Black & White Pansy Outfit For American Girl Size Dolls Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: Two 150 yd balls size 10 crochet thread in White and 1 in Black, size E & 7 crochet hook or hook to obtain gauge, needle to take crochet thread, 3 small snaps, 20" of 1\8" wide black ribbon, sewing needle and sewing thread.

GAUGE: E hook: 12 sc-dc combination sts = 2", 6 rows pattern = 1". 7 Hook: flower is 1".

FINISHED SIZE: Will fit 18" American Girl doll or look alike doll.

DRESS:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and F hook ch-65, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (64 sts)

ROW 2-6: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 7: (Sc next st, dc next st) 8 times, * (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 7 times, * rep bet ** 3 times, ch-1, turn. (70 sts)

ROW 8-12: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 13: (Sc next st, dc next st) 7 times, * (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 6 times, * rep bet ** 4 times, ch-1, turn. (78 sts)

ROW 14: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 15: (Sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, * (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, * rep bet ** 9 times, ch-1, turn. (96 sts)

ROW 16-19: Rep row 14.

RND 20: Overlap 1st 2 sts with last 2 sts of rnd, work sc through both thickness' then dc through both thickness' next st, (sc next st, dc next st) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (94 sts)

RND 21-65: (Sc next dc, dc next st) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 65 fasten off.

DRESS TOP:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and E hook join in bottom 1st st row 1 of dress, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, dc next, (sc next, dc next) 7 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 2-7: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 8: (Sc next st, dc next st) 4 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 9-10: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 10 fasten off.

<u>ROW 11:</u> With White and E hook join bottom other end of dress, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, dc next, (sc next, dc next) 7 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

ROW 12-20: Rep row 2-10. Fasten off end row 20.

<u>ROW 21:</u> Sk 4 sts from end row 1 of dress top, join next st, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, dc next, (sc next, dc next) 11 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (24 sts)

ROW 22-32: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 33: (Sc next st, dc next st) 4 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 34-35: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 35 fasten off.

<u>ROW 36:</u> With White and E hook join last st end row 32, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, dc next st, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 37-38: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 38 fasten off.

With needle and crochet thread sew tog at shoulders.

SLEEVE (MAKE 2):

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and E hook ch-7, sc 2nd ch from hook, dc next ch, (sc next ch, dc next ch) across, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 2-7: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)(10 sts)(12 sts)(14 sts)(16 sts)(18 sts)

ROW 8-11: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across to last 2 sts, (sc, dc) last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (22 sts)(26 sts)(30 sts)(34 sts)

ROW 12-13: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 14-15: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)(38 sts)

ROW 16-32: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 32 fasten off.

SLEEVE RIBBING (MAKE 2):

ROW 1: With White and E hook ch-7, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, join Black, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Sc ea st across, join White, fasten off Black, ch-1, turn.

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 6-43: Rep row 2-5.

ROW 44: Sc ea st across, fasten off.

BLACK SLEEVE UNDERLAY (MAKE 2):

<u>ROW 1:</u> With Black and E hook ch-39, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (38 sts)

ROW 2-3: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 3, fasten off.

PUTTING SLEEVE TOGETHER:

Sew Black Underlay to the bottom edge of the Ribbing over lapping slightly. Sew this completed section to the bottom edge of sleeve, again over lapping slightly. Sew long edges of sleeve tog-row 13-32. Pin the upper part of the sleeve into the armhole on dress matching center top and center bottoms, sew right sides tog. Rep for other sleeve.

DRESS HEM EDGE RIBBING:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and E hook ch-9, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, join Black, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Sc ea st across, join White, fasten off Black, ch-1, turn.

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 6-103: Rep row 2-5.

ROW 104: Sc ea st across, fasten off.

BLACK HEM EDGE UNDERLAY:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With Black and E hook ch-95, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (94 sts)

ROW 2-4: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 4, fasten off.

PUTTING EDGING ON HEM:

Sew Black Underlay to the bottom edge of the Ribbing over lapping slightly. Sew short ends tog to form a tube. Sew this completed section to the bottom edge of dress, again over lapping slightly.

WAIST RIBBING:

With White and Black threads and 7 hook rep row 1-76 of hem ribbing, fasten off.

BLACK WAIST UNDERLAY:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With Black and E hook ch-75, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (74 sts)

ROW 2-4: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 4, fasten off.

WHITE WAIST OVERLAY:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and E hook ch-5, sc 2nd ch from hook, dc next, sc next, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 2-51: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 51 fasten off.

PUTTING WAIST TRIM TOGETHER:

Sew the Black Underlay to the bottom edge of the Ribbing over lapping slightly. Sew this completed section to the

White overlay, again over lapping slightly. Sew this completed trim around dress at just below the sleeves.

COLLAR:

<u>ROW 1:</u> With White and E hook ch-5, sc 2nd ch from hook, dc next, sc next, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 2-41: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 41 fasten off.

With needle and crochet thread sew collar around neck edge. With needle and thread, sew 3 snaps down back opening of dress. Cut "of ribbon and sew around collar's base where collar meets dress. Find center of remaining ribbon and tie a bow. Tack bow to back of dress at collar.

FLOWER:

With Black and 7 hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: (Ch-3, 2 dc, ch-3, sl st) in ring 3 times, join White, fasten off Black, (ch-4, 3 trc, ch-4, sl st) in ring twice, do not turn.

<u>RND 2:</u> (Ch-3, work 3 hdc in next dc on next petal (black petal), 3 hdc next dc, ch-3, sl st bet next two petals) 3 times, fasten off.

-make 13 flowers for dress hem, 12 flowers (6 ea sleeve) for sleeves and 8 flowers for waist. Sew around respective parts above ribbing.

SHOE (MAKE 2):

<u>RND 1:</u> With Black and E hook ch-10, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc next 6 ch, 3 hdc last ch, turn piece so you are now working across the bottom of the foundation ch (in bottom of sts just made), hdc next 6, 2 hdc last, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)

RND 2: 2 hdc next 2 sts, hdc next 6, 2 dc next, 3 dc next, 2 dc next, hdc next 6, 2 hdc last st, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (25 sts)

RND 3: 2 hdc next 2 sts, hdc next 6, 2 dc next 3, 3 dc next, 2 dc next 3, hdc next 6, 2 hdc last 4 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (39 sts)

RND 4-7: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 8: Sc next 20 sts, (sk next st, sc next 2 sts) 3 times, sc last 10 sts, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)

RND 9: Sc next 10 sts, (sk next st, sc next 2 sts) 3 times, sc last 17 sts, sl st top beg sc, fasten off. (33 sts)

HAT:

<u>RND 1:</u> With White and E hook ch-61, sl st to form a ring, ch-1, (sc next ch, dc next ch) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (60 sts)

<u>RND 2:</u> * (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 4 times, * rep bet ** around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (72 sts) RND 3-7: (Sc next dc, dc next st) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 7 fasten off.

HAT BRIM:

ROW 1: With White and E hook ch-13, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, join Black, fasten off White, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 4: Sc ea st across, join White, fasten off Black, ch-1, turn.

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 6-145: Rep row 2-5.

ROW 146: Sc ea st across, fasten off.

Sew short ends tog to form a lp, Sew this around hat edge at rnd 7, easing as you sew. Make 11 flowers and sew around hat above brim.

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Bet = Between

Ea = Each

Tog = Together
