

# Monkey Hat Crochet Pattern



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Materials:

2-3 ozs Red Heart 4 ply yarns in the colors you like (light & dark of same color)

Small amount of cardboard

Needle to take yarn

Brown felt

Craft glue

Size J (adult) & F (child) crochet hooks or hooks to obtain gauge

Gauge: J Hook: 3 hdc = 1", 2 rows hdc = 1", 4 (sc, dc st combination) = 1-1\4", 4 rows pattern = 1-1\2".

F hook: 4 hdc = 1", 3 rows hdc = 1", 4 (sc, dc st combination) = 1". 3 rows pattern = 1".

Finished Size: Hat made with J hook: 23" inside measurement and will fit most adults. Hat made with F hook: 18" inside measurement & will fit 6 mo – 1 yr old.

Hat:

With dark yarn and hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch-1, work 12 hdc in ring, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

Rnd 2-3: (2 hdc next st, hdc next st) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (18 sts)(27 sts)

Rnd 4-5: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (36 sts)(48 sts)

Rnd 6: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.

Rnd 7: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (60 sts)

Rnd 8-15: Rep rnd 6. End rnd 15 fasten off.

Hat Brim:

Row 1: With dark yarn and hook ch-26, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc next 2 ch, sc next 3, sl st next 12, sc next 3, hdc last 3 ch, fasten off. (24 sts + sl sts)

Row 2: With dark yarn and hook join in 1st st bottom of row 1, you will be working across the bottom of the foundation row (in bottom of sts made row 1), ch-1, hdc sa st as beg ch-1, hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (24 sts)

Row 3-6: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (23 sts)(22 sts)(21 sts)(20 sts)

Row 7-9: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across to last 2 sts, hdc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. End row 9 fasten off. (18 sts)(16 sts)(14 sts)

Monkey Face:

Row 1: With lighter yarn and hook ch-11, sc 2nd ch from hook, (dc next ch, sc next ch) across to last ch, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

Row 2: (Sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across to last 2 sts, (sc, dc) last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

Row 3: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

Row 4: Rep row 2. (18 sts)

Row 5-9: Rep row 3.

Row 10: Sk 1st st, sc next st, dc dec next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) across to last 4 sts, sk next st, sc next st, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

Row 11: Rep row 3.

Row 12: Rep row 2. (18 sts)

Row 13-14: Rep row 3.

Row 15: Dc dec next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, sl st next 2 sts, rep bet () 3 times, dc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (14 sts)

Row 16: Sk 1st st, (sc next st, dc next st) 3 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 17: Dc dec next 2 sts, sc next, dc next, sc next, sl st last st, fasten off. (4 sts)

Row 18: With lighter yarn and hook join in last st end row 5, ch-1, sc sa st as beg ch-1, dc next st, (sc next st, dc next st) twice, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 19: Rep row 17, fasten off.

Using face as a pattern cut a piece of cardboard to fit bottom chin portion of face. Place face on hat, using needle and yarn sew to hat inserting cardboard as you sew. You may want to sew across the top of the chin-brim part of the hat to keep the cardboard from sliding up.

#### Outer Ear (Make 2):

Row 1: With dark yarn and hook ch-6, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

Row 2-3: 3 hdc 1st st, hdc ea st across to last st, 3 hdc last st, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)(12 sts)

Row 4-6: Hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc ea st across to last 2 sts, hdc dec last 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)(8 sts)(6 sts)

Rnd 7: Evenly sc ea st and row around working 2 sc in ea corner or turn in ear, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

#### Inner Ear (Make 2):

Row 1: With light yarn and hook ch-5, sc 2nd ch from hook, dc next ch, sc next, dc last ch, ch-1, turn. (4 sts)

Row 2: (sc, dc) next 2 sts, sc next, dc last st, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

Row 3: (sc, dc) next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) twice, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)

Row 4: (Sc next st, dc next st) across, ch-1, turn.

Row 5: Dc dec next 2 sts, (sc next st, dc next st) twice, sc next, sl st last st, fasten off.

#### Finishing The Hat:

Sew the inner ear to the outer ear and then to side of hat. Using patterns as a guide cut out eyes and nose from felt and glue in place. Cut a thin strip of felt (1¼" X 6" for adult & 1¼" X 3-1½" for child) and glue in place for the mouth trimming ends if needed.

Ch = Chain

St = Stitch

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sc = Single Crochet

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

Dc = Double Crochet

Rnd = Round

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Bet = Between

Ea = Each

Tog = Together

Dec = Decrease
