GLAMOUR CARDIGAN

Directions are for size 12. Changes for sizes 14 and 16 are in parentheses.

MATERIALS:

Heavy Weight Yarn—14 oz.

Size 4 and Size 7 Circular needles

Size 5 Plastic or Aluminum crochet hook

7 Bone rings

Beads (50)

GAUGE: 5 sts=one inch 6 rows=one inch

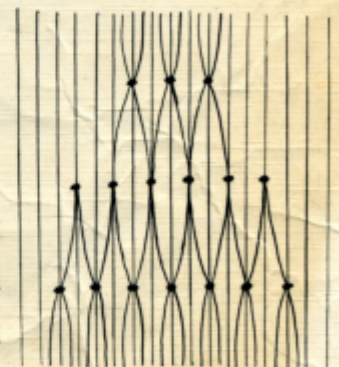
Starting at neck, using #7 needles, cast on 35 sts. P 1 K 1 P 1, K and mark next st for raglan seam, P 1 K 1 P 1, K and mark next st, P 1 K 1 across next 19 sts, K and mark next st, P 1 K 1 P 1, K and mark next st, P 1 K 1 P 1. Keep seam sts always K on right side, P on wrong side; work increased sts to conform with established K 1 P 1 ribbing. Inc for raglan as follows: pick up and work as a twisted st the thread between the seam st and the adjoining st. Inc one st each side of each seam st, and beginning and end, every other row—10 sts increased—8 times—115 sts. Work straight at front edges but continue raglan increases until 275 (283-291) sts. Next row, wrong side: P all sts removing markers. Next row: K 40 (41-42) sts for left front, place sts on holder; K next 59 (61-63) sts for left sleeve; place next 77 (79-81) sts on holder for back; place next 59 (61-63) sts on holder for right sleeve; place last 40 (41-42) sts on holder for right front. On sts of *left sleeve*, work in stockinette st; cast on 4 sts beg next 2 rows. Then dec one st beg and end of every 6th row until 45 (47-49) sts. Work even until 12 inches from underarm. Dec 5 sts evenly across last row—40 (42-44) sts. Change to #4 needles and work K 2 P 2

ribbing for 2 inches. Bind off as ribbing. Work *right sleeve* to correspond. Place sts of *left front* on needle, attach yarn at underarm edge, cast on 4 sts, place marker, cast on 4 sts, work across sts of back, cast on 4 sts, place marker, cast on 4 sts, work across sts of *right front*—173 (177-181) sts. Work in stockinette st. Dec one st each side of each marker—4 sts decreased—every 4th row 10 times—133 (137-141) sts. Work even until 9 inches from underarm. Dec 3 sts evenly across last row 130 (134-138) sts. Change to #4 needles and work in K 2 P 2 ribbing for 2 inches. Bind off as ribbing.

FRONT BORDER: Starting at lower edge of right front, and using #4 needles pick up about 266 (270-274) sts evenly spaced along fronts and neck edge. Work in K 2 P 2 ribbing for ½ inch ending at lower right front.

BUTTONHOLE ROW: Work across 6 sts, *bind off next 2 sts, work 10 sts; repeat from * 6 times more; finish row. Next row: Cast on 2 sts over the 2 bound-off sts of each buttonhole. Work ribbing for ½ inch more. Bind off as ribbing.

FINISHING: Block out ribbing pattern in yoke. Sew beads, catching ribbing in smocking design. Sew seams. Buttons: Work 12 single crochet in ring. Gather sts and turn into center of ring. Sew in place on left front. Block seams and body of sweater lightly.
