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C-75 . . . Cap, Bootees and Mittens

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 3 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 1 White and 1 skein of No. 802 Baby Blue.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 4.

2 white pearl buttons.

GAUGE: 6 sc make 1 inch; 7 rows make 1 inch.

CAP—First Section . . . Starting at bottom with White, ch 20. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd to 11th rows incl: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 12th row: Work off first 2 sc as 1 sc (1 sc decreased), sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat last row until 1 sc remains. Break off. Make 4 more sections the same way.

To join sections: Holding 2 sections together and working through both thicknesses to join, attach Blue to top and sl st closely across one side. Break off. Join remaining sections the same way. Join last section to first section. Attach Blue to 7th sc of starting chain on any section and sc in each ch around. Join and break off. Attach White to first sc, sc in same sc and in each sc across until there are 33 sc on row. Break off.

visor. . . . lst row: Mark off 3 sc at center of last row made. Using yarn double, attach White to first sc, 2 sc in each of the 3 sc. Turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across, sc in next 5 sc on Cap. Turn. 3rd to 7th rows incl: Sc in each sc across, sc in end sc on each row, sc in next 5 sc on Cap. Turn. 8th row: Sc in each sc across Visor. Break off. Attach Blue to next sc on Cap preceding Visor, sc in each sc across, sl st in next sc on Cap. Break off.

cord . . . Cut 6 strands of White, each 18 inches long. Twist these strands tightly, then double these strands and give them a twist in the opposite direction. Fasten ends securely. Sew Cord to front of Cap. Sew a button to each side of Cord.

at center with White, ch 20. 1st rnd: 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, tr in next 6 ch, 9 tr in last ch; working

along opposite side of starting chain make tr in next 6 ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, 3 dc in same place where first 3 dc were made. Sl st in 3rd ch of starting chain. 2nd and 3rd rnds: Sc in each st around, increasing around curved ends as necessary to keep work flat—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Join. Break off at end of 3rd rnd.

UPPER—Instep... Starting at center with White, ch 8. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain make sc in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 5th rows incl:** Sc in each sc across, increasing 3 sc evenly over rounded end. Ch 1, turn. At end of 5th row, ch 33 for ankle, sl st in first sc.

SIDE PIECE . . . 1st rnd: Sc in back loop of each sc and in each ch around. Join. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rnds: Sc in each sc around. Join. Break off at end of 4th rnd. Attach Blue to front loop of first sc on 5th row of Instep, sc closely around entire Instep. Join and break off.

CUFF . . . 1st rnd: Attach White to opposite side of starting chain on Side Piece, ch 4, * skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join. 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, sc in each sp and in each dc around. Join. 3rd to 7th rnds incl: Sc in each sc around. Join. Break off at end of 7th rnd. 8th rnd: Attach Blue to same place as sl st, sc in each sc around. Join and break off

Pin Sole in place, attach Blue to back and, working through both thicknesses, sc closely around. Join and break off. With White make a chain 12 inches long. Lace through sps on cuff. With Blue make 2 small pompons and sew one to each end of chain. Tie into a bow.

MITTEN (Make 2)—Back . . . Starting at center, ch 10. Work as for Instep of Bootee until 5 rows have been completed. 6th row: Sc in each sc across, increasing 3 sc evenly at rounded end.

CUFF.... 1st row: Ch 4 and, working across straight edge, skip end st of first 2 rows, dc in end st of next row, * ch 1, skip end st of next row, dc in end st of next row. Repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each dc and in each ch-1 sp across, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-4. Ch 1, turn. 3rd to 6th rows incl: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 6th row.

FRONT . . . Work exactly as for Back.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 1 (2½ mm. size) and 1 pair No. 2 (2¾ mm. size).

6 buttons.

GAUGE: 7½ sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

GIRL'S CARDIGAN—Back . . . Starting at lower edge with No. 1 knitting pins and Baby Pink, cast on

68 sts 76 sts 84 sts

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 11/4" 11/4" 11/2" increasing 1 st at the end of last row on Size 2 only. There are on needle 68 sts 77 sts 84 sts

Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work in pattern as follows: 1st row:

Knit 2 sts 3 sts 3 sts p 1, * k 6, p 1. Repeat from * across, ending with knit

2 sts 3 sts

2nd row: Purl

2 sts 3 sts 3 sts k 1, * p 6, k 1. Repeat from * across, ending with purl

Repeat last 2 rows twice, then repeat first row once more. Break off Pink. Attach Nile Green and repeat 2nd row of pattern. Break off Nile Green. The last 8 rows (first to 8th rows incl) constitute pattern.

Work in pattern until piece measures in all 61/2" 7" 71/2"

To Shape Armholes: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.

C-76 . . . Boy's Beret

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) of No. 679 Nile Green and a few yards of No. 1 White.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 3.

GAUGE: 7 half dc make 1 inch; 4 rnds make 1 inch.

Starting at center, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 2, 12 half dc in ring. Do not join rnds. 2nd rnd: 2 half dc in each half dc around. 3rd rnd: * 2 half dc in next half dc (1 half dc increased), half dc in next half dc. Repeat from * around. 4th to 12th rnds incl: Half dc in each half dc around, increasing 12 half dc evenly on each rnd. 13th to 17th rnds incl: Half dc in each half dc around. 18th to 22nd rnds incl: Half dc in each half dc around, decreasing 12 half dc evenly on each rnd-to dec 1 half dc, work off 2 half dc as 1 half dc. 23rd to 26th rnds incl: Half dc in each half dc around. 27th rnd: Sc in each half dc around. Join and break off. Wrong side of half dc is right side of Beret.

POMPON . . . Cut 2 circles of cardboard 2 inches in diameter. Cut a circle ³/₄ inch in diameter in center of each 2-inch circle. Using 1 strand of Green and 1 strand of White, complete as for No. C-32, page 14. Sew to center of Beret.

To Shape Shoulders: Bind off

LEFT FRONT . . . Starting at lower edge with No. 1 knitting pins and Pink, cast on 40 sts 44 sts 48 sts

1st row: * K 1, p 1. Repeat from * across to last 6 sts, k 6. 2nd row: K 7, * p 1, k 1. Repeat from * to last st, p 1. Repeat these 2 rows, keeping front border in garter st, until piece measures in all, ending at side edge 114" 114" 114"

Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work in pattern as follows: 1st row: 2 sts 5 sts p 1, * k 6, p 1. Repeat from * to last 6 sts, k 6. 2nd row: K 7, * p 6, k 1. Repeat from * across, ending with 2 sts purl 5 sts Repeat last 2 rows twice, then repeat first row once more. Next row: K 6 Pink. Break off Pink and attach Nile Green. With Nile Green k 1, * p 6, k 1. Repeat from * across, ending with 5 sts 2 sts purl Break off Nile Green, attach Pink and work in pattern as established, until piece measures in all, ending at side 61/2" 7" edge

To Shape Armhole: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every other row until there remain 34 sts 38 sts 42 sts Work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at front edge

2" 2" 21/2"

To Shape Neck: Bind off

at the beginning of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge every other row until there remain 18 sts 20 sts 24 sts
Work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at armhole edge

To Shape Shoulder: Bind off
6 sts 5 sts 6 sts
at the beginning of next row and every
other row 3 times 4 times 4 times

BUTTONHOLES . . . Divide Left Front Border into 6 equal parts and mark with pins. These pins indicate where buttonholes should be made on Right Front Border—to make a buttonhole, 2 sts in from front edge, on one row, bind off 2 sts; on next row cast on 2 sts to replace those bound off.

RIGHT FRONT . . . Work as for Left Front, reversing shapings and position of Border, making a buttonhole opposite each pin mark of Left Front Border.

SLEEVES . . . Starting at cuff with No. 1 knitting pins and Pink, cast on 42 sts 44 sts 50 sts

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 11/4" 11/4" 11/2" increasing 5 sts 5 sts 6 sts evenly spaced on last row. There are on needle 47 sts 49 sts 56 sts

Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work in pattern as follows: 1st row:

Knit 2 sts 3 sts 3 sts
p 1, * k 6, p 1. Repeat from * across, ending with knit

2 sts 3 sts 3 sts
2nd row: Purl
2 sts 3 sts 3 sts
k 1, * p 6, k 1. Repeat from * across, ending with purl

3 sts

3 sts

Work in pattern as established until piece measures in all

6½" 7" 7½" ending with same row as on Back at underarm.

To Shape Top: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at the end of each row until there remain 27 sts 23 sts 24 sts

Dec 1 st at both ends of each row until there remain 15 sts 15 sts 16 sts

Bind off.

with No. 2 knitting at outside edge with No. 2 knitting pins and Pink, cast on 68 sts 72 sts 76 sts

Work in garter st (knit each row) for 4 rows. Change to stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row). Keeping 3 sts at both ends in garter st work in stockinette st for 1½ inches. Bind off 15 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

Block to measurements. For vertical stripes, with crochet hook and 2 strands of Nile Green make a row of chain sts in each of the purled rib sts. Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew on collar. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

BOY'S CARDIGAN Work as for Girl's Cardigan, reversing colors and amounts, and making buttonholes on Left Front Border (instead of Right).

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 1 inch, increasing evenly across on last row

8 sts 11 sts 10 sts

Now work in pattern as for Back until piece measures in all

To Shape Top: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row until there remain 16 sts 19 sts 26 sts On Size 3 only, bind off 2 sts at the beginning of each row until 18 sts remain. On all sizes, bind off.

Block to measurements given. Sew up side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew garter st band along back neck edge. Sew in sleeves. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

join, attach Blue to side and sc closely around to opposite side. Break off. Attach Blue to edge of Cuff, sc closely around. Join and break off. With White, make a chain 10 inches long. Lace through ch-1 sps on cuff. Make 2 small pompons and sew one to each end of chain.
