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C-84 . . . Circus Clown

Illustrated on Centerspread

CHADWICK'S RED HEART SOCK & SWEATER YARN, 3 Ply, Shrink-and-Stretch Resist Finish, Art. E.255: 4 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 802 Baby Blue; 2 skeins of No. 1 White and 1 skein each of No. 789 Bittersweet and No. 686 Paddy Green.

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply, Art. E.245: 2 balls (1/3 oz. balls) of No. 253 Tangerine.

Few yards each of Black, Red and Rose "Knit-Cro-Sheen."

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 5 (for yarn).

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 (for "Knit-Cro-Sheen").

A yard of red trimmed organdy ruffling. Cardboard for feet. Cotton batting for stuffing.

GAUGE: 5 sc make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

BODY . . . Starting at neck with double strand of Baby Blue, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** * 2 sc in next sc (1 sc increased), sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. **4th rnd:** Inc 7 sc evenly around. Work without increasing until piece measures 3 inches. Inc 7 sc evenly on each of next 4 rnds. Work without increasing until piece measures 5½ inches. Break off. Stuff firmly with cotton. Sew together across bottom.

LEG (Make 2) . . . Starting at ankle with double strand of Blue, ch 24. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Sc in each ch around. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Repeat 2nd rnd until piece measures 2 inches. Inc 6 sc evenly around. Work without increasing until piece measures 3½ inches. Dec 6 sc evenly around on each of next 2 rnds—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc. Work without decreasing until piece measures 4½ inches. Inc 6 sc evenly around. Work without increasing until piece measures 7½ inches. Break off. Stuff firmly and sew edge together. Sew to Body.

FOOT (Make 2) . . . Starting at narrow end with double strand of Green, ch 11. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 2½ inches. Break off. Attach single strand of Tangerine to last sc made. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row 8 more times. Break off. Attach double strand of

Green and work until this section measures 2½ inches. Break off. Cut a piece of cardboard 1¾ x 3 inches. Fold piece over cardboard centering Tangerine section. Attach 2 strands of Green to fold and sc through both thicknesses around 3 open sides. Break off. Sew to end of Leg.

ARM (Make 2) . . . Starting at top with double strand of Blue, ch 18. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st and 2nd rnds:** Work as for first and 2nd rnds of Leg. Sc in each sc around until piece measures 4½ inches. Dec 6 sc evenly around. Break off. Stuff firmly and sew in place on Body.

HAND (Make 2) . . . With double strand of Green, ch 10. Work as for Foot until piece measures 1¾ inches. Break off. Fold piece in half. Attach double strand of Green and sc through both thicknesses around 3 sides, leaving one end open. Now ch 6 (for thumb), sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off. Stuff firmly and sew to arm.

HEAD . . . Starting at top with double strand of White, work as for Body until 4 rnds have been completed. **Next rnd:** Sc in each sc around. **Following rnd:** Inc 6 sc evenly around. Repeat last 2 rnds until 18 rnds in all have been made. Work without increasing until piece measures 4 inches in all. Dec 6 sc on each of next 5 rnds. Work without decreasing until piece measures 6 inches. Break off. Stuff firmly and gather opening slightly. Sew to Body.

EAR (Make 2) . . . Starting at center with double strand of White, ch 5. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, 2 sc in last ch; now, working across opposite side of chain make sc in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across, making 2 sc in each of 2 sc at rounded end. Ch 1, turn. **3rd, 4th and 5th rows:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 5th row. Sew straight edge to Head.

JACKET—Back . . . Starting at lower edge with single strand of Bittersweet, make a chain 11 inches long. **1st row:** In 2nd ch from hook make sc and half dc, * skip next ch, make sc and half dc in next ch. Repeat from * across until row measures 10 inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** In each sc across make sc and half dc. Ch 2, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 6 inches. Break off.

FRONT . . . Work exactly as for Back. Sew up sides, leaving 3 inches open for armhole. Put Jacket on clown. Sew up shoulder seams until piece is tight around neck.

SLEEVE (Make 2) . . . Starting at lower edge make a chain 6½ inches long. Work exactly as for Back until piece measures 5 inches. Sew underarm seam. Sew Sleeve to Jacket. Gather lower edge of Sleeve to fit closely around wrist. Tack Sleeves to shoulders of Body so that Front and Back of Jacket will be bloused.

HAIR . . . Cut a piece of cardboard 3 inches long. Wind a strand of Green 60 times around cardboard. Sew the strands securely across middle of one side. Cut strands in middle of other side. Sew in place above ear. Make another piece the same way.

HAT . . . Starting at center of crown with single strand of Tangerine, ch 2. Work as for Body until 3 rnds have been made. Work without increasing until piece measures 1¾ inches. Now inc 14 sc evenly around. **Next rnd:** Sc in each sc around. Break off. Stuff crown and sew to Head.

NOSE . . . With single strand of Rose "Knit-Cro-Sheen," ch 2. Work as for Body until 3 rnds have been made. Work without increasing for 3 more rnds. Break off. Stuff and sew in place.

With Black "Knit-Cro-Sheen," embroider eyes; with Red embroider mouth. Gather organdy ruffle to fit around neck and wrists and sew in place.

across to within last 2 sps. Turn. Repeat last row until 2 sps remain. Break off.

Sew up back seam of Hood. Bind front with ribbon. Sew Hood to Bunting.

POMPONS . . . Cut 2 circles of cardboard, each 1½ inches in diameter. Then cut a circle ½ inch in diameter at center of each 1½-inch circle. Place one cardboard circle on top of the other. * Cut 4 strands of yarn, each about 4 yards long. Draw one end of these strands through center of circle from back, pass them over outer edge and draw them through center of circle again (thus covering cardboard). Continue in this manner until yarn is all used. Repeat from * until center of circle is completely filled. With sharp scissors or razor cut yarn between the 2 cardboard circles at outer edge. Cut 2 strands of yarn about 6 inches long. Double these strands and slip between the 2 cardboard circles. Tie ends securely. Remove cardboards and trim Pompon evenly. Make 2 more Pompons same as this. Make 3 chains, 1½ inches, 2½ inches and 3 inches long. Sew one end of chain to each Pompon and opposite end to Hood.

C-85 Pink Afghan

Illustrated on Centerspread

36 x 52 inches

CHADWICK'S RED HEART POMPADOUR, 3 Ply, Art. E.278: 26 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 723 Baby Pink.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 5.

6 yards of pink satin ribbon, 2½ inches wide.

GAUGE: 13 sts make 2 inches; 5 rows make 1 inch. Each block measures 4 inches square.

PLAIN BLOCK (Make 58) . . . Starting at bottom, ch 23. **1st row:** Insert hook in 2nd ch from hook and draw up a loop; retaining all loops on hook, draw up a loop in each ch across (23 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop, * yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Repeat from * across. The loop which remains on the hook always counts as the first st of next row. **2nd row:** Insert hook under 2nd vertical bar and draw loop through; retaining all loops on hook, draw up a loop in each vertical bar across to within last vertical bar. Insert hook through last vertical bar and the stitch directly behind it and draw a loop through (this gives a firm edge to this side). Complete as for 2nd half of first row. Repeat 2nd row until piece is square. Sl st in each vertical bar across. Break off.

Attach yarn to any corner, 3 sc in same corner, sc closely around, making 3 sc in each corner. Join and break off.

SMOCKED BLOCK (Make 59) . . . Starting at bottom, ch 23. **1st row:** Work in plain afghan stitch. **2nd row:** Retaining all loops on hook insert hook under 2nd vertical bar and draw loop through, * holding yarn in front of work, insert hook through next vertical bar and draw a loop through from front of work (purl st made), make a plain afghan st in next vertical bar. Repeat from * across. Complete 2nd half of row in pattern. **3rd row:** * Make a purl st in next vertical bar, plain afghan st in next vertical bar. Repeat from * across. Complete row in pattern. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until piece is square. Sl st in

each vertical bar across, keeping pattern. Break off. Complete as for Plain Block.

To Join Blocks: Starting and ending with a smocked block, sew 7 smocked and 6 plain blocks together to form first strip. Starting and ending with a plain block, sew 7 plain and 6 smocked blocks together to form second strip. Sew second strip to first strip. Sew remaining blocks together in alternate pattern as before. Sew strips together. Sew ribbon around afghan, mitering corners.

Block to measurements.

C-93 . . Buttoned Soaker

Illustrated on Centerspread

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 3 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 1 White.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 1 (2½ mm. size) and 1 pair No. 2 (2¾ mm. size).

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 2.

8 buttons.

GAUGE: 8 sts make 1 inch; 14 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at front waistband with No. 1 knitting pins, cast on 78 sts. **1st row:** * K 2, p 2. Repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2. **2nd row:** * P 2, k 2. Repeat from * to last 2 sts, p 2. Work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 1½ inches, increasing 13 sts evenly spaced on last row (91 sts). Change to No. 2 knitting pins and work in moss st pattern as follows: **1st row:** * K 1, p 1. Repeat from * across, ending with k 1. Repeat first row until piece measures 7½ inches in all. Keeping continuity of pattern, bind off 4 sts at beginning of next 6 rows. Then bind off 3 sts at beginning of following 12 rows. Work in pattern over remaining 31 sts for ¾ inch. Keeping continuity of pattern, cast on 3 sts at beginning of next 12 rows, then cast on 4 sts at beginning of following 6 rows. At beginning of next 2 rows, cast on 5 sts for buttonhole overlap (101 sts). Work in pattern until piece measures ½ inch from last increase row. **Next row:** K 1, p 1, k 1, bind off next 3 sts. Work in pattern across to last 6 sts, bind

off 3 sts, k 1, p 1, k 1. **Following row:** K 1, p 1, k 1, cast on 3 sts, work in pattern to last 3 sts, cast on 3 sts, k 1, p 1, k 1. Continue working in pattern until piece measures 7½ inches in all from center of crotch, making 2 more buttonholes at both ends in same manner as before 2½ inches apart.

Change to No. 1 knitting pins and work across in pattern, decreasing 11 sts evenly spaced. Work in ribbing of k 2, p 2 for 1½ inches, making a buttonhole at both ends when ribbing measures 1 inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing. With crochet hook work a row of sl st along edges and around leg openings. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

C-87 . . Sheet and Pillow Case Insertions

Illustrated on Centerspread

COATS & CLARK'S TATTING-CROCHET, Art. C.21, Size 70: 10 balls of No. 1 White.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

A crib sheet and pillow case.

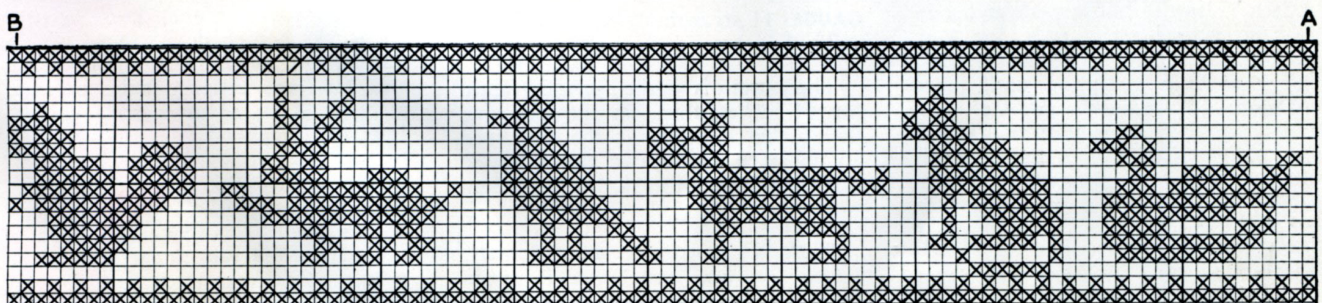
GAUGE: 8 sps make 1 inch; 8 rows make 1 inch.

SHEET . . . Starting at "A" on chart, ch 60. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 5 ch (2 bls made), (ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch—sp made) 15 times; dc in next 6 ch (2 more bls made). Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next 3 dc (bl made over bl), ch 2, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc (sp made over bl), (ch 2, dc in next dc—sp made over sp) 8 times; 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc (bl made over sp), make 7 sps, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Starting with 3rd row follow chart to "B"; then follow chart from "A" to "B" until piece measures length desired. Break off.

Pin insertion in place on sheet. Cut out material in back of insertion, leaving ¼ inch for hem on each side. Sew hems and insertion neatly in place.

PILLOW CASE . . . Work as for sheet until piece measures same as pillow case.

Sew narrow ends together and complete as for sheet.



C-90 Bunny Bib

Illustrated on Centerspread

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 76 Robinette and No. 1 White; or

CLARK'S O.N.T. MERCERIZED BEDSPREAD COTTON, Art. B.504: 1 ball each of No. 1 White and a color of your own choice.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Scraps of Rose embroidery floss.

A small white button.

GAUGE: 8 sc make 1 inch; 8 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at bottom with Robinette, make a chain 8 inches long. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across until row measures 6½ inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 6 inches.

To Shape Top: **1st row:** Sc in first 8 sc. Ch 1, turn. **2nd to 8th rows incl:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. **9th row:** Work off first 2 sc as 1 sc (1 sc decreased), sc in each sc across, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. **10th row:** 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to within last 2 sc, dec 1 sc. Ch 1, turn. Repeat last 2 rows alternately until 33 rows have been completed. **34th row:** Sc in first 2 sc, ch 4 for buttonhole, skip 4 sc, sc in next 2 sc. Ch 1, turn. **35th row:** Sc in each sc and in each ch across. Break off.

Attach thread to opposite end of last complete row and work other side to correspond, omitting buttonhole. At end of last row do not break off but sc closely all around bib. Join and break off.

EDGING . . . 1st row: With wrong side of sc rnd facing, attach thread to first sc on neck at outer edge, sc in same place, * ch 4, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around to corresponding sc on opposite side. Turn. **2nd row:** 6 sc in each loop around. Break off.

FIRST BUNNY (Make 2)—Body . . . Starting at center with White, ch 12. **1st rnd:** 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next 7 ch, half dc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain make half dc in next ch, dc in next 7 ch, half dc in next ch. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each st around, making 2 sc in each sc of 3-sc group at opposite end. Join. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, * dc in next sc, 2 dc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, sc in next 15 dc, 7 dc in next dc (arm), sc in next 9 dc, 7 dc in next dc (leg), sc in next 3 dc, 7 dc in next dc, sc in next 9 dc, 7 dc in next dc, sc in each remaining dc. Join and break off.

HEAD . . . Starting at center with White, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** * 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, sl st in first sc. **4th rnd:** Ch 10 for ear, sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next 4 sc, ch 10, make another ear, sc in each remaining sc around. Join and break off.

Sew Head to Body. Embroider eyes, nose and mouth as illustrated with scraps of Rose embroidery floss.

SECOND BUNNY—Body . . . Work as for Body of First Bunny until 3 rnds have been completed. **4th rnd:** Sc in each dc around. Join and break off.

HEAD . . . Work as for Head of First Bunny omitting embroidery.

TAIL . . . Starting at center with White, ch 2. **1st rnd:** Insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, thread over and draw thread through, draw through loop on hook, draw loop remaining on hook out to measure ½ inch (loop st made), retaining previous loop on hook, insert hook in same ch and complete a loop st. Continue making loop sts until ch is filled. Join and break off. Sew to Body. Sew Bunnies to bib. Sew button to back.

C-92 Bottle Cover

Illustrated on Centerspread

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 2 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 723 Baby Pink.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Double-pointed Sock Needles, 1 set No. 4 (3½ mm. size).

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 4.

¼ yard of white ribbon, ⅜ inch wide.

A few yards of White, Green and Yellow embroidery floss.

Use yarn double throughout.

GAUGE: 6 sts make 1 inch; 10 rnds make 1 inch.

Starting at bottom of cover, cast on 6 sts. Divide sts among 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts. Work in stockinette st (k each rnd) as follows: **1st rnd:** Knit around. **2nd rnd:** Inc 1 st in each st around (12 sts). **3rd rnd:** Knit around. **4th rnd:** * K 1, inc 1 st in next st. Repeat from * around (18 sts). Continue to work in this manner, increasing 6 sts every other rnd and always working 1 st more between increases until there are 42 sts on needle. **Next rnd:** Knit around.

Now work in moss st as follows: **1st rnd:** * K 1, p 1. Repeat from * around. **2nd rnd:** * P 1, k 1. Repeat from * around. Work in this manner for 8 more rnds. **Next rnd:** K 10,

work in moss st across next 32 sts. Repeat last rnd until piece measures 4¾ inches from first row of moss st. Now work in moss st only for 8 rnds. Bind off.

Attach double strand of yarn to top edge of cover. **1st rnd:** With crochet hook ch 4, skip 1 st, dc in next st, * ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st. Repeat from * around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in next sp, * ch 3, sc in last sc made, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Break off.

Lace ribbon through sps at top. Tie into a bow. With embroidery floss, embroider flowers (or baby's initials) on front panel as desired.

C-86 . . . Petticoat and Dress Edgings

Illustrated on Centerspread

COATS & CLARK'S TATTING-CROCHET, Art. C.21, Size 70: 4 balls of No. 1 White.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 14.

A baby dress and petticoat.

PETTICOAT EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach thread to bottom of petticoat and sc closely around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, * ch 5, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 2, dc in last dc made, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with picot loop, dc in last dc made, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in first sp, sc in same sp, * ch 12, sc in next free sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

Work Edging all around neck, shoulders and armhole opening. Join and break off. Complete other armhole to correspond.

DRESS EDGING . . . Rip out hem of dress and cut away excess material, leaving ⅛ inch for hem. Sew hem neatly in place. **1st rnd:** Attach thread to bottom of dress and sc closely around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, * ch 5, dc in last dc made, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, dc in last dc made, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, sc in same sp, * ch 10, sc in next ch-2 sp. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** In each loop around make (3 sc, ch 3) 3 times and 3 sc. Join and break off.

Work around sleeves the same way.

NECK EDGING . . . 1st row: With wrong side facing, attach thread to neck edge, sc closely across. Ch 5, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first 3 sc, dc in next sc and work in pattern across, ending with ch 2, dc in last sc. Turn. **3rd row:** Sl st in first sp, sc in same sp, * ch 10, sc in next ch-2 sp. Repeat from * across. Turn. **4th row:** Work as for 4th rnd of dress edging. Break off.
