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C-25 . . . Herringbone Set

Infant Size 3

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 6 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) will make the set, or 3 skeins for Sacque, 2 skeins for Bonnet, 1 skein each for Mittens or Booties.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 2 (2¾ mm. size).

3 yards of narrow ribbon.

2 yards of ribbon, 1 inch wide.

6 buttons.

GAUGE: 7½ sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS: Chest—22 inches; Length from shoulder to lower edge—11 inches; Length of side seam—7 inches; Length of sleeve seam—7 inches.

SACQUE—Back . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 85 sts and work in moss st pattern as follows: **1st row:** * K 1, p 1. Repeat from * across, ending with k 1. Repeat first row until piece measures 1¼ inches.

Now work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** (K 4, k 2 tog, O) 7 times; k 1, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 7 times. **2nd and all even rows:** P across. **3rd row:** K 3, k 2 tog, O, (k 4, k 2 tog, O) 6 times; k 3, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 6 times; O, k 2 tog, k 3. **5th row:** K 2, k 2 tog, O, (k 4, k 2 tog, O) 6 times; k 5, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 6 times; O, k 2 tog, k 2. **7th row:** K 1, k 2 tog, O, (k 4, k 2 tog, O) 6 times; k 7, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 6 times; O, k 2 tog, k 1. **9th row:** K 2 tog, O, (k 4, k 2 tog, O) 6 times; k 9, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 6 times; O, k 2 tog. **11th row:** K 5, k 2 tog, O, (k 4, k 2 tog, O) 5 times; k 11, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 5 times; O, k 2 tog, k 5. **12th row:** P across. The last 12 rows (first to 12th rows incl) constitute the pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures 7 inches in all.

To Shape Armholes: Bind off 4 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Keeping continuity of pattern, dec 1 st at both ends of every other row twice (73 sts). Work without decreasing until piece measures 4 inches from first row of armhole shaping.

To Shape Shoulders: Bind off 8 sts at the beginning of next 6 rows. Bind off remaining sts for back of neck.

LEFT FRONT . . . Starting at lower edge,

cast on 47 sts. Work in moss st pattern for 1¼ inches.

Now work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** * K 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 11 sts, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **2nd and all even rows:** Work in moss st over first 11 sts, p across. **3rd row:** K 3, k 2 tog, O, * k 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 12 sts, k 1, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **5th row:** K 2, k 2 tog, O, * k 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 13 sts, k 2, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **7th row:** K 1, k 2 tog, O, * k 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 14 sts, k 3, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **9th row:** K 2 tog, O, * k 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 15 sts, k 4, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **11th row:** K 5, k 2 tog, O, * k 4, k 2 tog, O. Repeat from * across to last 16 sts, k 5, (k 1, p 1) 5 times and k 1. **12th row:** Repeat 2nd row. Repeat the last 12 rows (first to 12th rows incl) until piece measures 7 inches in all, ending with the same row as Back.

To Shape Armhole: Bind off 4 sts at armhole edge on next row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every other row twice. Work without decreasing until piece measures 2½ inches from first row of armhole shaping, ending at front edge.

To Shape Neck: Bind off 11 sts at the beginning of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge every other row until 24 sts remain. **If necessary** work without decreasing until piece measures 4 inches from first row of armhole shaping, ending at armhole edge.

To Shape Shoulder: Bind off 8 sts at the beginning of next row and every other row 3 times.

BUTTONHOLES . . . Divide Left Front edge into 6 equal parts and mark with pins. These pins indicate where buttonholes should be made on Right Front—to make a buttonhole, on one row bind off 2 sts, on next row cast on 2 sts to replace those bound off.

RIGHT FRONT . . . Work as for Left Front, making a buttonhole 4 sts in from front edge opposite each pin mark of Left Front until piece measures 1¼ inches. **Next row:** (K 1, p 1) 5 times; k 1, * O, k 2 tog, k 4. Repeat from * across. **Following row:** P across to last 11 sts, (k 1, p 1) 5 times; k 1. Pattern is now established. Work as for Left Front, reversing shapings, continuing with buttonholes 4 sts in from front edge opposite each pin mark on Left Front and moving diagonal stripe pattern to the left.

SLEEVES . . . Starting at cuff, cast on 43 sts and work in moss st for 1¼ inches, increasing 6 sts evenly spaced on last row (49 sts). Now work in

Infant Sizes 1, 2 and 3

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 3 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 802 Baby Blue for Sizes 1 and 2; 4 skeins for Size 3.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 3 (3 mm. size).

6 buttons.

GAUGE: 8 sts make 1 inch; 12 rows make 1 inch.

BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS:

Sizes	1	2	3
Chest	18"	20"	22"
Length from shoulder to lower edge	9½"	10½"	11½"
Length of side seam	6½"	7"	7½"
Length of sleeve seam	6"	6½"	7"

BACK . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on

72 sts 80 sts 88 sts

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 1 inch. Now work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** * K 1, place yarn in front of work, sl 1 as if to purl, place yarn in back of work. Repeat from * across (this is right side of work). **2nd row:** P across. **3rd row:** * Place yarn in front of work, sl 1 as if to purl, place yarn in back of work, k 1. Repeat from * across. **4th row:** P across. The last 4 rows (first to 4th rows incl) constitute the pattern.

Work in pattern until piece measures in all

C-32 Boy's Cap

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) each of No. 802 Baby Blue and No. 1 White.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 3 (3 mm. size).

GAUGE: 7 sts make 1 inch; 9 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at center of crown with Blue, cast on 10 sts. Now work as follows: **1st row:** K across. **2nd and all even rows:** P across. **3rd row:** Inc in each st across (20 sts). **5th row:** * K 1, inc 1 st in next st. Repeat from * across (30 sts). **7th row:** * K 2, inc 1 st in next st. Repeat from * across (40 sts). Continue to inc 10 sts on every k row, always working 1 st more between increases until there are 100 sts on needle, ending with a p row. **Next row:** Inc 1 st in first st, k 2, inc 1 st in next st, * k 3, inc 1 st in next st. Repeat from * across (126 sts). Now work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 4 inches, ending with wrong side facing.

FRONT BAND . . . Work across 21 sts. Turn and work over these sts only, decreasing 1 st at both ends of each row until 3 sts remain, then k 3 tog, slip yarn through remaining st. Attach yarn and work across next 21 sts in same manner. Continue to work in sections until all sts are worked off.

Sew up back seam. Fasten all ends securely. With crochet hook and White make a row of sc all around front band edge. Join with sl st in first sc. Turn and sl st in each sc. Join and break off. Press lightly.

POMPON . . . Cut 2 cardboard circles each 2 inches in diameter. Cut a circle about 1/2 inch in diameter in center of each cardboard circle. Cut 3 lengths of White, each 4 yards long. Holding the 2 cardboard pieces together, wind the 3 lengths of yarn around the cardboard pieces through center until center is filled. Cut yarn between the 2 cardboard pieces at outer edge and tie strands securely between the 2 cardboard circles. Remove cardboard. Trim ends evenly. Sew to center of crown.

pattern as follows: **1st row:** (K 4, k 2 tog, O) 4 times; k 1, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 4 times. **2nd row:** P across. Pattern is now established. Work in pattern as for Back until piece measures 7 inches in all, ending with the same row as on Back.

To Shape Top: Bind off 4 sts at the

beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends every other row until 19 sts remain. Bind off.

COLLAR . . . Starting at outside edge, cast on 75 sts and work in moss st for 1 1/2 inches. Bind off 15 sts at the beginning of next 4 rows. Bind off.

Block to measurements given. Sew up side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew on collar. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

BONNET . . . Starting at front edge of cuff, cast on 85 sts and work as for Back until piece measures 5 inches. Bind off 28 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Work in pattern over remaining 29 sts until piece measures same as bound off sts. Bind off.

Sew center piece along bound off sts. Fold cuff band to right side and sew lower edges together. With right side facing, pick up and knit 69 sts along lower edge and work in moss st for 1/2 inch. Bind off.

Press lightly through a damp cloth. Sew wide ribbon to each side at front for ties. Make 2 rosettes and sew to each side at front.

BOOTEES . . . Starting at top cast on 37 sts. Work in moss st for 1/2 inch. Now work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** (K 4, k 2 tog, O) 3 times; k 1, (O, k 2 tog, k 4) 3 times. **2nd row:** P across. Pattern is now established. Work in pattern until piece measures 3 inches in all.

INSTEP . . . Work across 25 sts. Turn and work in pattern over last 13 sts only for 2 inches. Break off.

FOOT . . . With right side facing and using needle with 12 sts attach yarn, pick up and knit 15 sts along right side of Instep, k across next 13 sts, pick up and knit 15 sts along other side of Instep, k across remaining 12 sts (67 sts). Work in moss st over these 67 sts for 13 rows.

To Shape Toe: **1st row:** P 2 tog, work across next 30 sts, k 3 tog, work across to last 2 sts, p 2 tog. **2nd row:** Work across in moss st. **3rd row:** K 2 tog, work across next 28 sts, p 3 tog, work across to last 2 sts, k 2 tog. **4th row:** Repeat 2nd row. **5th row:** P 2 tog, work across next 26 sts, k 3 tog, work across to last 2 sts, p 2 tog. **6th row:** Repeat 2nd row. Bind off. Sew up back and sole seams. Press lightly through a damp cloth. Run narrow ribbon through eyelets at ankle and tie in a bow.

MITTENS . . . Starting at cuff, cast on 49 sts. Work in moss st for 4 rows. Now work in diagonal stripe pattern as for sleeve until piece measures 2 inches in all, decreasing 8 sts evenly spaced on last row. Work in moss st until piece measures 4 inches in all.

To Shape Tip: K 1, p 1, k 1, * p 3 tog, (k 1, p 1) twice; k 3 tog, (p 1, k 1) twice. Repeat from * across to last

10 sts, p 3 tog, (k 1, p 1) twice; k 3 tog. Dec in this manner on every 4th row 2 more times, always working 1 st less between decreases. Break off, leaving a 12-inch length of yarn. Thread this yarn through a tapestry needle and run through remaining sts. Pull up tightly and fasten securely on wrong side.

Sew up side seams and press lightly through a damp cloth. Run ribbon through eyelets at wrist and tie in a bow.

1st row: K 8, * p 1, k 1. Repeat from * across. **2nd row:** * P 1, k 1. Repeat from * across to last 7 sts, k 7. Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 1/2 inch. **Next row:** Make a set of buttonholes on Right Front for girl; on Left Front for boy—to make a set of buttonholes, 3 sts in from front edge bind off 2 sts, work next 8 sts, bind off 2 sts; on next row, cast on 2 sts to replace each set of 2 sts bound off. Continue to work first 2 rows until piece measures 1 inch.

Now work in pattern as for Back, still keeping the 7 sts at front edge in garter st (k each row) and making a set of buttonholes every

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 1 inch, increasing evenly across on last row

Now work in pattern as for Back until piece measures in all

To Shape Top: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row until there remain **16 sts 19 sts 26 sts**

On Size 3 only, bind off 2 sts at the beginning of each row until 18 sts remain. On all sizes, bind off.

Block to measurements given. Sew up side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew garter st band along back neck edge. Sew in sleeves. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.
