CHADWICK'S RED HEART POMPADOUR, 3 Ply, Art. E.278: 5 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 261 Maize, or

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 3 balls of No. 9 Yellow.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 2.

4 yards of yellow ribbon, ½ inch wide.

GAUGE: 6 dc make 1 inch; 3 rows make 1 inch.

SACQUE . . . Starting at neck, ch 89 to measure 13 inches. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn (87 dc, counting turning chain). 2nd row: Skip first 2 dc, (dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc-shell pattern made-skip next dc) 14 times; dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Skip first 2 dc, * dc in next 2 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, skip next 2 dc. Repeat from * across to within last dc of last shell pattern, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Skip first 2 dc, * dc in each dc to center dc of next shell pattern, 3 dc in center dc, dc in each dc to within last dc of shell pattern, skip next 2 dc. Repeat from * across to within last dc of last shell pattern, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 5th row: Skip first 2 dc, * dc in each dc to center dc of next shell pattern, 5 dc in center dc, dc in each dc to within last dc of shell pattern, skip next 2 dc. Repeat from * across to within last dc of last shell pattern, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 6th to 11th rows incl: Repeat 4th and 5th rows alternately 3 more times. 12th row: Skip first 2 dc, dc in each dc across to center dc of next shell pattern, 3 dc in center dc, dc in each dc to within last dc of shell pattern, skip next 2 dc, dc in each dc across to center dc of next shell pattern, 3 dc in center dc, dc in each dc across to within last dc of shell pattern, skip next 3 shell patterns and first dc of next shell pattern, dc in next dc (armhole), work across 4 shell patterns, skip next 3 shell patterns and first dc of next shell pattern, work across last 2 shell patterns, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 13th row: Repeat 5th row. 14th to 21st rows incl: Repeat 4th and 5th rows alternately. Break off at end of 21st row.

SLEEVE . . . With wrong side of 11th row facing, attach yarn to center of underarm. 1st row: Ch 3, dc in base of next dc on underarm, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, work in pattern around armhole to within last dc of shell pattern,

dc at base of next dc on underarm. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, work in pattern around Sleeve to within last dc on last shell pattern. Join to top of ch-3. Ch 3, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Skip next dc, dc in next dc, work in pattern around Sleeve to within last dc of shell pattern. Join to top of ch-3. Break off at end of 4th row. Work other Sleeve in same way.

BEADING . . . Attach yarn to neck edge. 1st row: Sc in each ch across. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip first 2 sc, dc in next sc, * ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc. Repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn.

EDGING... Working along neck edge, sc in first dc, * draw loop on hook up ½ inch, thread over, draw loop through, insert hook between single and double loops and draw a loop through, thread over and draw through 2 loops on hook (knot st made), sc in next sp. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in 3rd ch of turning chain. Work in knot st pattern evenly along front edge. Now work a row of double knot sts closely along lower edge—to make a double knot st, make 2 knot sts between sc's. Complete other front edge to correspond. Join and break off.

Attach yarn to inner edge of Sleeve and work as for lower edge of Sacque.

Cut 1 yard of ribbon and lace through Beading at neck.

CAP . . . Starting at back, ch 4. 1st rnd: 9 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join to top of starting chain. Ch 3, turn. 2nd and 3rd rnds: Dc in same place as sl st, 2 dc in each dc around. Join. Ch 3, turn. 4th rnd: Dc in same place as sl st, * dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. Ch 3, turn. 5th rnd: Dc in each dc around. Join. Ch 3, turn. 6th rnd: Work as for 4th rnd. Now work in rows as follows: 1st row: Dc in next 75 dc. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd row 5 more times. 8th row: Skip first dc, dc in front loop of each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn (back loop of dc is right side of Cap). 9th row: Work as for 2nd row. Now work across neck edge as follows: 1st row: Sc closely across, holding in to fit. Ch 1, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Do not ch 1 and turn at end of 3rd row. Sc closely across front of Cap holding in to fit. Break off.

EDGING . . . 1st row: Attach yarn to first sc on front of Cap, in next sc make sc and dc (group st made), * skip next sc, group st in next sc. Repeat from * across. Break off. 2nd row: Attach yarn to first sc on previous row, group st in same sc, group st in each sc across. Break off.

RUFFLE . . . With front of Cap facing, attach yarn to back loop of first

free dc on 7th row, ch 3 and, working across row, dc in back loop of the next 3 dc, * 3 dc in back loop of next dc, dc in back loop of next 4 dc. Repeat from * across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in next 4 dc, * 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, skip next 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last 4 dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Skip first dc, dc in next 6 dc, * 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, skip next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last 6 dc, dc in top of turning chain. Turn. 4th row: * Make a double knot st, skip next dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Sew Ruffle to Cap at each side. Cut 14 inches of ribbon and lace through first row of Ruffle. Sew ends securely. Cut 2 strips of ribbon, each 13 inches long. Sew in place for ties. Cut remaining ribbon in half and make 2 rosettes. Sew one to each side of Cap.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 3 (3 mm. size).

4 yards of narrow ribbon.

GAUGE: 6 sts make 1 inch; 9 rows make 1 inch.

BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS:

Sizes	2	3
Chest	20"	22"
Length from shoulder	to lower	edge
Length of side seam	11½"	12"
Length of sleeve seam	7"	7½"

BACK . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 127 sts 133 sts

Now work 4 rows in garter st (k each row). Next row: * K 1, O, k 2 tog. Repeat from * across. Work 5 more rows in garter st.

Work in pattern as follows: 1st row: P 1, * O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, p 1. Repeat from * across. 2nd row: K 1, * p 5, k 1. Repeat from * across. 3rd row: P 1, * k 1, O, k 3 tog, O, k 1, p 1. Repeat from * across. 4th row: Repeat 2nd row. The last 4 rows constitute pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures in all 1034" 1114"

To Shape Armhole: Bind off 2 sts at beginning of next row, then dec 1 st at armhole edge twice. Work in pattern without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping ending at front edge

Block to measurements. Sew sleeve and side seams. Thread ribbon through beading on fronts, lower edge, waist, neckband and cuffs, allowing for ties.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

1 yard of blue ribbon, ¼ inch wide. A small pearl button.

GAUGE: 10 dc make 1 inch; 4 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at neck with White, ch 56. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first sc, dc in next 9 sc, * ch 1, skip next 2 sc, in next sc make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made); ch 1, skip next 2 sc, dc in next 10 sc. Repeat from * across. Ch 3, turn. 3rd to 6th rows incl: Skip first dc, * dc in each dc across to next ch-1 sp, dc in sp, ch 1, shell in sp of next shell (shell made over shell), ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp. Repeat from * across. Dc in top of turning chain. Break off at end of 6th row. Turn. 7th row: Attach White to first dc following first shell on previous row, ch 3, dc in each dc across to next ch-1 sp, dc in sp, ch 1, shell over shell, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in each dc across to next ch-1 sp. Ch 3, turn. Work in pattern until 19 dc rows in all have been completed. Break off.

EDGING . . . **1st row**: Attach White to top of turning chain at beginning of 6th row, sc in same place, (ch 2, skip next 2 dc, shell in next dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc) twice; ch 2, shell over shell, ch 2, sc in base of first st on 7th row, (ch 2, skip next row, shell in end st of next row, ch 2, skip next row, sc in end st of next row) 3 times; ch 2, skip next row, in end st of next row make (2 dc, ch 2)

twice and 2 dc; (ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, shell in next dc) 5 times; ch 2, sc in first dc of next shell, ch 2, shell over same shell, ch 2, skip next dc of same shell, sc in next dc, ch 2, shell in next dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc. Complete row as for other side. Break off. Attach Blue to first sc on previous row, sc closely around entire Bib. Break off

STRAP . . . Starting at center with White, ch 44. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 6 for buttonhole, working along opposite side of starting chain, make dc in each ch across. Break off. 2nd row: Attach Blue to first st of previous row; cs in same place, sc in each dc across, 7 sc in ch-6 sp, sc in each remaining dc across to end of row. Break off.

Sew Strap in place. Sew button to other side to correspond. Cut 2 pieces of ribbon 4 inches long and lace through sps at each side of bib. Sew ends in place. Lace remaining ribbon through spaces at center and tie into a bow at top.

- 1½ yards of lavender ribbon, ½ inch wide.
- 3 yards of lavender ribbon, ½ inch wide.

GAUGE: 1 shell pattern makes 1 inch; 3 rows make 1 inch.

SACQUE—Back . . . Starting at bottom make a chain 10½ inches long. 1st row: In 6th ch from hook make dc, half dc and sc; skip next 2 ch, in next ch make sc, half dc and dc (shell pattern made); * skip next 2 ch, in next ch make dc, half dc and sc; skip next 2 ch, in next ch make sc, half dc and dc (another shell pattern made). Repeat from * across until 9 patterns in all have been made, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip first sc, (in next sc make dc, half dc and sc; in next sc make sc, half dc and dc) 9 times; skip next ch, sc in next ch. Ch 4, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 7 inches. Ch 35 at end of last row for Sleeve. Attach a separate piece of yarn to 3rd ch of turning chain on opposite end of row, ch 33 for other Sleeve. Break off.

Pick up main yarn and work in pattern as follows: In 6th ch from hook make dc, half dc and sc; skip next 2 ch, in next ch make sc, half dc and dc; skip next 2 ch, in next ch make dc, half dc and sc; in next ch make sc, Continued on page 9

C-269 . . . Continued from page 2 decreasing until piece measures from

half dc and dc. Continue working across chain in pattern to within last 2 ch. Work in pattern across next 9 shell patterns, skip 2 ch on next sleeve foundation chain and work in pattern across chain, ending with sc in last ch. Ch 4, turn. Continue working in pattern until Sleeve measures 3½ inches.

To Shape Neck: Work in pattern across next 8 shell patterns, sc in sp between last shell pattern and next shell pattern. Ch 4, turn. Work in pattern for 4 more rows. Ch 17 at end of last row (neck edge). Work in pattern across chain and 8 shell patterns. Continue to work in pattern until sleeve measures 71/2 inches in all, ending at front edge. Now work in pattern over next 5 shell patterns (this is front) until piece measures 7 inches from sleeve edge. Break off. Skip 3 shell patterns on neck edge, attach yarn to first dc on next shell pattern, ch 4 and work in pattern for 5 rows. Attach a separate piece of yarn to opposite end of last row, ch 15. Break off. Pick up main yarn and complete other side to correspond. Sew up side and sleeve seams.

Attach yarn to wrist edge and work as follows: 1st rnd: Sc closely around, holding in to fit. Join with sl st to first sc. 2nd rnd: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join and break off. Work around other Sleeve in same way.

BEADING . . . Attach yarn to neck edge. 1st row: Sc closely around neck. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip first 2 sc, * dc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Attach yarn to lower front edge, so closely along front, around neck and along other front. Break off. Cut 27 inches of the wider ribbon. Pass ribbon through Beading and tie in a bow.

CAP... Starting at back make a chain 15 inches long. Work in pattern until row measures 12 inches. Ch 5, turn. Continue to work in pattern until piece measures 6 inches from starting chain, ch 1 at end of last row. Next row: Sc closely across front of Cap, holding in slightly. Ch 1, turn. Following row: Sc in first sc, * skip next 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Fold scalloped edge back 1¼ inches. Sew in place at each end. Fold piece lengthwise and working through both thicknesses, sc closely across back of Cap. Break off.

Attach yarn at front edge of Cap and work as follows: 1st row: Sc closely across neck edge holding it in to fit. Ch 1, turn. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rows: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 4th row.

Break off at end of 4th row.

Cut remainder of wider ribbon in half and sew in place for ties. Cut a piece of narrow ribbon 13 inches long and pass through sps below scalloped edge at front of Cap. Sew ends in place. Make a rosette with remainder of ribbon and sew to Cap.

To Shape Top of Sleeve and Shoulder: Bind off 14 (14, 18) sts at the beginning of row. Work one more row. Bind off remaining 23 (26, 29) sts.

RIGHT FRONT . . . Work to correspond with Left Front, reversing shapings.

PANTS . . . With No. 1 knitting pins, cast on 16 sts. With right side of work facing pick up and knit onto same needle along waist of Back 61 (69, 77) sts, cast on 16 sts. There are 93 (101, 109) sts on needle. Work in ribbing as follows: 1st row: P 1, * k 1, p 1. Repeat from * across. 2nd row: K 1, * p 1, k 1. Repeat from * across. Work in ribbing as established for 1 inch, ending with first row. Next row: K 6, (inc 1 st in next st) 8 times; k 1, p 1. On Size 2 only, k 4; On Size 3 only, k 8; On all Sizes, (k 1, inc 1 st in next st) 30 times; k 1 (5, 9) sts, p 1, k 1, (inc 1 st in next st) 8 times; k 6. There are on needle 139 (147, 155) sts.

Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work as follows: 1st row (wrong side of work): K 4, p 19, k 1, p 91 (99, 107) sts, k 1, p 19, k 4. 2nd row: K 23, p 1, k 91 (99, 107) sts, p 1, k 23. Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures from last row of ribbing, ending with a purl row $7\frac{1}{2}$ (8, $8\frac{1}{2}$) inches.

To Shape Leg: Knit first 23 sts and place these sts just worked onto a spare needle, bind off next 4 sts, k across to last 23 sts, place these last 23 sts onto a spare needle. Turn. Bind off 4 sts at the beginning of next row and p across. Still working in stockinette st, bind off 4 sts at the beginning of each row, until 37 sts remain. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Work in stockinette st over remaining 33 sts for 4 rows for hem of crotch. Bind off. Attach yarn to inner edge of one set of 23 sts on spare needle and, keeping border in garter st as established, bind off 4 sts at the beginning of next row and every other row until 3 sts remain. Bind off. Work other side to correspond.

with No. 2 knitting pins, cast on 33 sts. Work in stockinette st for 4 rows. Still working in stockinette st, cast on 4 sts at the beginning of each row until there are 49 (57, 65) sts on needle. Now cast on 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Work as follows:

1st row: K across. 2nd row: K 4, p across to last 4 sts, k 4. Repeat last 2 rows for ½ (1¼, ½) inches, ending with 2nd row. Next row: K 2, bind off 2 sts, k across to last 4 sts, bind off 2 sts, k 2. Following row: K 2, cast on 2 sts, p across to last 2 sts, cast on 2 sts, k 2. Work in stockinette st, keeping borders in garter st and mak-

ing a set of buttonholes as before every $1\frac{1}{4}$ ($1\frac{1}{2}$, $1\frac{3}{4}$) inches thereafter until piece is long enough to reach to first row of ribbing at the waist, ending with a purl row. Next row: K 4, * k 2 tog, k 1. Repeat from * to last 3 (5, 7) sts, k 3 (5, 7) sts.

Change to No. 1 knitting pins and, still making a set of buttonholes as indicated, work in ribbing as follows: 1st row (wrong side of work): K 4, * p 1, k 1. Repeat from * to last 5 sts, p 1, k 4. 2nd row: K 4, * k 1, p 1. Repeat from * to last 5 sts, k 5. Work in ribbing as established for 1 inch.

Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work in stockinette st, keeping borders in garter st and making buttonholes as indicated until 10 (9, 9) sets of buttonholes have been completed, ending with a knit row. Knit 4 rows. Bind off.

NECKBAND... Sew up top of sleeves and shoulder seams. With right side of work facing and No. 1 knitting pins, pick up and knit around entire neck edge, including sts on stitch holder 71 (79, 87) sts. Work in ribbing as for back waistband until piece measures 1 inch. Bind off in ribbing.

SLEEVE BAND... With right side of work facing and No. 1 knitting pins, pick up and knit along cuff edge 42 (48, 54) sts. Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for ½ inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

HEMS . . . With right side of work facing, attach yarn to the purl st at side edge of back of left leg and pick up and knit 38 (42, 46) sts along leg opening to within crotch. 1st row: P across. 2nd row: K 2 tog, k across. Repeat last 2 rows once. Purl 1 row. Bind off. With right side of work facing, attach yarn to first st of garter st border and pick up and knit 28 sts to within the purl st at side edge. 1st row: P across. 2nd row: K across to last 2 sts, k 2 tog. Repeat the last 2 rows once. Purl 1 row. Bind off. Work hems for back of right leg to correspond, reversing shapings. With right side of work facing, attach yarn to inner point of right leg opening on Front Panel and pick up and knit 16 sts to within crotch. 1st row: P across. Work in stockinette st for 4 more rows. Bind off. Work other side to correspond.

Block to measurements. Sew side and sleeve seams of bodice. Fold front parts along purl stitch to front and sew top of front parts to waist. Fold hems of crotch and stitch in place. Seam back crotch and crotch of Front Panel together. Turn under all hems and stitch in place. Make a row of sc along front openings of bodice, making five ch-5 buttonloops evenly spaced on right side of front edge (last buttonloop should be ½ inch from top of ribbing). Sew buttons to inside of left front edge opposite each buttonloop. Buttonhole stitch around buttonholes. Sew buttons to correspond with buttonholes.
