>ROW 13:</u> Sc next st, dc next st, (sc, dc) last st, ch-1, turn. (4 sts) <u>ROW 14-23:</u> (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. <u>ROW 24:</u> (Sc, dc) next st, sc next st, dc next 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (5 sts) <u>ROW 25:</u> (Sc next st, dc next st) twice, (sc, dc) last st, fasten off. (6 sts) -Make 3 in burgundy and 3 in blue

#### SHORT SCARF SECTION:

Rep row 1-5 of long section. <u>ROW 6:</u> Rep row 12 of long section. <u>ROW 7:</u> Rep row 13 of long section. <u>ROW 8-9:</u> (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. <u>ROW 10:</u> Rep row 24 of long section. <u>ROW 11:</u> Rep row 25 of long section. -Make 3 in burgundy and 3 in blue. With needle and matching yern says the long searf of

With needle and matching yarn sew the long scarf section along snowman's neck and trailing out onto the rug. Rep with short section attaching it to the long section to form the scarf.

With no-sew glue, randomly glue snowflake sequins to the rug. With the fabric paint make 2 eyes for ea of the snowmen and cut out of felt and glue buttons and a noses to them as well.
