

No. 1—"HALO" Hat and BAG SET

MATERIALS—Lily Rug Yarn:—3-skeins Hunter Green and 1-skein Beige. Lily Viking Aero Crochet Hook Size H-6. 3 wooden button molds size 1½".

HAT—(Medium size). Crown: — (Gauge—4 sc—1". 3 rows—1"). With Green, ch 2, making 1st st twice usual length, 6 sc in long st. Mark end of round as an aid in counting. Work following rows in back loops only. Row 2—2 sc in each sc (12 sc). Row 3—Repeat Row 2 (24 sc). Row 4—Widen 1 st in every 2d st (36 sc). Row 5—1 sc in each st. Row 6—Widen 1 st in every 3d st (48 sc). Repeat Rows 5 and 6 twice (85 sc). Repeat Row 5 seven times. Sl st in next 3d st. Fasten off.

RetroAccessories BRIM—With Green, ch 11, 10 sc on chain. Work following rows in back loops only. Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 10 sc. Row 3—Drop Green, but do not cut. Draw Beige thru loop on hook. turn, 10 sc. Row 4-Ch 1, turn, 10 sc. Row 5—Drop Beige, draw up Green and thru loop on hook, turn, 10 sc. Repeat from Row 2 for a total of 64 rows (32 ribs). Row 65— Join Green, turn, 2 sc in last sc, 1 sc in each sc across, with 2 sc in end sc. Work 1 more row in Green and 2 in Beige without widening. Repeat these last 4 rows 9 times (30 sc in last rows). Make 4 more rows in Green without widening. **EDGE**—Sc in same end st, * (sc in next row down side) twice, skip next row, sc between ribs. Repeat from * to end of band (making 3 sc across ends of every 2 ribs). Fasten off. Repeat on other side. Fold band lengthwise thru center, right side out. Going thru 1 loop of each st and using a Green strand, sew one edge of band to top loops on edge of crown, then sew other edge of band to loops on edge of crown. Whip ends of band together, lap wide end over narrow end and tack together. Tack a button mold with Green yarn on wide point.

HANDBAG—Circle—With Green, ch 2, making 1st st twice usual size, 8 sc in long st. Mark end of round. Work in back loops only. Row 2—2 sc in each sc (16 sc). Row 3—Widen 1 st in every 2d st (24 sc). Row 4—Widen 1 st in every 3d st (32 sc). Continue for 4 more rows in same way, making 1 more st between widenings in each row (64 sc). ROW 9—66 sc, 2 sl sts. Fasten off.



No. 1-"HALO" HAT and BAG SET

BAND—With Green, ch 25, 24 sc on chain. Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 24 sc. Drop Green. Row 3—Join Beige, turn, 24 sc. Row 4—Ch 1, turn 24 sc. Drop Beige. Row 5—Pull up Green and join, turn, 24 sc. Repeat from Row 2 for a total of 70 rows (35 ribs). EDGE—Sc in same end st, (sc between next 2 ribs) repeated to end. Ch 1, turn, 1 sl st in each sc, pulling tight. Fasten off. Repeat these 2 rows on other side of band. Fold band in center lengthwise. Using Green, sew one side to one circle, other side to 2d circle.

HANDLE — With Green, ch 70, 69 sc on chain, 2 more sc in end, sc in each st on other side of chain, join and fasten off. Make a 2d piece and sew together around edges.

Steam and press each half of bag, working on inside (wrong side). Sew one end of handle between the 2 sides of one end of band. Sew other end of handle to other end of band. Pad each circle with 1 or 2 circles of heavy muslin or canvas. Line bag, and close with a zipper around top half of circles.

No. 4—BELT and POCKET SET

(Below-at right)

MATERIALS — Lily Rug Yarn:—2-skeins for foundation color, and a partial skein each of 2 contrasting colors. Lily Viking Aero Crochet Hook Size H-6.

BELT—With main color, make a chain 4" longer than belt length, sc in 3d st from hook, (ch 1, sc in next 2d st) repeated for desired belt length allowing 2" for lap. Rip and fas-

ten off excess chain. Row 2—Ch 2, turn, sc in 1-ch space between last 2 sc, (ch 1, sc between next 2 sc) repeated to end 2-ch. Repeat his row 4 times. Work 1 sc, 1 hdc, 5 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc across end. Edge—Ch 1, sl st in corner, * (ch 1, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sl st in next 1-ch) * repeated to end, sc across end. Repeat from * to * across side and around end. Join and fasten off. Using 2 strands of a contrasting color, make a tight chain about a foot longer than belt. Do not cut. Repeat with other contrasting color.



Mark belt into 2" lengths with pins. Starting at straight end, pin chains wrong-side-up on belt in alternately crossed curves, crossing them at the 2" markings. At curved end, curl one chain around into a tight loop, then the other around it in opposite direction. Using matching sewing thread, sew chains in place along both sides. Steam and press belt on wrong sideRetroAccessories

TASSEL—With both contrasting colors 8 times around a 6" cardboard, tie at one edge, cut at other, and tie a 2d time 1" from top. Fasten to center curl and trim to an even length. Fasten Belt with snaps.

POCKETS—With main color, ch 5, sc in 3d st from hook, ch 1, sc in next 2d st. Row 2—Ch 3, turn, sc in 3d ch st from hook, ch 1, sc between next 2 sc, ch 1, sc in end 2-ch, ch 1, hdc in same place. Row 3—Ch 3, turn, sc in 3d ch st from hook, ch 1, sc between hdc and next sc, (ch 1, sc between next 2 sc) repeated across to end 2-ch, ch 1, hdc in same and chain. Row 4—Ch 2, turn, sc between hdc and next sc, (ch 1, sc between next 2 sc) repeated to end 2-ch. Repeat these last 2 rows. Row 7—Ch 2, turn, sc between last 2 sc, (ch 1, sc between next 2 sc) repeated to end 2-ch. Repeat these last 2 rows. Row 7—Ch 2, turn, sc between last 2 sc, (ch 1, sc between next 2 sc) repeated to end 2-ch. Repeat this row 6 times.

Work around with the same edge as on Belt. Make a 2d piece. With a double strand of one contrasting color, ch 19, ch 31 with other color,—for each pocket. Sew these on Pockets in a double curl, following illustration. Steam and press on wrong side.

CAP—Top—With main color, ch 8, join with sl st. (Ch 5, sc in ring) 7 times, ch 2, dc in ring. Row 2—(Ch 4, sc in next loop, ch 4, sc in same loop) repeated for 15 loops, ch 2, dc in same loop. Row 3—(Ch 3, sc in next loop) 15 times, ch 1, dc in next loop. Repeat Row 3 twice. Row 6—(Ch 4, sc in next loop) 15 times, ch 2, dc in next loop. Repeat Row 6 three times. Fasten off.

BAND—Make similar to Belt, in proper head size, allowing 1" for lap. Steam and press Band on wrong side into a flat curve, lap ends and sew together. Sew edge of Top under top edge of Band. Make a tassel, winding both contrasting colors 12 times around an 8" card. Sew to end of Band.

No. 2—CAP and BAG SET of Crocheted Cord

(Illustrated on Front Cover)

MATERIALS-Lily Rug Yarn: -3-skeins Wine, 2-skeins Dusty Rose and

1-skein Gray. Lily Viking Aero Crochet Hook Size H-6.

HAT—Side—With Wine, ch 2, (2sc, 1 hdc and 2 dc) in starting st. Working in back loops, make dc in 5 sts of last row. Continue around and around with 1 dc in each st, having the wrong side of sts outside of cord. Be careful not to add or drop sts, always have 5 dc in each row. Repeat until cord (stretched) is 23" long (or head size). End with 2 hdc, 1 sc and 1 sl st and fasten off. Make a 2d cord in Wine, 2 cords in Dusty Rose and 1 cord in Gray, all about 22" long (or 1" shorted than 1st cord). Make another Wine cord about 21" long. Sew cords together into a band, with starting ends all at same end. Start with longest Wine cord at bottom, then Wine, Dusty Rose, Gray and Dusty Rose, with shortest Wine cord on top. Sew thru 1 dc of each cord only, being careful to follow the same rib of dc lengthwise (it will help to untwist cord and press flat with fingers). Sew next cord to next dc-rib from last sewn rib, thus having 3 free dc-ribs on right side of cord. Sew ends of band together (center front).

TOP—With Wine, ch 4, 6 sc in starting st. Row 2—Ch 1, turn, and working in both loops, 7 sc across row. Repeat 5 times. Row 8—Ch 1, turn, skip last sc, 1 sc in each remaining sc. Repeat 4 times. Fasten off. Join Wine with 3 sc in starting st, then work sc around, widening as necessary to keep work flat. Put 3 sc in tip end. Join to 1st sc and fasten off. Working in back loops, make 1 row of sc in Dusty Rose, Gray and Wine, widening as necessary and with 3 sc in narrow end. Then make a final sc-row in Wine thru both loops of sts. Steam and press both pieces, then sew top to band, with

pointed end at black.

POM-PONS—Wind Wine 100 times around a card 1" wide. Tie at one edge, cut at other, and fluff into a pom-pon. Tack to top center-front of band. Make a pom-pon each in Dusty Rose and Gray and tack on

each side in center of band.

BAG—With Wine, make a cord (as for Hat Band) 35" long. Starting at starting end, sew together around and around into a flat circle. Using Dusty Rose, make a cord to fit around circle. Sew in place, starting at starting end so that stitches can be ripped or added at finishing end to make cord fit exactly around previous round. Next make a cord in Gray, then Dusty Rose, Wine, Dusty Rose, Gray, Dusty Rose, and 3 rows in Wine. Be careful to keep work flat. Finished circle should be 15" in diameter.

GUSSET—Repeat Hat Top thru 3 repeats of Row 8. (Ch 1, turn, 3 sc)

twice, (ch 1, turn, 2 sc) twice. Fasten off. Make a 2d piece.

Fold circle across center. Sew a gusset in each end with pointed end up. Interline bag with stiff muslin or canvas, then line, and close with a zipper around top between gussets.

No. 3-CAP

RetroAccessories

(Illustrated on Front Cover)

MATERIALS-Lily Rug Yarn:-1-skein each Emerald Green and Rust.

Lily Viking Aero Crochet Hook Size H-6.

With Green, ch 4, 3 sc on chain. Row 2—Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in back loop of last sc, (4 dc in next sc) twice. Work following rows in both loops. Row 3—Ch 3, turn, 1 dc in last dc, (2 dc in next) twice, 1 dc in next 6 dc, (2 dc in next st) 3 times. Row 4—Ch 4, turn, dc in last dc, (ch 1, dc in next st) 17 times. Row 5—Ch 4, turn, dc in last 1-ch space, (ch 1, dc in next space) repeated across, ch 1, dc in same end space. Repeat this row 7 times. Row 13—Ch 2, turn, sc in last 1-ch space, ch 1, sc in next, (ch 1, hdc in next) twice, * (ch 1, dc in

next) 9 times, dc in next space (a decrease), ** (ch 1, dc in next space) & times, (ch 1, hdc in next) twice, (ch 1, sc in next) twice. Row 14-Repeat peat Row 13 to *. (Ch 1, dc in next space) 8 times, skip 2 dc, dc in next space. Repeat Row 13 from ** to end. Row 15—Repeat Row 13 to *. (Ch 1, dc in next space) 3 times, dc in next space, (ch 1, dc in next) 4 times, skip 2 dc, dc in next space, (ch 1, dc in next) 4 times, dc in next space, (ch 1, dc in next) twice, (ch 1, hdc in next) twice, (ch 1, sc in next) twice. Continue for 3 more rows with a decrease over each of 3 decreases. Row 19-Repeat Row 13 to *. Ch 1, dc in next space, (skip 2 dc, dc in next space) 3 times, (ch 1, hdc in next) twice, (ch 1, sc in next) twice. Row 20—Ch 2, turn, sc in last space, ch 1, sc in next, ch 1, hdc in next 2 spaces, skip 2 dc, dc in next space, skip 2 dc, hdc in next 2 spaces, ch 1, hdc in next, (ch 1, sc in next) twice. Row 21—Ch 2, turn, sc in last space, ch 1, hdc in next, skip 2 hdc, dc in next space, skip 3 dc, dc in next space, skip 2 hdc, hdc in next space, ch 1, sc in next. Row 22-Ch 1, turn, dc in center space, sl st in end sc. Edge-Ch 1, sc in end of next 9 rows, (2 sc in next space) 11 times, sc in next 3 sts, (2 sc in next space) 11 times, sc in next 9 rows, sl st in 1st 1-ch. Fasten off.

Fold top fullness into a crosswise tuck $3\frac{1}{2}$ " up from front. Make tuck 1" deep in center, tapering off at sides. Sew in place.

FRILL—With Green, ch 35, sc in 6th st from hook, (ch 5, sc in next st) 29 times, ch 5, sc in same end st, (ch 5, sc in next st) 29 times up other side of long chain. Fasten off. Join Rust to loop at one end, * ch 1, dc in next loop, (ch 1, dc in same loop) 4 times, ch 1, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Sew frill thru center across front of cap at base of tuck.
