

## Holiday Jacket Free Vintage Pattern



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# "Holiday" Casual Jacket . . . C-440

Directions are given for Size 10. Changes for Sizes 12, 14 and 16 are in parentheses.

**COATS & CLARK'S RED HEART SUPER FINGERING, 3 Ply, Art. E. 239:** 16 (17, 19, 20) skeins (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins) of No. 912 Geranium.

Knitting Pins, 1 pair each No. 0 (2 mm. size), No. 1 (2½ mm. size) and No. 2 (2¾ mm. size).  
6 brass buttons.

**GAUGE: Pattern Stitch—On Size 2 knitting pins—**9 sts make 1 inch; 16 rows make 1 inch.  
**On Size 1 knitting pins—**19 sts make 2 inches.  
**On Size 0 knitting pins—**10 sts make 1 inch.

**BACK . . .** Starting at lower edge with No. 2 knitting pins, cast on 124 (128, 135, 141) sts. Work in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row) for 1 inch, ending with a k row. **Next row:** Increasing 15 (15, 16, 18) sts evenly spaced, k across to form hemline. There are 139 (143, 151, 159) sts on needle. Now, work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** K 3, \* holding yarn in back of work, sl 1 st as if to p, k 3. Repeat from \* across. **2nd row:** K 3, \* holding yarn in front of work, sl 1, k 3. Repeat from \* across. **3rd row:** K 1, \* holding yarn in back of work, sl 1, k 3. Repeat from \* across, ending with sl 1, k 1. **4th row:** K 1, \* holding yarn in front of work,

sl 1, k 3. Repeat from \* across, ending with sl 1, k 1. The 1st to 4th rows incl constitute the pattern.

Making first 3½ inches with No. 2 knitting pins, next 1¾ inches with No. 1 knitting pins and last ¾ inch with No. 0 knitting pins, work in pattern until piece measures 6 inches in all above hemline. Place a marker in work to indicate waistline, then continue in pattern with No. 0 knitting pins for ¾ inch more. Now, change to No. 1 knitting pins and, being careful to keep in pattern, inc 1 st at both ends of one row every ¾ inch twice. Change to No. 2 knitting pins and continue to inc 1 st at both ends of one row every ¾ inch 4 (4, 5, 5) times more. There are 151 (155, 165, 173) sts on needle. Work without increasing until piece measures 12½ (12¾, 13, 13¼) inches in all above hemline.

**To Shape Armholes:** Bind off 7 (7, 8, 9) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row 8 (8, 9, 10) times. There remain 121 (125, 131, 135) sts. Work without decreasing until piece measures 8 (8¼, 8½, 8¾) inches above first row of armhole shaping, ending with a right side row.

**To Shape Shoulders and Neck:** Work first 49 (50, 53, 55) sts and slip on a stitch holder to be worked later; bind off center 23 (25, 25, 25) sts, place a marker in the center bound-off st to indicate center back; work to end of row. There are 49 (50, 53, 55) sts on needle for right side of back. Now, at armhole edge bind off 7 (8, 5, 6) sts once, then 6 (6, 7, 7) sts every other row 5 times, at the same time, at neck edge, bind off 4 (4, 5, 6) sts once, then 3 sts every other row twice, then dec 1 st every other row twice. With right side facing, slip sts from stitch holder onto No. 2 knitting pins, attach yarn at neck edge and complete left side to correspond to right side, reversing shapings.

**LEFT FRONT (including facing) . . .** Starting at lower edge with No. 2 knitting pins, cast on 66 (70, 73, 77) sts. Work in stockinette st for 1 inch, ending with a k row. Cast on 81 sts at end of last row. **Next row:** K 81; now increasing 9 (9, 10, 10) sts evenly spaced,

k across to form hemline. There are 156 (160, 164, 168) sts on needle. Now, work in pattern as follows: **1st row:** Work exactly as for 1st row of pattern on Back to within last 41 sts; holding yarn in back of work, sl 2 (turning line); k 3, sl 1, continue in pattern to end of row (39 sts for front facing). **2nd row:** Work exactly as for 2nd row of pattern on Back across first 39 sts; p 2; k 3, sl 1, continue in pattern to end of row. **3rd row:** Work exactly as for 3rd row of pattern on Back to within last 41 sts; sl 2; k 1, sl 1, k 3, continue in pattern to end of row. **4th row:** Work exactly as for 4th row of pattern on Back across first 39 sts; p 2; k 1, sl 1, k 3, continue in pattern to end of row. The 1st to 4th rows incl constitute the pattern. Making first 3½ inches with No. 2 knitting pins, next 1¾ inches with No. 1 knitting pins and last ¾ inch with No. 0 knitting pins, work in pattern until piece measures 6 inches in all above hemline. Place a marker in work to indicate waistline, then continue with No. 0 knitting pins for ¾ inch more.

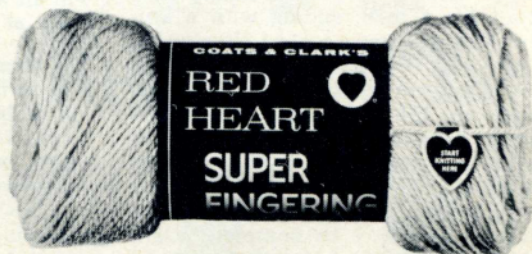
**To Shape Side and Front Edges:** Change to No. 1 knitting pins and work in pattern, increasing 1 st at side edge every ¾ inch twice, at the same time, inc 1 st each side of turning line (front edge) every 1½ inches once. Change to No. 2 knitting pins and continue at side edge to inc 1 st every ¾ inch 4 (4, 5, 5) times more, at the same time, inc 1 st each side of turning line every 2¼ inches twice. There are 168 (172, 177, 181) sts on needle. Work without increasing until piece measures 12½ (12¾, 13, 13¼) inches in all above hemline, ending with same row of pattern as on Back at underarm.

**To Shape Shawl Collar and Armhole:** Dec 1 st each side of turning line every ¾ inch 3 times in all, at the same time, at side edge bind off 13 (14, 15, 16) sts once, then dec 1 st every other row 8 (8, 9, 10) times. There are 141 (144, 147, 149) sts on needle. Now, inc 1 st at outer edge of facing and dec 1 st each side of turning line on one row every ¾ inch once, then every ½ inch once, then every ¼ inch 5 times, then every 3rd row until 117 (118, 120, 121) sts remain. If necessary, work without increasing or decreasing until piece measures 8 (8¼, 8½, 8¾) inches above first row of armhole shaping, ending at armhole edge.

**To Shape Shoulder and Remainder of Collar:** At armhole edge, bind off 7 (8, 5, 6) sts once, then 6 (6, 7, 7) sts every other row 5 times, at the same time continue to inc 1 st at facing edge and

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dec 1 st each side of turning line on one row every 3rd row 4 times more. There remain 76 sts. Now, inc 1 st at both edges and dec 1 st each side of turning line on one row every 3rd row until, matching shoulder seams, collar reaches to center back marker on Back, ending with a right side row. Now, continue to dec 1 st each side of turning line every 3rd row 5 times more, and **at the same time** bind off 4 sts at beginning of next 7 rows, then 3 sts at beginning of next 10 rows. Bind off remaining 8 sts.

With pins mark the position of 3 buttons, having first pinmark 3 inches above lower edge and 3rd pinmark 11¼ (11½, 11¾, 12) inches above lower edge.

**RIGHT FRONT** . . . Work as for Left Front for 1 inch, ending with a knit row. **Next row (wrong side):** Increasing 9 (9, 10, 10) sts evenly spaced, k across to form hemline. Cast on 81 sts. There are 156 (160, 164, 168) sts on needle. **Following row:** Work in pattern as for Back across first 39 sts (front facing); sl 2 for turning line; continue in pattern to end of row. Now, continue in this way to complete Right Front to correspond to Left Front, re-

versing shapings and making a set of buttonholes opposite pinmarks as follows: On a right side row, work to within 17 sts of turning line, bind off next 9 sts; work across until there are 8 sts beyond turning line on right-hand needle; bind off 9 sts, work to end of row. On following row, cast on 9 sts over each group of bound-off sts.

**SLEEVES** . . . Starting at lower edge with No. 2 knitting pins, cast on 64 (64, 68, 68) sts. Work in stockinette st for 1 inch, ending with a k row. **Next row:** Increasing 7 sts evenly spaced, k across to form hemline. There are 71 (71, 75, 75) sts on needle. Now, working in pattern as for Back, inc 1 st at both ends of one row every 1½ inches once, then every ¾ inch 6 (6, 4, 2) times, then every ½ inch until there are 119 (123, 129, 133) sts on needle. Work without increasing until piece measures 15½ (16, 16½, 17) inches in all above hemline, **ending with same row of pattern as on Back at underarm.**

**To Shape Top:** Bind off 10 (10, 11, 12) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row 14 (16, 16, 16) times. Now, dec 1 st at both ends of one row every 4th row until piece measures 5 (5¼, 5½, 5¾) inches in all above first row of top shaping. Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 6 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

Block to measurements. Place a marker ½ inch in from side edge at underarm of each front. Sew shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves, matching sleeve seams and underarm markers. If desired, line facing with pre-shrunk muslin or pelon. Turn under hems on sleeves and lower edge and sew in place. Sew center back seam of collar and facing. Turn facing to wrong side along turning line and sew in place. Buttonhole stitch around buttonholes. Sew buttons in place as illustrated.
