Marie Antoinette Pincushion Vase Dolls Crochet Pattern



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Pincushion Doll

<u>Materials:</u> 4-5 oz Red Heart Baby Soft yarn in Light Rose (7722), size E crochet hook, needle to take yarn, small amount of cardboard and stuffing.

Gauge: 5 hdc sts = 1", 5 rows hdc = 1-1/2"

Doll:

With Rose yarn and E hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch-1, 12 hdc in ring, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

Rnd 2-3: (2 hdc next st, hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)(27 sts)

Rnd 4: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)

Rnd 5: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (45 sts)

Rnd 6: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (56 sts)

Rnd 7: Bk Lp hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.

Use this as a guide and cut cardboard to fit inside.

Rnd 8: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.

Rnd 9: Hdc next 4 sts, (hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 8 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (49 sts)

Rnd 10-16: Rep rnd 8. Place cardboard in bottom of piece.

Rnd 17: (Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 5 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (42 sts)

Rnd 18-23: Rep rnd 8.

Row 24: Hdc ea st across, do not join, you are now working in rows, ch-1, turn.

Row 25: Hdc next 2 sts, (hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 6 sts) across, ch-1, turn. (37 sts)

Row 26-27: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Row 28: Hdc next 2 sts, (hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 5 sts) across, ch-1, turn. (32 sts)

Row 29-31: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Row 32: Hdc next 6 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 33: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (5 sts)

Row 34-35: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Row 36: SI st next 3 sts, hdc last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

Row 37: Hdc ea st across, fasten off.

Row 38: With yarn and E hook join in end row 31, ch-1, hdc same st as beg ch-1, hdc next 5 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 39-43: Rep row 33-37. End row 43 fasten off.

Row 44: With yarn and E hook count over 4 sts from end row 32, ch-1, hdc same st as ch-1, hdc next 13 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

Row 45: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across to last 2 sts, hdc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

Row 46: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Row 47: Hdc next 2 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

Row 48; Hdc ea st across, fasten off.

Row 49: With yarn and E hook join in end row 46, ch-1, hdc same st as beg ch-1, hdc next st, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

Row 50: Hdc ea st across, fasten off.

With needle and yarn sew tog at shoulders.

Sleeve:

<u>Rnd 1:</u> With yarn and E hook join in 2nd of 3rd sk st in arm hole, ch-1, sc same st as beg ch-1, sc next st, evenly work 5 sc, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, 5 sc, sc next st, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (21 sts)

Rnd 2: Sc next 6 sts, hdc next, (dc dec next 2 sts) 3 times, hdc next st, sc last 7 sts, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)

Rnd 3: Sc next 7 sts, hdc next 5 sts, sc last 6 sts, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

Rnd 4-6: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.

Rnd 7: (Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (15 sts)

Rnd 8: (Sk next st, sc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

Rnd 9: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.

-Rep other side for 2nd sleeve. Place on doll and stuff dress. With needle and yarn sew back close.

Marie Antoinette Wig:

Additional Materials: Size 10 crochet thread in White, size 7 crochet, sewing needle and sewing thread.

With White and 7 hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch-1, work 12 hdc in ring, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

Rnd 2-3: (2 hdc next st, hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)(27 sts)

Rnd 4: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)

Rnd 5: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (45 sts)

Rnd 6: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (53 sts)

Rnd 7-17: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 17 fasten off.

Long Wig Roll For Back:

Row 1: With White and 7 hook ch-9, hdc 2nd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

Row 2-34: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 34 fasten off.

-Make 4. Sew ea roll tog along long edges. Sew ea roll to back of wig stacking one on top the other.

Medium Roll For "Curl":

Row 1: With White and 7 hook ch-7, hdc 2nd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 2-7: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 7 fasten off.

-Make 2. Sew tog at long edges to form a tube.

Small Roll For "Curl":

With White and 7 hook rep row 1-4 of medium roll. End row 4 fasten off.

-Make 20. Sew tog at long edges to form a tube. Sew 2 rows of small curls across top of wig. Pair one of the remaining rolls with the 1 medium roll and sew to the bottom edge of wig where the long back rolls begin. Rep on other side with last rolls.

Marie Antoinette Snood:

Addition Materials:

Aunt Lydias size 10 metallic thread in Gold and size 7 hook.

With Gold and 7 hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch-1, work 12 sc in ring, sl st top beg sc, do not turn.

Rnd 2: (Ch-4, sc next st) around, do not turn.


Rnd 3-11: (Ch-4, sc next lp) around. End rnd 11 fasten off.



Marie Antoinette In Gold Lace







Marie Antoinette In Gold Lace:

Additional Materials:

110-115 yds (it comes in 100 yd balls) Aunt Lydias size 10 crochet thread metallic in Gold, size 7 crochet hook, One 10 yd reel 5/8" wide Pink ribbon, sewing needle and sewing thread.

Gauge: Lace = 2-1/4" wide

Lace:

Row 1: With Gold and 7 hook ch-14, dc 4th ch from hook, dc next 2 ch, ch-4, sk next 4 ch, dc last 4 ch, ch-5, turn

Row 2: Dc 1st 4 sts, work 4 dc in next ch-4 sp, dc last 4 sts, ch-5, turn.

Row 3: Dc 1st 4 sts, ch-4, sk 4 sts, dc last 4 sts, ch-5, turn.

Row 4-46: Rep row 2-3.

Row 47: Dc 1st 4 sts, 4 dc in next ch-4 sp, dc last 4 sts, turn piece so you will now be working down the long side of the lace, * (dc, ch-1) 6 times in ch-5 lp, sc next ch-5 lp * rep bet ** across with the last sc being worked in the side of next row, turn.

<u>Row 48:</u> Ch-1, sc 1st sc, * (ch-3, sc next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch-3, sc next sc * rep bet ** across, end by sl st in side of next row on short side of lace, fasten off.

Next Side:

Row 1: With Gold and 7 hook join in 1st ch-5 lp on other side of lace, * (dc, ch-1) 6 times in ch-5 lp, sc next ch-5 lp * rep bet ** across with the last sc being worked in the side of next row, turn.

<u>Row 2</u>: Ch-1, sc 1st sc, * (ch-3, sc next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch-3, sc next sc * rep bet ** across, end by sl st in side of next row on short side of lace, fasten off.

Weave ribbon over and under row on lace at opening (ch-4 sps) and leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ " extra at ea end for hem. Fold under ends and sew to back of lace.

Fold lace 2" (about 2 ribbon squares) toward wrong side, tack to hold, Fold lace again 3-1/2" from edge (about 2 more ribbon squares below 1st fold. Again tack to hold. Sew lace at ea side of doll at waist.

Bow:

You will need 14" of ribbon for ea bow made. Carefully fold end into a circle, holding edge to keep its shape, make a lp about ¼" from circle, rep on other side. Make 2 more layers of lps for a total of three. Sew through all layers at ea side to hold.

-Make 2 and sew to ea side of lace at top. Make another one for snood or wig. In the snood I cut an additional 6" of ribbon to place under the bow.



Marie Antoinette In Pink









Marie Antoinette In Pink:

<u>Additional Materials:</u> 1-2 ozs Red Heart Baby Soft yarn in Light Rose (7722), size E crochet hook, Size 10 crochet thread in Petal Pink, small amount in metallic Gold, size 7 crochet hook, needle to take yarn, sewing needle and sewing thread.

Overskirt:

Row 1: With pink yarn and E hook ch-62, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn.

Row 2-16: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 16 do not ch-1, turn.

Row 17: (Ch-4, sl st next st, ch-3, sl st next st) across, fasten off.

With needle and yarn run a line of basting (large) stitch across the top of the underskirt at about row 15 working over and under stitch. Pull tight to gather, knot off. Try to work the gathers evenly toward both ends leaving the very back center of the underskirt flat. Place around doll at waist and sew in place.

Trim:

Row 1: With Pink thread and 7 hook ch-6, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-5, turn.

Row 2: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Row 3 Hdc ea st across, ch-5, turn.

Row 4-18: Rep row 2-3.

Row 19: Hdc ea st across, turn piece so you will now be working down the long side of the lace, * (trc, ch-1) 7 times, trc in ch-5 lp, sc next ch-5 lp * rep bet ** across with the last sc being worked in the side of next row, turn.

Row 20: Ch-1, sc 1st sc, * (ch-3, sc next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch-3, sc next sc * rep bet ** across, end by sl st in side of next row on short side of lace, fasten off.

-Make 8. Sew 2 around bottoms ea sleeve. Sew 1 around neck edge. Sew the remaining trim layering at front of doll between overskirt edges.

Bow:

With Gold and 7 ch- 26, fasten off. Tie into a bow and trim ends.

-Make 6. Sew 1 to ea sleeve at side, sew 2 at center front of bodice and least

Marie Antoinette In Aprons & Lace:

<u>Additional Materials:</u> 1-2 ozs Red Heart Baby Soft yarn in Light Rose (7722), size E crochet hook, Size 10 crochet thread in White and in metallic Gold, size 7 crochet hook, needle to take yarn, sewing needle and sewing thread.

Front Side Aprons:

Row 1: With Gold thread and 7 hook ch-10, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

Row 2-14: 2 hdc 1st st, hdc ea st across to last st, 2 hdc last st, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)(12 sts)(14 sts)(16 sts)(18 sts)(20 sts)(22 sts)(24 sts)(26 sts)(28 sts)(30 sts)(32 sts)(34 sts)

Row 15-17: Hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

Rnd 18: Sc ea st and row around working 3 sc in ea corner, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

Row 19: * Sc next st, sk next 2 sts, (trc, ch-1) 5 times next st, trc same st, sk next 2 sts) around 3 sides, do not work across top straight edge, end with sc, fasten off.

-Make 2. With needle and Gold thread sew a line of basting (large) stitch across the top of the underskirt at about row 15 working over and under stitch. Pull tight to gather, knot off. Sew ea apron at sides of doll at wasit.

Back Apron:

With Pink yarn and E hook rep row 1-19 of side apron. Gather like above and sew to back of doll at waist and over lapping the gold aprons.

Lace:

Row 1: With White thread and 7 hook ch-41, dc in 8th ch from hook (= dc, ch-2, dc), dc next 6 sts, (ch-5, sk next 5 sts, dc next 7 sts) twice, ch-2, dc last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch-5 (= dc + ch-2 here and throughout), dc next 7 sts, (ch-2, sk 2 ch, sc next ch, ch-2, sk 2 ch, dc next 7 sts) twice, ch-2, sk 2 ch, dc next ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch-5, * dc next dc, ch-2, sk 2 dc, sc next dc, ch-2, sk 2 dc, dc next dc, ch-5 * rep bet ** twice,ch-5, dc next dc, ch-2, sk next 2 dc, sc next dc, ch-2, sk next 2 dc, dc next dc, ch-2, dc 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5,

Row 4: Ch-5. dc next dc, (ch-5, dc next dc, 5 dc in ch-5 sp, dc next dc, ch-5, dc in next dc,) twice, ch-2, dc 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5, turn.

Row 5: Ch-5, dc next dc, * ch-2, sk next 2 ch, sc next ch, ch-2, dc next 7 dc * rep bet ** twice, ch-2, sk next 2 ch, sc next ch, ch-2, dc next dc, ch-2, dc 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5, turn.

Row 6: Ch-5, (dc next dc, ch-5, dc in next dc, ch-2, sk next 2 dc, sc next dc, ch-2, sk next 2 dc, dc next dc, ch-5, dc next dc) twice, ch-2, dc in 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5, turn.

Row 7: Ch-5, * dc in next dc, 5 dc next ch-5 lp, dc next dc, ch-5 * rep bet ** twice, dc next dc, 5 dc next ch-5 lp, dc next dc, ch-2, dc 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5, turn.

Row 8: Ch-5, (Dc next 7 dc, ch-2, sk next 2 ch, sc next ch, ch-2) twice, dc next 7 dc, ch-2, dc in 3rd ch of previous rows ch-5, turn.

Row 9-26: Rep row 3-8. End row 26 fasten off.

Cross Bar At Bodice:

Row 1: With Gold thread and 7 hook ch-3, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc last ch, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)

Row 2-14: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 14 fasten off.

-Make 2. Sew one cross bar at top bodice just under neck edge. Sew the 2nd bar just above the waist on bodice. In your hand gather the White lace so it will fit under both bars. Insert and tact in place. Tack the remaining part of the lace flat against the bottom of the doll.
