## Pansy Purse <br> Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: 1 skein Light Sage Red Heart Super Saver yarn, small amounts in Black and Cherry Red, size H crochet hook or hook needed to obtain gauge, needle to take yarn and 1 pair of black purse handles.

GAUGE: 4 hdc sts $=1 ", 3$ rows hdc $=1-1 \backslash 2 "$, Flower is $2-1 \backslash 2 " \mathrm{X} 2-1 \backslash 2 "$
FINISHED SIZE: $8 "$ tall X $10 "$ across widest pt .
PURSE:
RND 1: With Light Sage and H hook ch-12, hdc $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook, hdc next 8 ch, 3 hdc last ch, turn piece so you are now working across the bottom of the foundation ch (in bottom of sts just made), hdc next 8,2 hdc last, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (22 sts)
RND 2: 2 hdc next 2 sts, hdc next 8, 2 hdc next 3, hdc next 8 , 2 hdc last st, $s l$ st top beg hdc, ch- 1 , turn. ( 28 sts) RND 3: 2 hdc next 2 sts, hdc next 8,2 hdc next 6 , hdc next 8 , 2 hdc last 4 sts, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. ( 40 sts) RND 4: ( 2 hdc next st, hdc next st) 3 times, hdc next 10, rep bet () 5 times, hdc next 10 , rep bet () twice, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. ( 50 sts )
RND 5: Bk Lp hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.
RND 6-7: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.
RND 8: ( 2 hdc next st, hdc next st) 4 times, hdc next 13, rep bet () 6 times, hdc next 13, rep bet () twice, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (62 sts)
RND 9-13: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn.
RND 14: (2 hdc next st, hdc next 2 sts) around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. ( 74 sts )
RND 15-21: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 21 fasten off.

## FLOWER:

With Black and H hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.
RND 1: (Ch-3, 2 dc in ring, ch-3, sl st in ring) 3 times, join Red, fasten of Black, (ch-4, 3 tre in ring, ch-4, sl st in ring) twice, do not turn.
RND 2: (Ch-3, work 3 hdc in top next 2 dc , ch-3, sl st bet Black petals of rnd 1) 3 times, fasten off.
-Make 14 flowers and sew to purse. Sew handles to top edge of purse.
