

Hats, Bags and accessories





Cover Girls

Beret . . . P.C. 1331

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS KNIT-CRO-SHEEN, 2 balls of any color.
 Bone Crochet Hook No. 8.
 1 yard each of 2 contrasting color ribbons.
 Wind thread into 4 equal balls.

Use 4 threads throughout.

SKULL CAP . . . Starting at center, ch 4. Join. **1st rnd:** 10 sc in ring. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. **4th rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **5th to 11th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around. Break off.

BERET . . . Starting at center, ch 4. Join. **1st rnd:** 11 sc in ring. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. **4th rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. **5th and 6th rnds:** Sc in each sc around. **7th rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around (88 sc). **8th to 18th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around. **19th rnd:** Sc in each sc around, decreasing 8 sc at equal distances apart — to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc.

Repeat the last rnd 5 more times (40 sc remain at end of last rnd). Work 2 rnds without decreasing. Break off after the last rnd.

Make a pleat at the 3rd row down from center and tack edges together securely on wrong side. Place Skull Cap in line with stitching just made and sew in place (this is back of Beret). Make 2 green bows and 2 red bows with ribbon and sew one of each color on each side of tuck at center top of Beret and at back of Beret.

Square Brimmed Hat . . . P.C. 1336

MATERIALS:

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 3 balls (1 oz. balls).

Bone Crochet Hook No. 8.

25 inches of ribbon, 1½ inches wide.

Use a double strand throughout.

CROWN . . . Starting at center, ch 7. **1st rnd:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch, then work along opposite side of starting chain, making dc in each ch. **2nd rnd:** 2 dc in each dc around. **3rd rnd:** * Dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. **4th rnd:** Dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, 3 dc in next 3 dc, sc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in each dc to 3 dc-group (mark this point as beginning of each of following rnds). **5th rnd:** Dc in next dc, 3 dc in center dc of 3 dc-group, dc in next 4 dc, sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in each dc to 3 dc-group. **6th, 7th and 8th rnds:** Repeat the 5th rnd, having 1 more dc on each side of the 3 sc on each rnd. At the end of the 8th rnd, make sc in next 2 dc. Ch 3, turn.

Work is now done in rows instead of rounds.

BRIM . . . 1st row: 2 dc in next sc, * dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from * until 20 dc are made, 3 dc in next dc, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in following dc) 4 times; 3 dc in next dc, ** dc in next dc, 2 dc in following dc. Repeat from ** until 20 dc are made, counting from last 3 dc-group. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each dc, making 3 sc in center dc of 3 dc-group. Ch 3, turn. **3rd row:** Dc in each dc, making 3 dc at center sc of 3 sc-group. Ch 1, turn. **4th and 5th rows:** Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows. **6th row:** Sc in each sc across. Break off.

Gather Brim at center. Make a bow with ribbon and sew in front of gathers. Sew the last row of Brim at each end to Crown.

Baby Cap . . . P.C. 1352

MATERIALS:

CHADWICK'S RED HEART KNITTING WORSTED, 2 balls (1 oz. balls) of Hunter's Green and 1 ball of Brown.

Bone Crochet Hook No. 8.

Use a double strand throughout.

Starting at tip of Crown with Green, ch 4. Join. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, 8 dc in ring. **2nd and 3rd rnds:** 2 dc in top of ch-3, 2 dc in each dc around (36 dc at end of 3rd rnd). **4th rnd:** (Sc in next 3 dc, dc in next 9 dc) 4 times. **5th rnd:** Sc over each sc and dc over each dc. **6th rnd:** Sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 9 dc, sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc. **7th rnd:** Sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 6 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 9 dc, sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next dc. **8th, 9th and 10th rnds:** Work as for 7th rnd, having 1 more dc before and after increases on each side of each rnd. Break off after the 10th rnd.
