Suede & Boa Hat Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS:

1/2 skein Lion Bran Suede yarn in Taupe, 1/2 skein Bernat Boa yarn in Faucon, needle to take Boa yarn and H hook or hook to obtain gauge.

<u>GAUGE:</u> Suede: $3 \text{ hdc} = 1^{\circ}$, $5 \text{ rows hdc} = 2^{\circ}$. Boa: $4 \text{ hdc sts} = 1^{\circ}$, $3 \text{ rows hdc} = 1^{\circ}$.

FINISHED SIZE: Hat will fit most adults.

HAT SECTION:

ROW 1: With Suede and H ch-4, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc next ch, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

<u>ROW 2-5:</u> 2 hdc next st, hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)(4 sts)(5 sts)(6 sts)

<u>ROW 6-8:</u> 2 hdc next st, hdc ea st across to last st, 2 hdc last st, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)(10 sts)(12 sts) <u>ROW 9:</u> Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 10: 2 hdc next st, hdc ea st across to last st, 2 hdc last st, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

<u>ROW 11-15:</u> Rep row 9.

ROW 16: Hdc ea st across, join Boa, fasten off Suede, ch-1, turn.

<u>RND 17:</u> (Hdc next st, 2 hdc next st) 6 times, hdc next, 3 hdc last st, turn so you are now working across side and evenly (hdc next row, 2 hdc next row) around working 3 hdc in turns, sl st top beg hdc, fasten off. (86 sts)

-make 4. With Boa yarn and needle sew all four sections tog.

HAT EDGING:

<u>RND 1:</u> With Boa and H hook join in any st bottom edge of hat, ch-1, hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, fasten off.

This pattern was worked using suede yarn but any worsted weight yarn will work equally as well. It's the same thing for the boa yarn used in this pattern: any speciality light weight yarn will work as well. Abbreviations Used In This Pattern

Ch = ChainSt = StitchSl St = Slip StitchSc = Single CrochetHdc = Half Double CrochetDc = Double CrochetRnd = RoundBeg = BeginningRep = RepeatBet = BetweenSp = SpaceSk = SkipDec = DecreaseEa = EachTog = Together
