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# C-73 . . . . Pussy Cat

### Illustrated on Page 23

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply, Art. E.232: 3 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 230 Yellow and 1 skein of No. 1 White.

A few yards each of Mid Rose and Black "Knit-Cro-Sheen."

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 6.

Teething ring rattle.

1 yard of blue grosgrain ribbon, 1½ inches wide.

Scraps of green and rose felt. Cotton batting for stuffing.

**GAUGE:** 5 sc make 1 inch; 5 rnds make 1 inch.

BODY . . . Starting at neck with Yellow, ch 2. 1st rnd: 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 3rd rnd: \* 2 sc in next sc (1 sc increased), sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. 4th to 10th rnds incl: Inc 6 sc evenly on each rnd. Work without increasing until piece measures 6 inches in all. Dec 7 sc evenly on each of next 6 rnds—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc. Join and break off. Stuff Body firmly with cotton. Sew up opening.

**HEAD** . . . Starting at front with White, ch 6. 1st rnd: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain, sc in each ch across. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 3rd rnd: Inc 6 sc evenly around. Break off. Attach Yellow to last sc made and inc 6 sc evenly on each rnd until piece measures 41/2 inches across the widest part. Place pin as marker on last rnd. Work without increasing until piece measures 2 inches from last increased rnd. Dec 6 sc evenly around on each rnd until 30 sc remain. Stuff firmly with cotton. Dec 6 sc on each of next 4 rnds. Sew up opening. Sew Head to Body.

LEG (Make 2) . . . Starting at foot with White, ch 9. 1st rnd: Work as for first rnd of Head. 2nd to 8th rnds incl: Sc in each sc around. Break off. Attach Yellow to last sc made and sc in each sc around for 3 rnds. Inc 3 sc evenly around on each of next 3 rnds. Work without increasing until piece measures 5½ inches in all. Dec 6 sc evenly on each of next 2 rnds. Stuff Leg firmly with cotton and sew up opening. Sew Leg to Body. Fold White section up to form foot and sew in place.

ARM (Make 2) . . . Work exactly as for Leg until 8 rnds have been com-

pleted. Break off. Attach Yellow and sc in each sc around until piece measures 43/4 inches in all. Break off. Stuff firmly with cotton, sew across top opening. Sew to Body.

EAR (Make 2) . . . Starting at point with White, ch 2. 1st row: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 4th row: 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. 5th to 8th rows ind: Repeat last 2 rows alternately 2 more times. 9th and 10th rows: Repeat 3rd row. Break off. Make another piece the same way, using Yellow. Sew White and Yellow pieces together and sew to Head.

TAIL . . . Starting at tip with White ch 2. 1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: Inc 3 sc evenly around. 3rd and 4th rnds: Sc in each sc around. Break off. 5th to 10th rnds incl: Attach Yellow and sc in each sc around. Next rnd: Inc 3 sc evenly around. Work without increasing until piece measures 6 inches in all. Stuff firmly and sew in place.

With Mid Rose "Knit-Cro-Sheen," embroider nose, mouth, pads of feet, and arms, as illustrated. With Black embroider whiskers. With White embroider background for eyes. Cut 2 oval pieces of green felt ¾ inch long for eyes. Sew in place with Black French knots. Cut a piece of rose felt 1 inch long. Sew in place for tongue. Tie ribbon around neck in a bow. Sew teething ring to arm.

# C-72 . . . Fringed Shawl

Illustrated on Page 23

Shawl measures approximately 44 inches square.

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply, Art. E.232: 13 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 1 White and 9 skeins of No. 227 Canary Yellow.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 4 (3½ mm. size).

**GAUGE:** 11 sts make 2 inches; 15 rows make 2 inches.

The pattern is worked in solid fabric for 44 inches, then, on the last row, the stitches indicated in the directions are dropped and drawn down to the cast-on stitches—this forms the openwork.

With White cast on 240 sts loosely. 1st to 4th rows incl: Work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row). Break

off White. 5th row: Attach Lt. Yellow and knit across. 6th to 9th rows incl: Work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row). Break off Lt. Yellow. 10th row: Attach White and purl across. 11th, 12th and 13th rows: Work in stockinette st. Break off White. 14th row: Attach Lt. Yellow and purl across. 15th to 18th rows incl: Work in stockinette st (p 1 row, k 1 row). Break off Lt. Yellow and attach White. Repeat last 18 rows until piece measures 44 inches, or shawl is square when measured. Bind off 2 sts loosely, \* drop next st, bind off 3 sts. Repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, bind off 2 sts (keeping st loose over dropped st). Let dropped sts run to cast on edge.

FRINGE . . . Cut 3 strands of White, each 14 inches long. Double these strands to form a loop, insert hook in stitch and pull loop through. Draw loose ends through loop and pull up tightly. Make a fringe evenly spaced ½ inch around all sides of shawl. Pick up 3 strands of first and second fringes and make a knot ½ inch down from edge of shawl. Pick up 3 strands of second and third fringes and make a knot ½ inch down at center of the two fringes, making 2 rows of knots in all. Trim ends evenly.

## C-71 . . . Baby Slippers

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 1 White and No. 65 Beauty Pink.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

3/4 yard pink satin ribbon, 1/4 inch wide.

GAUGE: Instep motif measures  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter; 10 dc make 1 inch.

White, ch 26. 1st rnd: 7 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across, 8 dc in last ch, working along opposite side of starting chain, dc in each ch across. Join with sl st to top of starting chain. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, 2 dc in next 8 dc, dc in each dc across to within dc preceding 8-dc group at rounded end, 2 dc in next 10 dc, dc in each dc across to within last dc, 2 dc in last dc. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Pink to same place as sl st, sc in each st around. Join and break off.

with Beauty Pink, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 12 sc in ring. Join. 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, \* 5 dc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join. 3rd

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#### Size 1 or 2

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 3 Ply, Art. E.277: 5 skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 1 White and 1 skein of No. 723 Baby Pink.

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 3.

3 small white buttons.

A yard of Lt. Green embroidery floss.

**GAUGE**: 6 sc make 1 inch; 7 rows make 1 inch.

YOKE—Back . . . Starting at lower edge with White, make a chain 13 inches long. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, until row measures 11½ inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Sl st in first 4 sc, sc in next sc and in each sc across to within last 4 sc. Ch 1, turn (4 sc decreased at each end of row). 4th row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 4th row until piece measures 3½ inches in all.

To Shape Shoulders: 1st row: Dec 7 sc, sc in next sc and in each sc across to within last 7 sc. Ch 1, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Repeat 3rd row of Yoke 2 more times. Break off.

Front (Make 2) . . . Starting at lower edge, make a chain 7 inches long. 1st row: Work as for first row of Back until row measures 53/4 inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Dec 4 sc, sc in next sc and in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 4th row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 4th row until piece measures 23/4 inches in all, ending at front edge.

To Shape Neck: 1st row: SI st in first 7 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across to within last sc. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Dec 1 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat last 2 rows once more. Now shape shoulder as for Back. Break off.

Sew shoulder seams and underarm

BODY . . . 1st row: Attach yarn to first st at front edge of Yoke and, working around lower edge, ch 4, \* dc in next st, ch 1. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Insert hook in 2nd ch from hook and draw loop through, insert hook in next ch and draw a loop through, insert hook in first dc (at base of ch-3) and draw a loop through, insert hook in next dc and draw a loop through, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook, \* ch 1 to fasten (star st), insert hook in fastening ch of star st just made and draw a loop through, insert hook

in last loop of same star st and draw a loop through, insert hook in do where last loop of previous star st was made and draw a loop through, insert hook in next dc and draw loop through, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook (another star st). Repeat from \* across, drawing last loop of last star st through 3rd ch of ch-4 on previous row. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip first fastening ch, \* dc in next fastening ch, ch 1. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows, until Body measures 11 inches, ending with 2nd row. Break off.

**SLEEVE (Make 2)...** Starting at wrist edge with White, ch 38. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 61/2 inches.

To Shape Top: 1st row: Dec 3 sc at beginning and end of row. Now dec 1 sc at beginning and end of every other row until piece measures 8½ inches in all. Break off.

Sew sleeve seams. Sew in Sleeves.

collar... Starting at neck edge with White, make a chain 11 inches long. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across until row measures 93/4 inches. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. 4th to 8th rows incl: Work as for 2nd row. Break off at end of 8th row.

EDGING . . . 1st row: Attach Pink to end of first row of Collar, sc closely across narrow edge, 3 sc in corner, sc in each sc across long edge, 3 sc in corner, sc closely across other narrow edge. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across, making 3 sc in center sc of each 3-sc group at corners. Break off. Sew Collar in place, easing in to fit.

BUTTONHOLE BAND . . . Attach White to neck edge of Right Front. 1st row: Sc closely across Front. Break off. Attach Pink to last sc made. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across, making 3 buttonholes evenly spaced on

Yoke—to make a buttonhole, ch 2, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Sc in each st across. Break off.

**BUTTON BAND** . . . Attach White to lower edge of Left Front and work as for Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

With Pink embroider 4 flowers on each Yoke Front. With Green embroidery floss, embroider leaves around flowers. Block lightly. Sew buttons in place.

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rnd: Ch 5, \* sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, ch 2, dc in next sc, ch 2. Repeat from \* around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-5. 4th rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, \* 3 sc in next sp, sc in next st. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

UPPER . . . Attach White to same place as sl st, ch 41, skip 15 sc, sl st in next sc. 1st rnd: Sc in next 10 sc, half dc in next sc, dc in next 9 sc, half dc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc, sc in each ch around. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in next st and in each st around. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Pink to same place as sl st, sc in same place, sc in each dc around. Join and break off. Attach White to same place as sl st. Repeat last 2 rnds 2 more times.

cuff....lst row: Attach Pink to first ch on opposite side of ch-41, sc in each ch across. Break off. 2nd row: Attach White to first sc made on previous row, ch 3, dc in next sc and in each sc across. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip first 2 dc, \* dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc. Repeat from \* across. Break off. 4th row: Attach Pink to last dc made, sc in same place, \* ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook (picot made). Repeat from \* across. Break off.

Pin Upper in place on Sole and attach Pink to any sc and sc closely around. Join and break off.

Lace ribbon through beading and tie into a bow. Make another slipper the same way.
