Hat No. 126

Materials Required—American Thread Company "Silkine" Pearl Cotton size 5.
3 Medium or 2 Large Balls White or Colors.
For Embroidery—"Silkine" Art Thread 6 Strand Embroidery Cotton.
1 Skein each of Shade No. 901 Lt. Emerald, 1007 Deep Yellow, 1034 Medium Blue and 1100 Turkey Red.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 3.
Make a chain about 6 inches long and work a row of s c on ch. Ch 1, turn and continue working back and forth

in s c until work measures 20 inches or is length desired.
To Make—Fold through center and sew across one side and short end which is the back seam. Bring the top point of seam down to lower edge and fasten. Turn hat inside out and work a row of s c around lower edge of hat.
At front—Using 6 strand of any color desired form a peak by beginning $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches from center and the lower edge of hat, overcast to point and down other side to correspond. Work loop stitch flowers as illustrated, using 6 strands of "Silkine" Art Thread.

Hat No. 127

Materials Required—American Thread Company "Silkine" Pearl Cotton size 5.
8 Medium or 4 Large Balls, White, Black or Colors.
1 Steel Crochet Hook No. 3.
This entire hat is worked with double thread.
Ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 2 and work 11 s d c into ring. Join each row and start each row with ch 2.
2nd row—2 s d c in every other s d c (18 s d c).
3rd row—Same as 2nd row taking up back loop of st only.
4th row—Increase in every 3rd st taking up both loops. These two rows form the pattern and are followed throughout the entire hat.
5th and 6th rows—Increase in every 3rd st.
7th and 8th rows—Increase in every 4th st and work 4 rows even.
13th row—Decrease by working every 9th and 10th st

together and work 1 row even.
15th row—Increase in every 5th st.
16th row—Increase in every 10th st and work 1 row even.
18th row—Increase in every 15th st.
19, 20, 21 and 22nd rows—Repeat 17th and 18th rows twice.
23rd to 35th rows—Work even.
36th row—Turn work and work even.
37th row—Count off 48 sts for front of hat, increase in every 8th st 8 times and work remainder of row even. Work 3 more rows even and finish with a row of s c. Trim hat with ribbon or cord. A cord may be crocheted using 2 colors, one strand of each and worked as follows; ch 4, join, work 1 s c in each st and continue working rounds of s c until cord is length desired.

Hat No. 128 RetroAccessories

Materials Required—American Thread Company "Silkine" Pearl Cotton size 5.
3 Medium Balls Iridescent No. 1 or 2.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.
Make a chain 1 inch longer than head size (without stretching) work 2 d c in 4th st from hook * skip 3 sts, s c in next st, ch 3, 2 d c in same st, repeat from * to end of row, ch 3, turn.
2nd row—S c in 3 ch loop of last shell made, * ch 3, 2 d c in same st, s c in next shell, repeat from * to end of

row and repeat 2nd row until 4 shells remain. This forms a triangle.
With White work a row of s c all around.
2nd row—Work in s c, at the cut off corner work 2, 8 ch loops with 2 s c between loops and work 2 more rows of s c working s c over loops.
Make 2, 10-inch cords, 1 in White and 1 in Color following directions for cord in Hat No. 127. Attach cords to the corners, skip through loops and tie as illustrated.

Hat No. 129

Materials Required—American Thread Company "Silkine" Pearl Cotton size 5.
2 Medium Balls Blue or any Color desired.
1 Medium Ball White or Cream.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.
Top of Hat—With Color, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3, work 11 d c in ring, join each row.
2nd row—Ch 3, * 1 d c in next st, 2 d c in next st, repeat from * all around and repeat 2nd row 3 times.
Next row—Increase in every 3rd st, (96 sts).
On 1st 10 sts work 9 rows of d c, * break thread. Skip 14 sts and work 9 rows of d c on next 10 sts, repeat from * twice.
BRIM—With Color, make a chain the desired head size

and work 3 rows of d c, 1 row in Color, 1 row in White or Cream and 1 row in Color.
4th row—With White or Cream increase in every 10th st and work 1 row even in Color.
6th and 7th rows—Repeat 4th and 5th rows.
8th row—With Color, ch 1, thread over, insert in next st, pull through, * thread over, insert in same st, pull through, repeat from * thread over and pull through all loops on needle, ch 1 to tighten puff st, ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from beginning all around. Attach bands of hat to brim spacing them evenly.
These hats may also be made in American Thread Company "DeLuxe" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton.
