



Classic Cotton Gloves . . . P.K. 1343
Classic Wool Lining . . . P.K. 1344

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS KNIT-CRO-SHEEN, 2 balls for each size for Classic Cotton Gloves.

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY WOOL, 2 balls (3/4 oz. balls) for each size for Classic Wool Lining.

Set of 4 double-pointed steel knitting needles No. 14.

GAUGE: 9 sts make 1 inch; 12 rnds make 1 inch.

CLASSIC COTTON GLOVE

SIZES	4	5	6	7
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Cast on over 2 needles (to allow for stretch)

56 sts 60 sts 64 sts 68 sts

Remove 1 needle and work as follows: Divide sts on 3 needles, join, being careful not to twist sts, and work in ribbing of k 2, p 2, for

2 1/2" 3" 3" 3 1/2"

Then work in pattern as follows: **1st and 2nd rnds:** K around. **3rd rnd:** * K 1, p 1. Repeat from * around. These 3 rnds constitute the pattern. Work in pattern for

3/4" 1" 1" 1 1/4"

ending with the 3rd rnd. Start increasing for Thumb gore on next rnd as follows: Work in pattern across first 4 sts of 1st needle, place a marker, inc next st—*to inc 1 st, knit first in the front loop and then in back loop of the same st*, k 1 st, inc 1 st, place a second marker. K remainder of rnd. On next rnd transfer the markers onto right-hand needle. The sts between the markers are Thumb sts. Inc in the st after the 1st marker and before the 2nd marker every 3rd rnd until there are between markers

17 sts 19 sts 21 sts 23 sts

(keep sts between markers in pattern).

On next rnd work to 1st marker, slip sts between markers onto a safety pin to be worked later. Cast on 3 sts to replace those slipped off and work in pattern to end of rnd. There are on needles

56 sts 60 sts 64 sts 68 sts

Work around until Glove, when tried on, reaches base of Middle Finger, ending between Middle Finger and Forefinger on palm side. Mark fingers by putting a safety pin on palm and back of hand between each finger, having for

Forefinger 16 sts 17 sts 18 sts 19 sts

Middle Finger	16 sts	17 sts	18 sts	19 sts
Ring Finger	12 sts	13 sts	14 sts	15 sts
Little Finger	12 sts	13 sts	14 sts	15 sts

Place all sts except Forefinger sts on safety pins to be worked later.

FOREFINGER . . . Place Forefinger sts on 3 needles, pick up thread and work around in pattern, casting on
 2 sts 3 sts 2 sts 3 sts
 between Forefinger and Middle Finger (where pin is). Work around in pattern until finger measures about
 2" 2 1/4" 2 3/4" 3"
 or to 1/4 inch from tip. **Next rnd:** * K 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around until 6 sts remain. Break off, leaving an 8-inch length. Thread a needle with this length and draw it through remaining sts. Fasten securely on wrong side.

MIDDLE FINGER . . . Slip sts for Middle Finger onto 3 needles. Attach yarn on palm side, work across in pattern, pick up
 2 sts 3 sts 2 sts 3 sts
 over cast-on sts of Forefinger, work across back of hand in pattern, cast on 2 sts between Middle and Ring Fingers.

There are on needles 20 sts 22 sts 22 sts 24 sts

Work as for Forefinger until piece measures
 2 1/4" 2 1/2" 3" 3 1/4"

Finish as for Forefinger.

RING FINGER . . . Slip sts onto needles, attach thread and work across palm side in pattern, pick up 2 sts where sts were cast on Middle Finger. Work across sts of back in pattern. Cast on
 2 sts 3 sts 2 sts 3 sts
 between Ring and Little Fingers.

There are on needles 16 sts 18 sts 18 sts 20 sts

Work as for Forefinger until piece measures
 2" 2 1/4" 2 3/4" 3"

Finish as for Forefinger.

LITTLE FINGER . . . Slip sts onto needles, attach thread and work around in pattern, picking up
 2 sts 3 sts 2 sts 3 sts
 between Ring and Little Fingers. There are on needles
 14 sts 16 sts 16 sts 18 sts

Work as for Forefinger, until piece measures
 1 1/2" 1 3/4" 2" 2 1/4"

Finish as for Forefinger.

THUMB . . . Transfer Thumb sts onto 2 needles. Attach thread at beginning of 1st needle and k around. Then with a 3rd needle pick up and knit 3 sts where the 3 sts were cast on. There are on needles

20 sts 22 sts 24 sts 26 sts

Work as for Forefinger until piece measures
 1 3/4" 2" 2 1/4" 2 1/2"

Finish as for Forefinger.

Work other glove to correspond.

CLASSIC WOOL LINING

Work as for Classic Cotton Gloves until ribbing is completed. Then follow the same directions, but work in stockinette st (k each rnd) instead of pattern.
