

Suede Tree Pillow & Matching Rug Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: Lion Brand Suede yarn: 1 skein Teal, 1 skein Sage, 2 skeins Olive, 3 skeins Scarlet and 5 skeins Ecru, 1 skein Lion Brand Glitterspun yarn in Gold, H crochet hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle to take glitterspun yarn, stuffing and needle and invisible thread.

FINISHED SIZE: Pillow is 12" square, Rug is 22" X 34"

Gauge: 3 sc = 1", 3 rows sc = 1"

PILLOW FRONT AND BACK (MAKE 2):

ROW 1: With Scarlet yarn and H hook ch-34, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (33 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc ea st across, join Ecru yarn, ch-1, turn, fasten off Scarlet.

ROW 4-8: Rep row 2.

ROW 9: Sc ea st across, join Scarlet yarn, ch-1, turn, fasten off Ecru.

ROW 10-11: Rep row 2.

Rep row 3-11 3 more times.

LAST ROW: Sc ea st across, fasten off scarlet.

TRIANGLE EDGING:

Work along outer edge of front only. Triangle color sequence is: Teal, Olive, Scarlet, Sage and Ecru.

FIRST TRIANGLE:

ROW 1: With teal and H hook join rt side facing in last st of last row of pillow, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next 2 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 2: Sk 1st st, sc next 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

ROW 3: Sk 1st st, sc next st, fasten off. (1 st)

NEXT TRIANGLE:

ROW 1: Join next color in sequence in next st\row after last triangle was worked, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next 2 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 2-3: Rep as for 1st triangle.

With needle and glitterspun yarn, work a buttonhole st around the outer edge(triangles) of front pillow. Along the large Ecru stripes work a diagonal st across the center 2 rows.

TREE TOP:

ROW 1: With Olive and H hook ch-2, work sc 2nd ch from hook, ch-1, turn. (1 st)

ROW 2: Work 3 st in st, ch-1, turn. (3 sts)

ROW 3-4: 2 sc 1st st, sc across to last st, 2 sc last st, ch-1, turn. (5 sts)(7 sts)

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, fasten off.

SECOND SECTION:

ROW 1: With Olive and H hook ch-6, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (5 sts)

ROW 2-4: 2 sc 1st st, sc ea st across to last st, 2 sc last st, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 4 fasten off. (7 sts)(9 sts)(11 sts)

THIRD SECTION:

ROW 1: With Olive and H hook ch-10, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (9 sts)

ROW 2-4: 2 sc 1st st, sc across to last st, 2 sc last st, ch-1, turn. (11 sts)(13 sts)(15 sts)

ROW 5: Sc ea st across, fasten off.

With needle and glitterspun work a buttonhole st long the outer edges of the top tree section. Along the 2nd and 3rd section work the buttonhole st along the sides and bottom of pieces. With the invisible thread, sew the tree sections together. Sew the completed tree to the center of the pillow front. Sew the back section to the front section leaving the triangle edging free and stuff.

RUG:

ROW 1: With Scarlet yarn and H hook ch-73, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (72 sts)

ROW 2-5: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 6: Sc ea st across, join Ecru, ch-1, turn, fasten off Scarlet.

ROW 7-17: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 18: Sc ea st across, join Scarlet, ch-1, turn, fasten off Ecru.

ROW 19: Sc ea st across.

Rep row 2-19 4 more times.

Then rep 2-5 and fasten off.

TRIANGLE EDGING:

Triangle color sequence is Teal, Olive, Scarlet, Sage and Ecru.

FIRST TRIANGLE:

ROW 1: With Teal and H hook join in last st last row of rug, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next 5 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 2-6: Sk next st, sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 6 fasten off. (5 sts)(4 sts)(3 sts)(2 sts)(1 st)

NEXT TRIANGLE:

ROW 1: With next yarn in color sequence, join next st after last completed triangle, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next 5 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 2-6: Rep as you did for 1st triangle.

With needle and glitter spun yarn work a buttonhole st around the outer edge of rug. Also work a diagonal st across the center 4 rows in ea Ecru strip.

-Make 12 trees just like you did for the pillow.

With needle and invisible thread sew the trees along the rug's stripe edge: 2 ea short side and 4 ea long side.

Abbreviations Used In This Pattern

Ch = Chain

St = Stitch

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sc = Single Crochet

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

Dc = Double Crochet

Rnd = Round

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Bet = Between

Sk = Skip

Lp = Loop

Dec = Decrease

Ea = Each

Tog = Together
