

# Shower Set One



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## C-91 . . . . . Cardigan

Illustrated on Centerspread

Infant Size 2

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277:** 2 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) each of No. 1 White and No. 679 Nile Green.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins,** 1 pair No. 2 (2 $\frac{3}{4}$  mm. size) and 1 pair No. 3 (3 mm. size).

4 small buttons.

**GAUGE:** 10 sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

**BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS:** Chest—20 inches; Length from shoulder to lower edge—10 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches; Length of side seam—6 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches; Length of sleeve seam—3 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

**BACK . . .** Starting at lower edge with Nile Green and No. 2 knitting pins, cast on 100 sts. Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Change to No. 3 knitting pins, attach White and work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** (K 4 White, k 2 Nile Green) 16 times; k 4 White. **2nd row:** P 3 White, (p 2 Nile Green, p 4 White) 7 times; p 2 Nile Green, p 6 White, (p 2 Nile Green, p 4 White) 7 times; p 2 Nile Green, p 3 White. **3rd row:** K 2 White, (k 2 Nile Green, k 4 White) 7 times; k 2 Nile Green, k 8 White, (k 2 Nile Green, k 4 White) 7 times; k 2 Nile Green, k 2 White. **4th row:** P 1 White, (p 2 Nile Green, p 4 White) 16 times; p 2 Nile Green, p 1 White. **5th row:** (K 2 Nile Green, k 4 White) 8 times; k 4 Nile Green, (k 4 White, k 2 Nile Green) 8 times. **6th row:** P 1 Nile Green, (p 4 White, p 2 Nile Green) 8 times; p 2 White, (p 2 Nile Green, p 4 White) 8 times; p 1 Nile Green. The last 6 rows constitute pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches, ending with 2nd row of pattern.

**To Shape Sleeves:** Keeping continuity of pattern, cast on 26 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. There are on needle 152 sts. Place a marker and work in pattern until piece measures 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches from marker.

**To Shape Top of Sleeves and Shoulders:** Bind off 26 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Bind off 17 sts at the beginning of following 4 rows. Bind off remaining 32 sts for back of neck.

**LEFT FRONT . . .** Starting at lower edge with Nile Green and No. 2 knit-

ting pins, cast on 59 sts and work in ribbing as follows: **1st row:** \* K 1, p 1. Repeat from \* to last st, k 1. **2nd row:** \* P 1, k 1. Repeat from \* to last st, p 1. Repeat the last 2 rows until piece measures  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Change to No. 3 knitting pins, attach White and work in pattern as follows: **Next row:** (K 4 White, k 2 Nile Green) 8 times; k 4 White. Place the last 7 sts on safety pin to be worked later for Band. Turn and work on remaining 52 sts as follows: **Next row:** P 1 Nile Green, (p 4 White, p 2 Nile Green) 8 times; p 3 White. Work in pattern as established until piece measures 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches, ending with 2nd row of pattern.

**To Shape Sleeve:** Cast on 26 sts at the beginning of next row, work in pattern to last 2 sts, k 2 tog. Work in pattern, decreasing 1 st at front edge every other row 18 times in all, ending at sleeve edge.

**To Shape Top of Sleeve and Shoulder:** Bind off 26 sts at the beginning of next row. Bind off 17 sts at same edge every other row, twice.

**RIGHT FRONT . . .** Starting at lower edge with Nile Green and No. 2 knitting pins, work in ribbing as for Left Front until piece measures  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Change to No. 3 knitting pins and work in pattern as follows: **Next row:** K 1, p 1, k 1, O (buttonhole), k 2 tog, p 1, k 1, place these 7 sts on a safety pin, attach White and work on remaining 52 sts in pattern as follows: (K 4 White, k 2 Nile Green) 8 times; k 4 White. **Following row:** P 3 White, (p 2 Nile Green, p 4 White) 8 times; p 1 Nile Green. Work in pattern as established to correspond with Left Front, reversing shaping.

**RIGHT FRONT BAND . . .** Slip 7 sts from safety pin on to a No. 2 knitting pin, attach Nile Green and work in ribbing, making a buttonhole as before every 1 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches thereafter, measuring from first buttonhole, until 4 buttonholes in all have been made. Continue in ribbing until piece measures 13 inches. Bind off in ribbing.

**LEFT FRONT BAND . . .** Work as for Right Front Band, omitting buttonholes.

**SLEEVE BANDS . . .** Sew up shoulder seams. With right side of work facing, Nile Green and No. 2 knitting pins, pick up and knit 72 sts along cuff edge. Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Bind off in ribbing.

Block to measurements. Sew side and sleeve seams in one continuous seam. Sew short ends of Front Bands together and sew Front Bands in place. Sew buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

## C-88 . . . Sacque, Bonnet and Bootees

Illustrated on Centerspread

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277:** 4 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 261 Maize.

**J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64:** 1 ball of No. 26 Nile Green.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook** No. 4.

2 yards of yellow satin ribbon,  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch wide and 1 yard,  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch wide.

**GAUGE:** 4 sc and 3 sps make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

**SACQUE . . .** Starting at neck edge, ch 74. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 6 ch, (ch 2, dc in next 8 ch) 8 times. Ch 3, turn. **2nd to 7th rows incl:** Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, making dc, ch 2 and dc in each ch-2 sp, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **8th row:** Sc in first dc, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc) 6 times; \* ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 1, sc in next dc, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc) 9 times. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in last sp, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc) 6 times; ch 1, sc in top of turning chain. Ch 1, turn. Mark center sp at back. **9th row:** Sc in first sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 14 times; ch 12 for armhole, skip 17 sc, \* sc in next sc, ch 1. Repeat from \* to marked sp at back, in sp make (sc, ch 1) twice (1 sp increased), sc in next sc and work in pattern across to within last 32 sc, ch 12 for other armhole, skip 17 sc and complete row in pattern. Ch 1, turn. **10th row:** Sc in first sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 14 times; (ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch) 5 times; \* ch 1, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* across, working across other chain the same way. Ch 1, turn. **11th row:** Sc in first sc, \* ch 1, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn. **12th row:** Work as for last row, increasing 1 sp at center back as before. Continue to work in pattern, increasing 1 sp at center back on every 3rd row until piece measures 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches from underarm. Break off.

**SLEEVE . . . 1st rnd:** Attach yarn to center ch of underarm, sc in same place, ch 1 and work in pattern around, ending with ch 1, sl st in first sc. Ch 1, turn. **2nd rnd:** Work in pattern around. Join. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd rnd until sleeve measures 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Join. Ch 3, turn.

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**CUFF . . . 1st rnd:** Dc in each sc and each ch-1 sp around, decreasing 10 dc evenly around—to dec 1 dc, work off 2 dc as 1 dc. Join. Ch 3, turn. **2nd rnd:** Dc in each dc around. Join. Ch 1, turn. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each dc around. Join and break off. Work other sleeve to correspond.

**EDGING . . .** Attach yarn to lower right front and work in pattern of sc, ch 1 along front edge, ending with sc in first ch of starting chain at neck edge, ch 4, \* skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1. Repeat from \* across neck, ending with dc in 3rd ch from end of row, ch 4, skip next ch, sc in next ch, work along other side of front as before. Break off.

**RUFFLE . . .** Starting at long side, ch 187 to measure slightly longer than outer edge of Sacque at 7th row of yoke. **1st row:** In 4th ch from hook make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc; \* skip 2 ch, in next ch make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 4, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, \* ch 1, in next sp make dc, ch 2 and dc; (ch 1, dc in next dc) 4 times. Repeat from \* across, ending with dc in top of turning chain. Break off. **3rd row:** Attach Nile Green to first ch-1 sp, sc in same sp, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, ch 2, sc in same sp, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, mark last sc made with red thread, (ch 2, sc in next sp) 4 times; \* ch 2, sc in same sp, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, mark last sc made with a blue thread, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice; drop loop from hook, insert hook through red marked sc and draw dropped loop through—joining made—(ch 2, sc in next sp) twice; ch 2, sc in same sp, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, mark last sc made with a red thread, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, join to blue marked sc, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice. Repeat from \* across. Break off. Sew ruffle in place as illustrated. Cut 1 yard of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch ribbon and pass through sps at neck edge.

**BONNET . . .** Starting at center of back, ch 18. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 6 times; ch 2, join to top of ch 3. Ch 3, turn. **2nd to 5th rnds incl:** Dc in each dc around, making dc, ch 2 and dc in each ch-2 sp around. Join. Break off at end of 5th rnd.

**SIDE PIECE . . .** Attach yarn to any ch-2 sp, sc in same sp, \* (ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc) 5 times; ch 1, sc in next sp. Repeat from \* 5 more times. Ch 1, turn, thus leaving last dc group free for back of neck. **2nd row:** Work in pattern as for Sacque, increasing 5 sps evenly across. Ch 1, turn. **3rd row:** Work in pattern without increasing. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 3rd row until side piece measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Break off. Sc closely along neck edge. Break off.

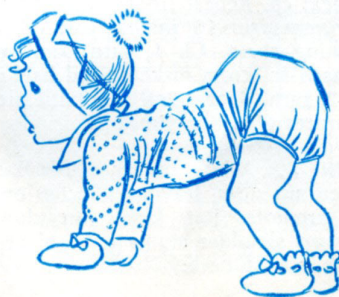
**RUFFLE . . .** Starting at long side, ch 75. Work as for Ruffle on Sacque. Sew in place as illustrated. Cut remaining  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch ribbon in half. Sew a piece to each side of front.

**BOOTE (Make 2)—Sole . . .** Starting at center, ch 20 (to measure  $3\frac{1}{4}$  inches). **1st rnd:** 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, tr in next 6 ch, 9 tr in last ch; now, working along opposite side of starting chain, make tr in next 6 ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in each remaining ch across, making 3 dc where first 3 dc were made. Sl st in top of starting chain. **2nd and 3rd rnds:** Sc in each st around, increasing as necessary at curved ends to keep work flat. Join. Break off at end of 3rd rnd.

**INSTEP . . .** Starting at front, ch 12. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 4 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 5 ch. Ch 1, turn. Hereafter pick up back loop only. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. **3rd row:** Sc in each sc to center sc, 3 sc in center sc, sc in each remaining sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until 12 rows have been completed.

**SIDE PIECE . . . 1st row:** Working through both loops, sc in first 6 sc. Ch 1, turn. Work over these sts only until piece is long enough to fit around sole. Break off. Sew last row to opposite side of Instep.

**CUFF . . . 1st row:** Attach yarn to end sc on first row of Side Piece, sc in same place, \* ch 1, skip end sc on next row, sc in end sc on next row. Repeat from \* around. Ch 1, turn. **2nd, 3rd and 4th rows:** Sc in first sc, \* ch 1, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn. At end of 4th row do not ch 1 to turn. Ch 5, sl st in point on Instep, ch 5, sl st in first sc. Ch 4, turn. Now work in rnds: **1st rnd:** \* Skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach yarn to center dc at back, ch 3, in same dc make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc; \* skip 1 dc, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc; skip 1 dc, in next dc make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc. Repeat from \* around. Join. **3rd and 4th rnds:** Work as for 2nd and 3rd rows of Sacque Ruffle. Cut a piece of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch ribbon 18 inches long. Lace through dc sps on cuff. Tie into a bow at front.



## C-89 . . . Hooded Bunting

Illustrated on Centerspread

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply, Art. E.232:** 16 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 679 Nile Green.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 6.**

2 yards of white satin ribbon,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide.

A 22-inch Crown Zipper, Style F.1.

**GAUGE:** 5 sps make 2 inches; 9 rows make 2 inches.

Starting at bottom make a chain 45 inches long (5 ch sts to 1 inch). **1st row:** Sc in 4th ch from hook, \* ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from \* across, until row measures 35 inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 2, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in first sp, \* ch 1, sc in next sp. Repeat from \* across. Ch 2, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 20 inches from starting chain. Now work in short rows for shoulder as follows: **1st row:** Work in pattern until row measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Turn. **2nd row:** Sl st in first sp (1 sp decreased), ch 2, sc in next sp. Continue in pattern across. Ch 2, turn. **3rd row:** Work in pattern without decreasing, ending with sc in last sp. Turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 4 more times (5 sps decreased). Break off. Attach yarn to opposite side of front and work other shoulder to correspond. Attach yarn to first free sp on back and work as follows: **1st row:** Ch 2, work in pattern across back, ending with sc in last free sp. Turn. **2nd row:** Work in pattern, decreasing 1 sp at each end of row. Ch 2, turn. **3rd row:** Work in pattern without decreasing. Turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 4 more times. Break off.

Sew up shoulder seams. Sew across bottom. Bind front edges with ribbon. Attach yarn to neck edge and sc closely around, drawing it in to fit. Sew zipper in place.

**FROG . . .** Make a chain  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches long. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off. Sew narrow ends together. Sew to right front of bunting  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches from top, crossing at end to form a 1-inch buttonloop. Make another piece the same way, having starting chain 6 inches long. Make a double knot at center to form button. Sew in place on opposite side of front, sew knot securely in place. Make 2 more frogs the same way. Sew to front of bunting, spacing  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches apart.

**HOOD . . .** Starting at front edge, ch 94 to measure 18 inches. **1st row:** Sc in 4th ch from hook, \* ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from \* across. Ch 2, turn. Work in pattern until piece measures 6 inches. Do not chain at end of last row. Turn. **Next row:** Sl st in first sp, in next sc and in next sp (2 sps decreased), ch 2, sc in next sp. Continue in pattern

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across to within last 2 sps. Turn. Repeat last row until 2 sps remain. Break off.

Sew up back seam of Hood. Bind front with ribbon. Sew Hood to Bunting.

**POMPONS . . .** Cut 2 circles of cardboard, each  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter. Then cut a circle  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch in diameter at center of each  $1\frac{1}{2}$ -inch circle. Place one cardboard circle on top of the other. \* Cut 4 strands of yarn, each about 4 yards long. Draw one end of these strands through center of circle from back, pass them over outer edge and draw them through center of circle again (thus covering cardboard). Continue in this manner until yarn is all used. Repeat from \* until center of circle is completely filled. With sharp scissors or razor cut yarn between the 2 cardboard circles at outer edge. Cut 2 strands of yarn about 6 inches long. Double these strands and slip between the 2 cardboard circles. Tie ends securely. Remove cardboards and trim Pompon evenly. Make 2 more Pompons same as this. Make 3 chains,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches and 3 inches long. Sew one end of chain to each Pompon and opposite end to Hood.

## C-86 . . . Petticoat and Dress Edgings

Illustrated on Centerspread

**COATS & CLARK'S TATTING-CROCHET,**  
Art. C.21, Size 70: 4 balls of No. 1  
White.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.**  
A baby dress and petticoat.

**PETTICOAT EDGING . . . 1st rnd:** Attach thread to bottom of petticoat and sc closely around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 5, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 2, dc in last dc made, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in next sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with picot loop, dc in last dc made, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in first sp, sc in same sp, \* ch 12, sc in next free sp. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

Work Edging all around neck, shoulders and armhole opening. Join and break off. Complete other armhole to correspond.

**DRESS EDGING . . .** Rip out hem of dress and cut away excess material, leaving  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch for hem. Sew hem neatly in place. **1st rnd:** Attach thread to bottom of dress and sc closely around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, \* ch 5, dc in last dc made, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 5, dc in last dc made, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, sc in same sp, \* ch 10, sc in next ch-2 sp. Repeat from \* around. Join. **4th rnd:** In each loop around make (3 sc, ch 3) 3 times and 3 sc. Join and break off.

Work around sleeves the same way.

**NECK EDGING . . . 1st row:** With wrong side facing, attach thread to neck edge, sc closely across. Ch 5, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first 3 sc, dc in next sc and work in pattern across, ending with ch 2, dc in last sc. Turn. **3rd row:** Sl st in first sp, sc in same sp, \* ch 10, sc in next ch-2 sp. Repeat from \* across. Turn. **4th row:** Work as for 4th rnd of dress edging. Break off.
