FREE LEAFLET W 14

Smart Crocheted Beret No. 1015

See the two versions of this hat on reverse side. Wear it with fashionable "curtain" back or wear it as a classic beret.

Materials required—American Thread Company "Dawn" Knitting Worsted or "Dawn" Germantown Wool. 3-1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ounce Skeins White, Black or Colors. Bone Crochet Hook No. 2 or 3.
 Ch 3, 6 s c in 1st st, join.
2nd row—Ch 1, 2 s c in each s c.
3rd row—Ch 2, 3 d c in same space, slip loop off hook, insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, * ch 2, 4 d c in next st, slip loop off hook, insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, repeat from * all around, join in 1st popcorn st.
4th row—Ch 1 and work 3 s c in each 2 ch loop.
5th row—Work a row of s c.
6th row—Ch 3 and work a popcorn st in same space, * ch 1, d c in next st, popcorn st in next st, repeat from * all around.
7th row—1 s c in each d c, 1 s c in each popcorn st and 1 s c in each ch 1.
8th row—1 s c in each s c.
 Repeat 6th, 7th and 8th rows then repeat 6th and 7th

row again. The remainder of the crown is worked in s c without joining rows and taking up the back loop of st only. Mark the beginning of row and work 5 more rows even.
Next row—Increase in every 10th st and work 3 rows even.
Next row—Decrease by working every 9th and 10th st together and work 1 row even. Repeat the last 2 rows until head size measures 20 inches or is size desired. Work a band of 5 rows of s c even, taking up both loops of s c, finish with a sl st and break yarn.
Back Drape—Ch 43, work 1st d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining st of ch, ch 6, turn, * skip 1 d c, 1 s c in next d c, ch 6, repeat from * across row, ch 1, turn.
Next row—Sl st to center of loop, ch 6 and continue loops across row. Repeat last row 11 times, break yarn. Attach yarn in 1st loop of 1st row, s c over same loop, ch 5, s c in same space, * s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in same loop, repeat from * all around. Sew drape to back of hat on the inside of band.

Crocheted Hat with a College Degree No. 1014

Materials required—American Thread Company "Dawn" Germantown Wool or "Dawn" Knitting Worsted. 2-1 ounce Balls, No. 1725 Tan. 1-1 ounce Ball, No. 1727 Brown. Bone Crochet Hook No. 2.
Gauge—5 sts=1 inch.
 With Tan, ch 6, join. Ch 1 and work 2 s c in each st of ch, join, (12 s c).
2nd row—Ch 1, * 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 1 s c. ch 2, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from * 3 times, join.
3rd row—Ch 1, 1 s c in each s c between corners, 1 s c, ch 2, 1 s c in each corner.
Repeat 3rd row—There will be 2 more s c on each side each row. Work 1 more row in Tan, 1 row Brown (when changing color, start next color on a different side, the joining will not be as noticeable as if joined in the same place), 2 rows Tan, 1 row Brown, 2 rows Tan and 1 row Brown. Work should measure 5 inches.
 On right side of work attach Tan to 1 corner and work 1 s c in corner, 1 s c in each s c across 1 side taking up the back loop of st only, 1 s c in next corner, ch 1, turn and work 14 more rows of s c taking up both loops of st. Band should measure about 3 inches. Repeat these 16 rows on 2nd side (to the left of 1st side).
 On the next side to the left, join yarn in 4th s c from

corner, * work to corner. ch 1, turn, work across these sts and 1 more st, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn, repeat from * until all sts across side have been picked up, then work on all sts until there are 16 rows on the narrow end. The wide end of this side is the back of hat. Work the next section same as last section having the wide end next to the wide end of previous section. Press the work lightly under a damp cloth and crochet the sides together on the right side to form a ridge.
FLOWERS—With Tan, ch 3, 5 s c in 1st st, join and break yarn. Attach Brown * ch 5, sl st in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, sl st in next s c of Tan, repeat from * 5 times, break yarn leaving a length for sewing. Tack flowers to hat at each point of petal and work 1 flower for each side.
FRINGE TASSEL—With Brown ch 19 and work 18 s c on ch. With Tan work a 2nd row of s c, break yarn. Pick up Brown, s c into back loop of 1st s c * draw up an 18 inch loop on hook, keep loop on hook, s c into back loop of next st, repeat from * across row always keeping 1 or 2 loops on hook to gauge length of next loop, turn work and repeat loops on other side of s c, break yarn. Foldband in half and crochet together across upper edge. Trim tassel and attach to hat as illustrated.

Ring-Tail Knitted Stocking Cap No. 1016

Materials required—American Thread Company "Dawn" Shetland Floss. 1-1 ounce Ball White. 2-1 ounce Balls Red or any Color desired. 5 double pointed Knitting Needles No. 1 Bone or No. 11 Steel.
 On 4 needles with Red cast on loosely 88 sts—22 on each needle, join, taking care not to twist the stitches.
1st row—K 1 st, P 1 st, repeat all around.
2nd row—Purl the K st and knit the purl st. Repeat the 2nd row for 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches. The remainder of work is plain knitting. Continue in Red until work measures about 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches (using up 1 ball of Red). Attach White and work 1 row.

Next row—Decrease 1 st at each end of each needle then decrease every inch in same manner 6 times, working in the following color scheme: 8 rows White, 3 rows Red, 2 rows White, 5 rows Red, 2 rows White, 3 rows Red, 8 rows White, 8 rows Red, 3 rows White, 2 rows Red, 5 rows White, 2 rows Red, 3 rows White and the remainder of work in Red. Work $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch, decrease and break yarn leaving an end, thread this into a tapestry needle, pick up all sts, draw them together and fasten firmly.
TASSEL—Cut about 50 strands of yarn about 30 inches long, double these and tie at top then tie tightly about 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches from the top. For a longer hat knit without decreasing for about 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches instead of 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches and follow directions for decreasing.
