

No. 110 - Pouch Bag

MATERIALS: 6 tubes Mogor Gimp, Silk lining, 9 inch Zipper, 1 pair Celluloid Rings.

Gauge: 7 stitches equal 1 inch.

Needle: No. 3 Steel Crochet Hook.

Chain 144, join with slip st. to form 1 ring. 1st row: 1 s.c. in each ch. st., join with sl. st.

2nd row: * 1 s.c. in each of 3 s.c. of previous row, 1 tr. c. in next st. * and continue around to end of row and

join with slip st., ch. 1 (hereafter join every row with sl. st. and chain 1).

3rd row: * s.c. over s.c. of previous row, 1 tr. c. * (from now on, this will be referred to as a cable st.) To make cable st. (thread over needle twice, insert hook under tr. c. of previous row, draw thread through and work off as for previous treble until one loop is left on hook) and repeat from * to * to end of row.

4th row: * 1 s.c. in each s.c. of previous row * cable over cable, s.c. next st., cable st., 1 s.c. * and repeat from

* to *.

5th row: Same as 4th row.

6th, 7th rows: Same as 2nd row, and 3rd row. (This makes one short cable between 2 long cable stitches.)

8th, 9th rows: s.c. in every stitch.

This ends first pattern. Repeat from 2nd to 9th rows, five times (6 patterns in all.)

Join bag by sl. stitching across bottom and turn inside out.

Attach zipper and lining to top of bag.

Handles: One row of s.c. around pair of celluloid handles and stitch to one corner of bag.
