## C-29 . . . Little Lady

Illustrated on Page 27

Infant Sizes 1, 2 and 3

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277:** 6 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) for Size 1; 8 skeins for Sizes 2 and 3 for the set.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins,** 1 pair No. 3 (3 mm. size).

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Double-pointed Sock Needles,** 1 set No. 3 (3 mm. size).

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook** No. 3.

2 yards of ribbon, 1/4 inch wide.

1 yard ribbon, 1/2 inch wide.

**GAUGE:** 7 sts make 1 inch; 9 rows make 1 inch.

### BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS:

Sizes	1	2	3
Chest	18"	20"	22"
Length from shoulder to lower edge	9 1/2"	10 1/2"	11"
Length to underarm	6"	6 1/2"	7"
Length of sleeve seam	5 1/2"	6"	6 1/2"

**NOTE:** Garment is worked in one piece to underarm.

**SACQUE . . .** Starting at lower edge, cast on **169 sts 187 sts 205 sts**

Work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** K across. **2nd row:** K 1, \* O, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, O, make a cable over next 4 sts—to make a cable, slip next 2 sts on a double-pointed needle and place in back of work, k 2, knit the sts from double-pointed needle. Repeat from \* across to last 6 sts, O, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1. **3rd and all odd rows:** P across. **4th row:** K across. **6th row:** K 1, \* k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, k 2 tog, k 4. Repeat from \* across to last 6 sts, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, k 2 tog, k 1. **8th row:** K across. **9th row:** P across. The last 8 rows (2nd to 9th rows incl) constitute the pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures **6" 6 1/2" 7"**

**RIGHT FRONT YOKE . . .** Work across **50 sts 56 sts 62 sts**

Turn and work over these sts only. Keeping continuity of pattern, bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next row. Still keeping continuity of pattern,

dec 1 st at armhole edge every other row until there remain

**44 sts 49 sts 55 sts**

Work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending with a p row

**1 1/4" 1 1/2" 1 1/2"**

**Next row:** Discontinue pattern and knit **7 sts 8 sts 8 sts**  
k 2 tog **15 times 16 times 19 times**  
knit **7 sts 9 sts 9 sts**

Work in stockinette st (p 1 row, k 1 row) until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at front edge **2 1/4" 2 1/2" 2 1/2"**

**To Shape Neck:** Bind off 4 sts at the beginning of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge every row until there remain **18 sts 20 sts 22 sts**

If necessary, work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at armhole edge **3 1/2" 4" 4"**

**To Shape Shoulder:** Bind off 6 sts at the beginning of next row and every other row **3 times twice 3 times**  
Bind off remaining sts on Sizes 2 and 3.

**BACK YOKE . . .** Attach yarn where sts were divided and work across

**69 sts 75 sts 81 sts**

Turn and work over these sts only. Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row, until there remain

**57 sts 61 sts 67 sts**

Work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping **1 1/4" 1 1/2" 1 1/2"**

Discontinue pattern and work in stockinette st until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping

**3 1/2" 4" 4"**

**To Shape Shoulders:** Bind off 6 sts at the beginning of each row

**6 times 4 times 6 times**

Bind off at beginning of next 2 rows

**— 8 sts 4 sts**

Bind off remaining **21 sts 21 sts 23 sts**

**LEFT FRONT YOKE . . .** Work as for Right Front Yoke, reversing shapings.

**SLEEVES . . .** Starting at cuff, cast on **43 sts 52 sts 52 sts**

Work in pattern until piece measures **5 1/2" 6" 6 1/2"**

ending with the same row of pattern as for Sacque at armhole shaping.

**To Shape Top:** Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Keeping continuity of pattern, dec 1 st at both ends

## C-44 . . . Lace Sacque

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277:** 2 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 802 Baby Blue and 1 skein of No. 1 White, or

**J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64:** 1 ball each of No. 25 Crystal Blue and No. 1 White.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook** No. 2.

1 3/4 yards of blue ribbon, 1/2 inch wide.

Each motif measures 1 3/4 inches square.

**FIRST MOTIF . . .** Starting at center with White, ch 4. **1st rnd:** 15 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join with sl st to top of starting chain. Break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach Blue to same place as sl st, ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, make 2 dc in same place, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 3, in same place as cluster was made make dc, ch 5, dc, ch 3 and 3-dc cluster; \* skip next 3 dc, in next dc make 3-dc cluster, ch 3, dc, ch 5, dc, ch 3 and 3-dc cluster. Repeat from \* around. Join to top of ch-3. Break off.

**SECOND MOTIF . . .** Work as for First Motif until first rnd is completed. **2nd rnd:** Attach Blue to same place as sl st, ch 3, in same place make 2-dc cluster, ch 3 and dc; ch 2, sl st in any corner sp on First Motif, ch 2, dc in same place as last dc was made on Second Motif, ch 1, sl st in next sp on First Motif, ch 1, 3-dc cluster in same place as last dc was made on Second Motif, skip next 3 dc, 3-dc cluster in next dc, ch 1, sl st in next sp on First Motif, ch 1, dc in same dc as last cluster was made on Second Motif, ch 2, sl st in next corner sp on First Motif, ch 2, in same place as last dc was made on Second Motif make dc, ch 3 and 3-dc cluster. Complete rnd as before (no more joinings).

Make 70 motifs in all and, following chart on page 28, join adjacent sides as Second Motif was joined to First Motif (where 4 corners meet, join 3rd and 4th corners to joining of previous 2 corners). Sew up sleeve and side seams.

**YOKE . . .** Attach Blue to corner of top motif on right front edge. **1st row:** Ch 3, \* working in back loop only, dc in each ch and in each st across to next corner, skip joining at corner. Repeat from \* around to left front edge. Ch 3, turn. **2nd to 5th rows incl:** Skip first dc, \* dc in each dc across to within 2 dc of corner, skip next 4 dc.

## C-40 . . . Strap Slippers

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL,** 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof Pull-Out Skein") of No. 1 White. Scraps of Pink.

**J. & P. COATS OR CLARK'S O.N.T. SIX STRAND EMBROIDERY FLOSS,** Art. A. or B.11: 1 skein each of No. 26 Nile Green and No. 46-A Mid Rose.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook** No. 4.

1¼ yards of pink ribbon, ¼ inch wide.

**SOLE . . .** Starting at center, ch 20. **1st rnd:** 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, tr in next 6 ch, 9 tr in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain make tr in next 6 ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, 3 dc in same place where first 3 dc were made. Sl st in 3rd ch of starting chain. **2nd and 3rd rnds:** Sc in each st around, increasing around curved ends as necessary to keep work flat—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Join. Break off at end of 3rd rnd.

**TOE PIECE . . .** Starting at instep, ch 8. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 7th rows incl:** Sc in back loop of each sc across. Ch 1, turn. At end of 7th row, ch 25, sl st in first sc of same row. Break off. Attach yarn to center of ch 25 and work in rows as follows: **1st row:** Sc in each ch, sc closely around instep, sc in each remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 8th rows incl:** Sc in back loop of each sc around. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 8th row.

Sew up back seam. Pin sole in place and, working through both thicknesses, make sc closely around. Join and break off.

**STRAPS AND BACK . . . 1st row:** Ch 10, skip 5 sts on top, attach yarn to next st, sc in same place and in next 14 sts, ch 11. Turn. **2nd row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sc in back loop of each sc and in each remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. **3rd row:** Sc in back loop of each sc across. Break off. **4th row:** Skip 10 sc. Attach yarn to next sc, sc in back loop of same sc and in next 14 sts. Ch 1, turn. **5th to 10th rows incl:** Sc in back loop of each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 10th row. Turn. **11th row:** Ch 10, sc in back loop of first sc and each sc across. Ch 11, turn. **12th and 13th rows:** Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows. Break off.

Embroider instep with scraps of Pink Baby Wool and embroidery floss. Cut ribbon into 4 pieces. Tie a piece through each strap. Make another Slipper the same way.

Bind off.

Block to measurements. Sew up shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves, matching pattern.

**BEADING . . .** With wrong side facing, attach yarn at front neck edge, ch 5, \* skip ¼ inch on neck edge, dc on edge, ch 2. Repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn. **Next row:** In each sp across make sc, ch 3 and dc. Break off.

Make sc around sleeves and outer edges, turn and sl st in each sc. Break off. Cut wide ribbon in half and run through Beading.

**BOOTEES . . .** Starting at cuff, cast on 43 sts. Work in garter st (k each row) for ½ inch. Now work in pattern as for Sacque until piece measures 2½ inches in all, ending with a p row. **Next row:** K 1, \* O, k 2 tog, k 1. Repeat from \* across. **Following row:** P across.

**INSTEP . . .** K across 28 sts. Turn and work in stockinette st over the last 13 sts only for 1½ inches, ending with a p row. Break off. With right side facing using needle with the 15 sts, attach yarn, pick up and k 14 sts along right side of Instep, k 13, pick up and k 14 sts along other side of Instep, k 15 (71 sts). Work in stockinette st across all sts for ¾ inch, ending with a p row.

**FOOT . . . 1st row:** K 1, k 2 tog, k 30, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 30, k 2 tog, k 1. **2nd and all even rows:** P across. **3rd row:** K 1, k 2 tog, k 28, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 28, k 2 tog, k 1. **5th row:** K 1, k 2 tog, k 26, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 26, k 2 tog, k 1. **6th row:** P across. Bind off.

Sew up back and sole seams. Press. Run narrow ribbon through Beading at ankle.

**BONNET . . .** Starting at front edge, cast on 88 sts and k 4 rows. Now work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row) for 1½ inches, ending with a knit row. Work in pattern as for Sacque until piece measures 5½ inches in all. Bind off 28 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Work in stockinette st over remaining 32 sts until piece measures same as bound-off sts. Bind off.

Sew back piece to bound off sts. Turn 1 inch of front band to right side and sew lower edges together. With right side facing, pick up and k 84 sts along neck edge and work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 5 rows. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Press lightly.

Cut remaining wide ribbon in half and sew to each side at front edge for ties. Trim with rosettes if desired.

**MITTENS . . .** Starting at cuff, cast on 45 sts. Divide sts evenly on 3 needles, being careful not to twist sts. Work in pattern as follows: **1st rnd:** K around. **2nd rnd:** \* O, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, O, make a cable over next 4 sts—to make a cable, slip next 2 sts on a double-pointed needle and place in back of work, k 2, knit sts from double-pointed needle. Repeat from \* around. **3rd, 4th and 5th rnds:** K around. **6th rnd:** \* K 2 tog, O, k 1, O, k 2 tog, k 4. Repeat from \* around. **7th and 8th rnds:** K around. Repeat the last 8 rnds until piece measures 2 inches, decreasing 10 sts evenly on last rnd (35 sts). **Next rnd:** K 1, \* O, k 2 tog. Repeat from \* around. Work in stockinette st (k each rnd) until piece measures 4 inches in all. Dec 6 sts evenly spaced on next rnd and every 4th rnd, until 11 sts remain. Break off, leaving an 8-inch length of yarn. Thread yarn into needle and run through remaining sts, pull up tightly and darn in end on wrong side. Run narrow ribbon through eyelets.

Repeat from \* across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. At end of 5th row ch 6, turn.

**BEADING . . .** Sl st in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), skip first 2 dc, \* dc in next dc, picot, skip next dc. Repeat from \* across, ending with dc in top of turning chain.

**EDGING . . .** Working down front make (picot, 2 sc in end st of next row) 6 times; picot, working in back loop only of each st on motifs, \* sc in next 2 sts, picot. Repeat from \* to lower edge. Continuing to work in back loop only, make sc in each st across lower edge. Complete Edging as for other side of front. Break off. Attach Blue to sleeve seam and work Edging as for Front. Break off.

Cut 1 yard of ribbon, pass through Beading and tie in a bow. Cut 4 strips of ribbon for ties and sew in place on front.
