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## "Easy-Going" Bulky Knit Jacket ... C-441

Directions are given for Size 10. Changes for Sizes 12, 14 and 16 are in parentheses.

COATS & CLARK'S RED HEART "TURBO-KNIT," 2 Ply, Art. E. 274: 16 (17, 19, 21) skeins (2 oz. Folded Skeins) of No. 835 Periwinkle.

Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 8 (5 mm. size).

5 buttons.

GAUGE: Stockinette Stitch: 4 sts make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

BACK . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 69 (71, 75, 79) sts. Work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row) for 4 rows. P next 2 rows to form hemline, then continue in stockinette st until piece measures 141/2 (143/4, 15, 151/4) inches in all above hemline.

To Shape Armholes: Bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row 4 (4, 4, 5) times in all. There remain 51 (53, 55, 57) sts. Work without decreasing until piece measures 7½ (7¾, 8, 8¼) inches above first row of armhole shaping.

To Shape Shoulders: Bind off 4 (5, 5, 6) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Bind off 6 sts at beginning of next 4 rows. Slip remaining 19 (19, 21, 21) sts for back of neck on a stitch holder to be worked later.

LEFT FRONT . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 45 (46, 48, 50) sts. Work in stockinette st for 4 rows. P next 2 rows to form hemline. Next row (right side): K 39 (40, 42, 44); (p 1, k 1) 3 times (Front Border). Following row: (P 1, k 1) 3 times; p 39 (40, 42, 44). Repeat last 2 rows alternately until there are 28 rows in all above hemline. Now, work in cable pattern as follows: 1st row (right side): K 13 (13, 14, 15), p 2, k 9 (cable rib), p 2, k 13 (14, 15, 16); (p 1, k 1) 3 times. 2nd row: (P 1, k 1) 3 times; p 13 (14, 15, 16), k 2, p 9, k 2, p 13 (13, 14, 15). 3rd and 4th rows: Repeat 1st and 2nd rows. 5th row: K 13 (13, 14, 15), p 2, slip next 3 sts on a double-pointed needle and hold in front of work, k next 3 sts from left-hand needle, k 3 from doublepointed needle (half cable twist made), k 3, p 2, k 13 (14, 15, 16); (p 1, k 1) 3 times. 6th row: (P 1, k 1) 3 times, p 13 (14, 15, 16), k 2, slip next 3 sts on a double-pointed needle and hold in back of work, p next 3 sts from lefthand needle, p 3 from double-pointed needle (complete cable twist now made), p 3, k 2, p 13 (13, 14, 15). 7th to 16th rows incl: Repeat 1st and 2nd rows alternately 5 times in all. The 5th to 16th rows incl constitute the pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures 14½ (14¾, 15, 15¼) inches in all above hemline, ending at side

To Shape Armhole: At beginning of next row bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts, work across. Dec 1 st at same edge every other row 4 (4, 4, 5) times in all. There remain 36 (37, 38, 39) sts. Work without decreasing until piece measures 5 (51/4, 51/4, 51/2) inches in all above first row of armhole shaping, ending at front edge.

To Shape Neck: 1st row: Work first 12 sts and slip on a stitch holder to be worked later, work to end of row. Now, at neck edge dec 1 st on each row 5 (5, 6, 6) times, then on every other row 3 times. There remain 16 (17, 17, 18) sts. Work without decreasing until piece measures 71/2 (73/4. 8, 81/4) inches above first row of armhole shaping, ending at armhole edge.

To Shape Shoulder: At beginning of next row, bind off 4 (5, 5, 6) sts, then at same edge 6 sts every other row twice. With pins, mark the position of 5 buttons on front border, having first pinmark 5 inches above hemline and fifth pinmark 1/2 inch below neck edge.

RIGHT FRONT . . . Work exactly as for Left Front until hemline has been made. Next row (right side): (K 1, p 1) 3 times (Front Border), k 39 (40, 42, 44). Following row: P 39, (40, 42, 44); (k 1, p 1) 3 times. Repeat last 2 rows alternately until there are 24 rows in all above hemline, ending at front edge. 25th row: Work 2 sts, bind off 2 sts (buttonhole), work to end of row. 26th row: Work across, casting on 2 sts over the 2 sts bound off. 27th and 28th rows: Repeat 1st and 2nd rows. Next row (right side): (K 1, p 1) 3 times, k 13 (14, 15, 16), p 2, k 9 (cable rib), p 2, k 13 (13, 14, 15). Following row: P 13 (13, 14, 15), k 2, p 9, k 2, p 13 (14, 15, 16); (k 1, p 1) 3 times. Now, working in pattern as established, complete Right Front to correspond to Left Front, reversing shapings and at the same time making a buttonhole as before opposite each of the remaining 4 pinmarks.

SLEEVES . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 29 (29, 31, 31) sts. 1st row: K 1, \* p 1, k 1. Repeat from \* across. 2nd row: P 1, \* k 1, p 1. Repeat from \* across. Repeat last 2 rows alternately until piece measures 3 inches in all, ending with 2nd row. Now, work in stockinette st, increasing 1 st at both ends of next row, then on one row every 1 inch thereafter 10 (11, 11, 12) times more. There are 51 (53, 55, 57) sts on needle. Work without increasing until piece measures 15¾ (16¼, 16¾, 17¼) inches in all.

To Shape Top: Bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row until piece measures 4½ (4¾, 5, 5¼) inches in all above first row of top shaping. Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

POCKET (Make 2) . . . Starting at lower edge, cast on 24 sts. Work in stockinette st for 31/2 inches, increasing 3 sts evenly spaced across last row. Now work in ribbing as before for 1 inch. Bind off in ribbing.

Block to measurements. Sew shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew pockets in place. Turn under hem and sew in place.

COLLAR . . . With right side facing, attach yarn and work across sts on Right Front stitch holder; pick up and k 12 (13, 14, 15) sts along front neck edge; k 19 (19, 21, 21) sts from Back stitch holder; pick up and k 12 (13, 14, 15) sts along Left Front neck edge to within stitch holder; work across sts on stitch holder. There are 67 (69, 73, 75) sts on needle. Now work in ribbing as before until Collar measures 4 inches in all. Bind off loosely in

With right side facing, sl st along each front edge. Buttonhole st around buttonholes. Sew on buttons.
