

# Pumpkin Garland Free Crochet Pattern



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**MATERIALS:** 4 ply yarn in the following colors: Pumpkin, Coffee, Frosty Green, Light Sage, Claret and Gold, H crochet hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle to take yarn, About 10 yds 20 gauge craft wire, wire cutters, pliers, stuffing, needle and thread.

**FINISHED SIZE:** Small Pumpkin: 2" X 3"; Tall Pumpkin: 3" tall X 2" wide; Large Leaf 3" X 5"; Small Leaf 2-1/4" X 3". Finished vine is 3' long.

**Gauge:** 4 sts (sc, dc) = 1", 4 rows pattern = 1"

#### SMALL PUMPKIN:

With Pumpkin yarn and H hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

**RND 1:** Ch-1, (sc, dc) 5 times in ring, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

**RND 2:** (Sc, dc) ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (20 sts)

**RND 3:** \* Sc next dc, dc next sc, (sc, dc) next 2 sts, \* rep bet \*\* around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (30 sts)

**RND 4-7:** (Sc next dc, dc next sc) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

**RND 8:** (Sc next dc, dc next sc, sc next dc, dc dec next 2 sts, sk next st) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (20 sts)

**RND 9:** (Sc next dc, dc next sc, sc next dc, dc dec next 2 sts) 3 times, sc next st, dc last st, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

**RND 10:** (Sk next st, sc next 2 sts) 4 times, sk next st, sc last st, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (9 sts)

-Make 3

#### STEM:

**ROW 1:** With Lt sage and H hook ch-6, sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (5 sts)

**ROW 2:** Working in back lps only, sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

**ROW 3-8:** Back lp sc across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 8 fasten off.

#### FINISHING PUMPKIN:

Stuff pumpkin body firmly. Beg at short end of stem roll to form a log. Stick log (stem) inside pumpkin at opening. With needle and pumpkin yarn sew stem to pumpkin. With needle and pumpkin yarn, make side sections in pumpkin by inserting needle through inside top of pumpkin to bottom, pull yarn through and up side and down again by stem. Rep to make 5 or 6 sections on the pumpkin.

#### TALL PUMPKIN:

Rep row 1-2 of small pumpkin.

**ROW 3-8:** (Sc next dc, dc next sc) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

**ROW 9:** Rep row 9 of small pumpkin.

**ROW 10:** Rep row 10 of small pumpkin.

Finishing as you did for small pumpkin.

-Make 3

#### SMALL LEAF:

**ROW 1:** With yarn and H hook ch-2, sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

**ROW 2:** Sc only st, ch-1, turn.

**ROW 3-5:** (Sc, dc) ea st across, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)(4 sts)(8 sts)

**ROW 6-7:** Dc dec next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) to last 2 sts, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)(4 sts)

**ROW 8:** (Dc dec next 2 sts) twice, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

**ROW 9:** Dc dec next 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

**ROW 10:** Sc only st, ch-1, turn.

**RND 11:** Cut a piece of wire that will roughly go around leaf, sc over wire in evenly around outside edges of leaf working 2 sc in ea corner, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. With pliers twist ends of wire tog and to lay flat.

-Make: 2 Lt Sage, 3 Frosty Green, 5 Coffee, 6 Claret and 6 Gold.

LARGE LEAF:

Rep row 1-5 of small leaf.

ROW 6: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next dc, dc next sc) across to last 2 sts, (sc, dc) last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

ROW 7-10: \* Dc dec next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) to last 2 sts, dc dec last 2 sts, \* rep bet \*\* across, ch-1, turn.  
(10 sts)(8 sts)(6 sts)(4 sts)

ROW 11: Rep row 8 of small leaf. (2 sts)

ROW 12: Rep row 9 of small leaf. (1 st)

ROW 13: Rep row 10 of small leaf.

RND 14: Rep rnd 11 of small leaf.

-Make 6 Lt Sage and 7 Frosty Green.

STEM:

With Coffee yarn and H hook ch-3, sl st to from a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, work (Sc, dc) 3 times in ring, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

RND 2: (Sc next dc, dc next sc) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

Rep rnd 2 until piece measures 3' long. Cut two 3-1\2' lengths of wire and twist tog into one. Slide wire inside vine.

LAST RND: (Dc dec next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg dc, fasten off.

FINISHING:

Lay vine across a flat surface. Beg arranging pumpkins and leaves in a pleasing manner, overlapping small leaves over large leaves and setting remaining small leaves aside. With needle and thread (I used invisible thread) secure pieces to vine. Now go back and fill in with the small leaves securing as before. Bend leaves to make the vine look more life-like.
