

Juvenile Hat and Sport Bag Free Vintage Pattern



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No. 102 — Juvenile Cap

MATERIALS: 3 tubes Mogor Gimp.

No. 3 Crochet Hook.

Gauge: 7 stitches equal 1 inch.

1st row: ch. 4, join with slip st. to form a ring, make 4 s.c. in ring.

2nd row: * s.c. in first st. 2 s.c. in next st. Repeat from * to end of row.

3rd row: Same as row 2.

4th-11th rows: s.c. in s.c., making 4 increases at equal intervals on every other row. Do not make increases directly over increases of previous rows. There will be 24 s.c. on 11th row.

(This will form a small peak on top of cap, to measure 1½ inches from centre top to edge.)

12th row: 1 s.c. in each of next 4 s.c. — 1 cable st. (To do this, make a treble *. Thread over needle twice, insert hook into same st. as last s.c., draw thread through, thread over, draw through 2 loops, thread over through next 2, thread over, through last 2 loops) 1 s.c. in each of the next 4 s.c. *. Repeat from * to * to end of row.

13th, 14th rows: s.c. in each of next 5 s.c. 1 cable st. over cable st. (To do this, make a treble crochet, thread over needle twice, insert hook under treble st. of previous row, draw thread through, work off as for previous treble until 1 loop is left on hook) 1 s.c. in each of next 5 s.c. *. Repeat from * to * around.

15th row: * 1 s.c. in each of the next 3 s.c. 1 cable st. worked over s.c. of previous row. * Repeat from * to * to end of row. This row is worked similar to row 12. (There will be 12 sets of cable stitches.)

16th row: Increase 1 s.c. between cable stitches (4 s.c. between).

17th, 18th rows: 5 s.c. between cable stitches.

19th, 20th rows: 6 s.c. between cable stitches.

21st-23rd rows: 7 s.c. between cable stitches.

24th-25th rows: 8 s.c. between cable stitches.

26th-28th rows: 9 s.c. between cable stitches.

29th-34th rows: 10 s.c. between cable stitches.

35th row: * 11 s.c. between cable stitches *.

Repeat from * to * until cap measures 6½ inches from centre top of peak to edge of crown, and 21½ inches around edge.

Crochet 2 rows of s.c. around edge without the cable st. working a s.c. in place of cable st. This will finish off cap very neatly.

No. 102 The Sport Bag

MATERIALS: 7 tubes Mogor Variegated Crochet Gimp, Silk lining, No. 3 Crochet Hook, 1 Set wooden 8-inch bag handles.

Chain 50.

Gauge: 7 stitches equal 1 inch.

1st row: Make d.c. in 3rd chain and 1 d.c. in each chain until end of row making 48 stitches in all, chain 2, turn.

2nd, 3rd and 4th rows: Same as 1st row.

5th row: 1 s.c. in each d.c. of preceding row, chain 1, turn.

6th row: 2 s.c. in each s.c. of preceding row (95 stitches), chain 1, turn.

7th row: * 3 s.c. — 1 tr. c. (put yarn over hook twice, pull yarn through two loops, then next two loops, and through last two), continue from * until end of row ending in 3 s.c., chain 1, turn.

8th row: 1 s.c. in every stitch of preceding row.

9th row: 3 s.c., 1 tr. c., inserting hook under tr. c. of 7th row.

Now continue working 8th and 9th rows alternately for 16 inches.

Now work one s.c. in every other stitch and finish bag by making 5 rows of d.c.

Line bag, fold bag in half and finish by inserting ends in slot in handle and stitching down.

Slip st. sides together within three inches of top of bag.
