



**MATERIALS:** Beehive Catriona Crepe (1 oz. skeins): Sizes 12 and 14—7 skeins of White; Size 16—8 skeins. 1 skein each of California Blue and Lime Mint for all sizes . . . . Royal Society Aluminum or Plastic Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 1 (2½ mm. size) . . . Royal Society Six Strand Embroidery Floss, 1 skein each of Green (584) and Pink (603) . . . Blue beads and bugles. Yellow beads . . . Pegrl buttons . . . ¼ yard white grosgrain ribbon, 1 inch wide . . . Shoulder pads . . . Snap fastener.

**GAUGE:** 11 sts measure 1 inch; 13 rows measure 1 inch.

**MEASUREMENTS FOR BLOCKING GARMENT:**

Sizes	12	14	16
Bust	32"	34"	36"
Width across back at underarm	16"	17"	18"
Width across each front at underarm	9"	9½"	10"
Width across back above armhole shaping	12½"	13¼"	14"
Length from shoulder to lower edge	19½"	20½"	21"
Length of side seam	13"	13½"	14"
Length of sleeve seam	4½"	4½"	5"
Width across sleeve at upperarm	12½"	13"	13½"

**BACK . . .** Starting at lower edge with White, cast on  
160 sts 170 sts 180 sts

Work in stockinette st (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) for ¾ inch, ending with a purl row. Knit the next 2 rows (ridge for hemline). Continue in stockinette st, decreasing 1 st at both ends of every 3rd row until there are on needle  
132 sts 142 sts 152 sts

Work without decreasing for ½ inch. Now increase 1 st at both ends of every  
5th row 5th row 6th row  
until there are on needle 176 sts 186 sts 196 sts

Work without increasing until piece measures in all (excluding hem)  
13" 13½" 14"

**To Shape Armholes:** Bind off 10 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at both ends of every other row until there are on needle  
138 sts 144 sts 152 sts

Work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping  
6½" 7" 7"

**To Shape Shoulders:** Bind off 11 sts 8 sts 10 sts at the beginning of the next 8 rows 12 rows 10 rows  
Bind off for back of neck the remaining  
50 sts 48 sts 52 sts

**LEFT FRONT . . .** Starting at lower edge with White, cast on  
90 sts 96 sts 100 sts

Work in stockinette st for  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch, ending with a purl row. Knit the next 2 rows (ridge for hemline). Continue in stockinette st, decreasing 1 st at side edge on every 3rd row until there are on needle

76 sts    82 sts    86 sts

Work without decreasing for  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch. Now increase 1 st at side edge on every 5th row until there are on needle

5th row    5th row    6th row  
98 sts    104 sts    108 sts

Work without increasing until piece measures in all (excluding hem), ending at side edge,

13"    13½"    14"

**To Shape Armhole:** Next row: Bind off the first 10 sts and complete row. **Following row:** Bind off the first 10 sts (for neck) and complete row. Continue to decrease 1 st at armhole edge on every other row until there are on needle

75 sts    79 sts    82 sts

**At the Same Time**

when piece measures 1 inch from first row of armhole shaping, follow chart for pattern until top of chart is reached.

Now work with White only without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at neck edge,

5"    5½"    5"

**To Shape Neck:** Bind off 2 sts at beginning of next row and every other row 3 times. Then bind off at neck edge the first 25 sts and complete row. Now work without decreasing until piece measures from first row of armhole shaping, ending at side edge,

25 sts    25 sts    26 sts  
6½"    7"    7"

**To Shape Shoulder:** Bind off 11 sts at the beginning of the next row and every other row thereafter

8 sts    10 sts  
4 times    6 times    5 times

**RIGHT FRONT . . .** Work to correspond with Left Front, reversing shapings and making a buttonhole 3 sts in from front edge when piece measures in all (excluding hem) and every inch thereafter until 7 buttonholes in all have been made—to make a buttonhole—on one row bind off 5 sts, and on the next row cast on 5 sts to replace those bound off.

**SLEEVES . . .** Starting at cuff with White, cast on

116 sts    120 sts    126 sts

Work in stockinette st for  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch, ending with a purl row. Knit the next 2 rows (ridge for hemline). Continue in stockinette st, increasing 1 st at both ends of every 5th row until there are on needle

138 sts    142 sts    148 sts

Work without increasing until piece measures (excluding hem)

4½"    4½"    5"

**To Shape Top:** Bind off 10 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at both ends of every other row until there remain 78 sts. Decrease 1 st at both ends of every row until 32 sts remain. Bind off.

Block pieces to measurements given.

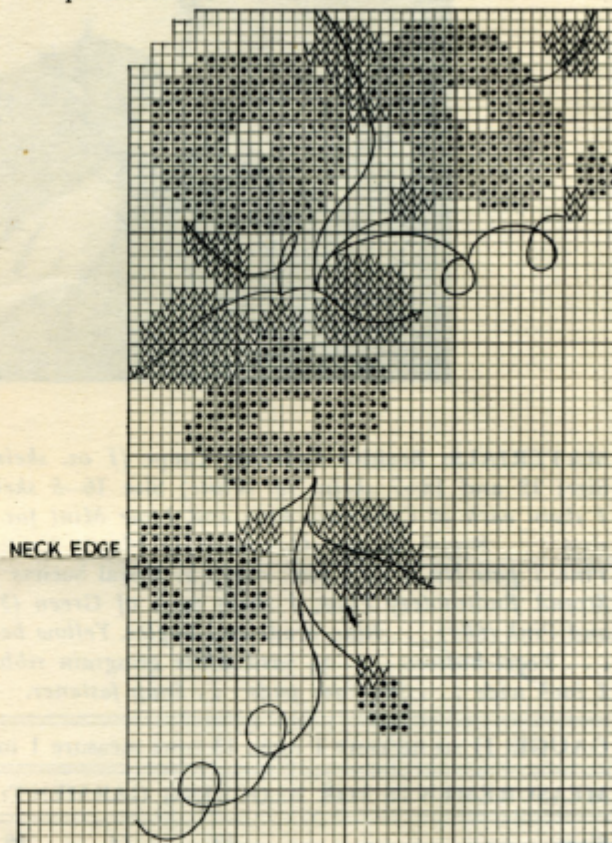
Sew up side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Turn under all hems and slip stitch in place. With crochet hook, work a row of sc along front and neck edges. Line the front edges with grosgrain, cutting buttonholes to correspond with buttonholes on garment. Overcast buttonholes. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Sew on snap fastener 1 inch up from lower edge of fronts. Sew four Yellow beads in the center of each Blue flower. Outline petals of flowers with blue beads, bugles and Pink Six Strand. Embroider stems of flowers and veins of leaves with Green Six Strand. Sew shoulder pads in place.

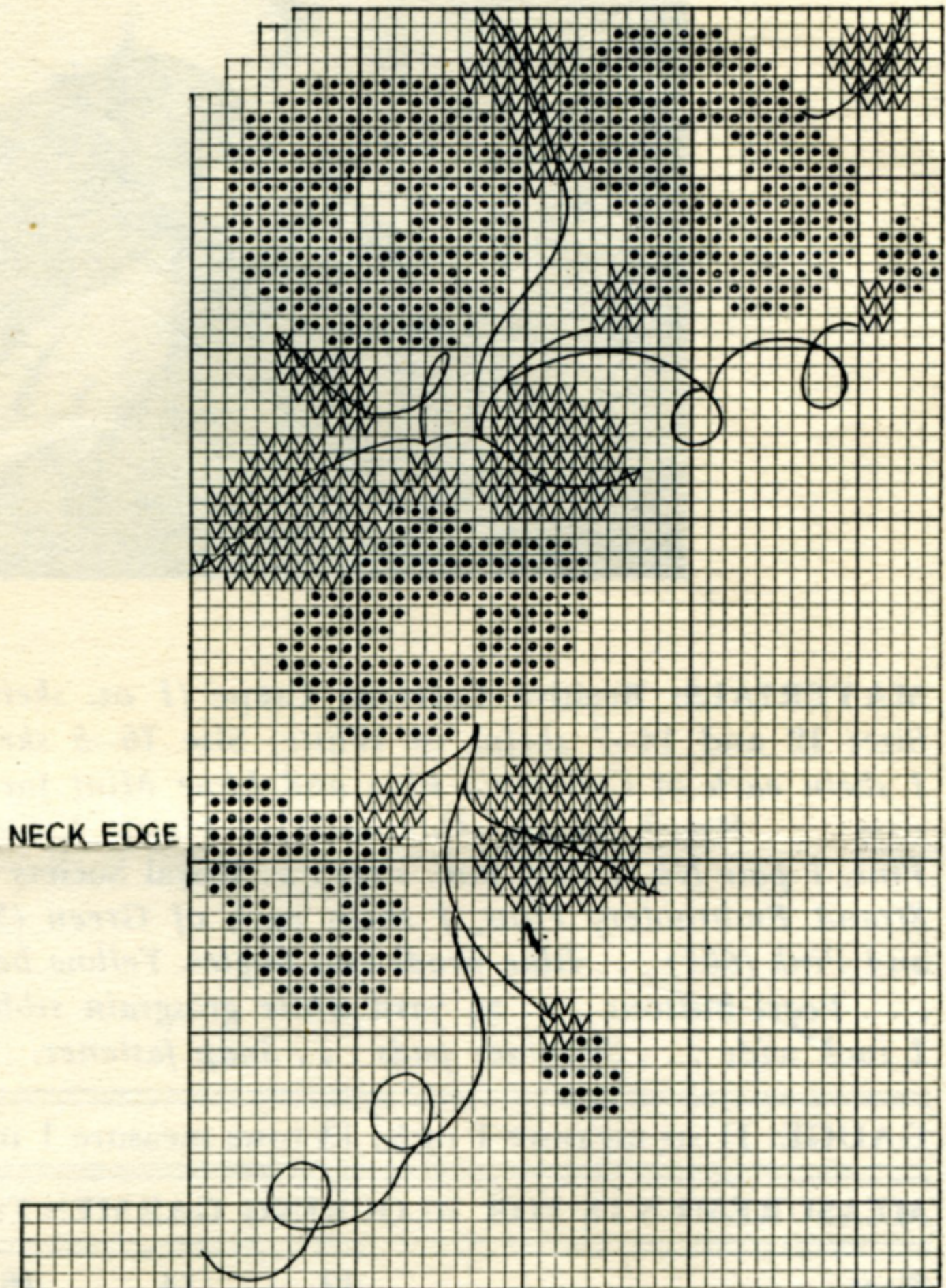
\* (asterisk) . . . Repeat the instructions following the asterisk as many more times as specified, in addition to the original.

Repeat instructions in parentheses as many times as specified. For example: "(K 1, O, p 3) 4 times" means to make whatever is in parentheses 4 times in all. Also "(work off 2 sc as 1 sc) 6 times" means to make whatever is in parentheses 6 times in all.
