Directions for Making these Two Designs on Page 2

CROCHETED "FASCINATOR"

(Illustrated on Cover)

MATERIALS—Lily Knitting Yarn, Art. 600:—3-skeins color and 1-skein White. 1-yd. ribbon 1½" wide. Crochet hook size 1.

In color, ch 212, sc in 2d st from hook, * (ch 2, dc) 3 times in next 5th st, ch 2, sc in next 5th st. Repeat from * to end (21 shells).

ROW 2—Ch 1, turn, sl st in 2-ch and dc, sc in next 2-ch, (ch 4, sc in next space, ch 5, sc between 1st 2 dc in next shell) across, with 2-ch and dc for end loop.

ROW 3—Ch 5, turn, sc in next 5-ch loop, * (ch 2, dc) 3 times in next 4-ch loop, ch 2, sc in next 5-ch loop. Repeat from * across, ch 2, dc in end 4-ch loop.

ROW 4—Ch 5, turn, sc between 1st 2 dc of next shell, (ch 4, sc in next space, ch 5, sc between 1st 2 dc of next shell) across, with 2-ch and dc in end loop.

ROW 5—Turn, * (ch 2, dc) 3 times in next 4-ch loop, ch 2, sc in next 5-ch loop. Repeat from * across. Repeat Rows 2, 3, 4 and 5 until 1 shell remains in final repeat of Row 5. Fasten off. Pin right-side-down in a true triangle, with straight sides, stretching until pattern is opened up. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

EDGE—Join White to one space, ch 3 for a dc, * (ch 5, sl st in 1 loop of 4th st from hook, ch 1, dc) twice in next space. Repeat from * around, adding extra loops at corners.

Gather center point crosswise (5 shell-rows down) to half width and cover with a ribbon bow.

CROCHETED CAPTIVATOR

(Illustrated at Right)

MATERIALS—Lily Knitting Yarn, Art. 600:—3-skeins color and 2-skeins White. 1-ball Lily Pearl Cotton size 3 in Dp. Yellow. Crochet hook size 1.

In color, ch 209, dc in 6th st from hook, * ch 5, sl st in 1 loop of 4th st from hook for a p, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next 7th st of chain. Repeat from * to end.

ROW 2—Ch 1, turn, sc between last 2 dc, ch 6, (dc, ch 2, dc) between 2 dc of next shell, * ch 5, a p, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) between 2 dc of next shell. Repeat from * to 2d shell from end, ch 3, dc in end shell.

ROW 3—Ch 4, turn, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next shell, * ch 5, a p, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next shell. Repeat from * across, dc in end 6-ch. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until only 2 shells remain in last 2 rows.

EDGE—(Ch 4, sc in next space) to corner, put several loops in corner, 2 loops in each space on long side and complete as 1st side. Pin right-side-down in a true triangle, with straight sides, stretching until pattern is opened up. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

FLOWER—In White, * ch 4, dc in 4th st from hook, (ch 1, dc) twice in same st, ch 3, sl st in same st. Repeat from * 3 times, sl st at base of 1st petal, cut 7" long, pull on thru, thread to needle and fasten on back. In 1 strand Pearl Cotton, make a large French Knot in center. Make about 56 flowers. Tack 2½" apart on long side and 3" apart on short sides. Put a 2d row on short sides, ½" from edge and between those in 1st row. Slightly gather center point cross-size 5" down and cover down to gathers with flowers.

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Crocheted Captivator

This crocheted "Captivator" will keep every hair in place. One just must protect precious "hair-dos" these days.

CROCHETED HEAD SCARF

(Illustrated on Cover)

MATERIALS—Lily Knitting Yarn, Art. 600:—3-skeins Med. Green and 1-skein Red (or other colors). Crochet hook size 1.

In Green, ch 232, sc in 2d st from hook, (ch 6, sl st in 1 loop of 3d st from hook for a p, ch 1, sc in next 5th st of long chain) to end, with 2-ch and dc for end loop.

ROW 2—Turn, (ch 6, p, ch 1, sc in next loop) across, with 2-ch and dc for end loop. Repeat until 1 loop remains, ch 2, turn, dc in loop.

EDGE—* (ch 4, 2 sc in next space) to corner, 3 loops in corner, * (ch 4, 2 sc in next space, ch 4, 1 sc in same space, 1 sc in next, ch 4, 2 sc in same space) across to corner, 3 loops in corner and repeat from * to *. Fasten off.

Pin work right-side-down in a true triangle with straight sides, stretching until pattern is opened up. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

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FRINGE—Wind Red around a cardboard $2\frac{3}{4}$ " wide, and cut at one edge. Tie 3 strands in each loop on 2 short sides. Trim evenly.

CORD—Cut 3 strands Red 104" long, twist tightly, double and twist again. Tie a knot 1" from each end and fringe ends.

Mark a semicircle for head section, using pins. Keep a fixed measuring point at center of long side and measure out 12" from this point, placing pins 2" apart to form a semicircle. Thread cord thru loops inside of semicircle, gather to fit and tie in a bow under chin.

BOW—In Red, ch 10, sc in 6th st from hook, (ch 2, sc in next 2d st) twice. * Ch 4, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 2, sc in next) twice. Repeat from * for 22". Fasten off. Mark with pins at 3, 7, 11, 15 and 19 inches. Fold between pins and tack at pins, gathering slightly, forming 4 loops and 2 ends. Tack on center-top 1" from edge.

CROCHETED ROUND SHAWL

(Illustrated on Back Page)

MATERIALS—Lily Knitting Yarn, Art. 600:—2-skeins Cream and 1-skein each Lt. Green and Tea Rose (or other colors). Crochet hook size 1.

In Cream, (ch 5, dc in 5th st from hook) 25 times. Ch 7, turn, sc in next loop, (ch 4, sc in next) across, ch 2, tr in end st. Ch 1, turn, sc in tr, 6-ch loops across. Ch 8, turn, sc in next loop, 6-ch loops across, ch 2, tr in end st, ch 7 and drop. Join Tea Rose to 1st loop of last row and make a row of knot sts:—* (pull up loop $\frac{1}{2}$ " long, yarn over and pull thru, sc in single back loop of long st) twice, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across. Make a 1" knot st and a $\frac{1}{2}$ " one, turn, sc in center sc of next loop, (two $\frac{1}{2}$ " knot sts, sc in next loop) across, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " knot st and a 1" one, sl st at start of last row.

Fasten off. Pick up Cream, sc in center sc of end loop, ** ch 5, 2 dc in 5th st from hook, holding last loop of each dc on hook, yarn over and thru all 3 loops at once (a Cluster), ch 1, sc in next loop. Repeat from ** across, dtr down in previous Cream row, ch 7 and drop. Join Lt. Green to 1st sc of last row and make 2 rows of knot sts the same as Tea Rose band. Fasten off. Pick up Cream, sc in last loop, *** (ch 5, dc in 5th st from hook) twice, sc in next loop. Repeat from *** across, dtr down in last Cream row. Ch 7, turn, sc in last loop, and 4-ch loops across, ch 2, tr in end st. (Ch 1, turn, sc in tr, and 5-ch loops across. Ch 8, turn, sc in last loop, and 5-ch loops across, ch 2, tr in end st) twice, ch 7 and drop. Join Tea Rose to 1st loop of last row and repeat from * to ***. (Make 2 rows of knot sts, ending with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " and a 1" knot st, sc at start of last row, ch 7, turn, sc in center of last loop) 4 times, increasing length of knot sts to $\frac{3}{4}$ " in final 2 rows. Fasten off.

NECK FRILL—In Cream, (ch 3, dc in next space) across, ch 3, sc in end st. Fasten off.

Join Lt. Green and make 2 rows of knot sts. Fasten off.

EDGE — Join Tea Rose, a $\frac{3}{4}$ " knot st, ch 4, sc in side of sc for a p, another $\frac{3}{4}$ " knot st, sc in next loop. Repeat around entire shawl. Press work on back.

CORD — Cut 3 strands Lt. Green 112" long, twist tightly, double and twist again. Tie a knot in end. Run in beading row at neck. Finish cord with pom poms:—wind Lt. Green 100 times around a $\frac{3}{4}$ " card, cut at 1 edge and tie tightly in center.
