Looped Edge Purse Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: 1 skein Caron 4 ply yarn in Off White, small amount in Walnut, needle to take yarn, small snap, needle and invisible (clear) sewing thread and H hook or hook to obtain gauge.

<u>GAUGE:</u> 4 sts = $1-1\2$ ", 4 rows st pattern = $1-1\2$ " FINISHED SIZE: 19" wide X 7" tall X 2-1\2" deep

PURSE:

ROW 1: With Off White and H hook ch-31, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, sc last ch, ch-1, turn. (30 sts)

ROW 2-49: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-12, turn.

ROW 50: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 51-52: Sk 1st st, sc next, dc dec next 2, (sc next st, dc next st) across to last 4 sts, sk next st, sc next, dc dec last 2 st, ch-1, turn. End row 52 fasten off. (26 sts)(22 sts)

SIDE:

ROW 1: With Off White and H hook ch-6, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

ROW 2: 2 hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 3: Hdc ea st across, turn.

ROW 4: (Ch-12, sl st next 2 sts) across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 5-32: Rep row 3-4.

ROW 33: Rep row 3. Fasten off.

-make 2. Sew to purse at sides.

CENTER TAB ON FRONT EDGE OF PURSE:

ROW 1: With Off White and H hook count over 8 sts from end row 52 of purse, join next st, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, dc next, sc next, dc next, dc next, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 2-6: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn. End row 6 fasten off.

Sew snap to front purse.

BROWN LOOP FOR FRONT OF PURSE:

ROW 1: With Walnut and H hook ch-3, hdc 3rd ch from hook, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

ROW 2-10: Hdc only st, ch-1, turn. End row 10 fasten off.

Sew to front of purse so center tab will fit inside.

STRAP:

ROW 1: With Walnut and H hook, ch-5, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 2-96: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 96, fasten off.

Sew to ea side of purse on the inside.

Ch = ChainSt = StitchS1 St = Slip Stitch Sc = Single Crochet Hdc = Half Double Crochet Dc = Double Crochet

Rnd = Round

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Sp = Space

Bet = BetweenDec = Decrease

Ea = Each

Tog = Together
