Bee Appliques Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: Size 10 Crochet Thread in Black, White and Gold, size 7 crochet hook and craft glue.

SIZE: 3\4" long and 1\2" wide.

PLEASE NOTE: You will work threads behind sts as you crochet.

BODY:

<u>RND 1:</u> With Black and 7 hook ch-6, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc next 2 ch, 3 hdc last ch, turn piece so you are now working across the bottom of the foundation ch (bottom of sts just made) hdc next 2, 2 hdc last, join Gold, drop Black, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

RND 2: 2 hdc next 2 sts, pick up Black, hdc next 2 sts, pick up Gold, 2 hdc next 3 sts, pick up Black, hdc next 2 sts, pick up Gold, 2 hdc last st, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (16 sts)

<u>RND 3:</u> Hdc next 2 sts, pick up Black, hdc next 2 sts, pick up Gold, hdc next 6 sts, pick up Black, hdc next 2 sts, fasten off Black, pick up Gold, hdc last 4 sts, sl st top beg hdc, fasten off.

WINGS (MAKE TWO):

<u>RND 1:</u> With White and 7 hook ch-5, hdc 3rd ch from hook, hdc next ch, 3 hdc last ch, turn piece so you are now working across the bottom of the foundation ch (in bottom of sts just made), hdc next, 2 hdc last, sl st top beg hdc, fasten off. (8 sts)

Glue wings to bee.

Ch = Chain
St = Stitch
Sl St = Slip Stitch
Hdc = Half Double Crochet
Rnd = Round
Beg = Beginning
Rep = Repeat
Bet = Between
Dec = Decrease
Ea = Each
Tog = Together
