## Pearl Beaded Wrap With Pearl Pin <br> Free Crochet Pattern



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MATERIALS: 1 skein Berant Baby Coordinates yarn in white, 1 pkg 375 count 8 mm pearl beads, needle to take yarn and beads, 1 large snap and H hook or hook to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: $\mathrm{Sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}=1 ", 4$ rows pattern $=1-1 \backslash 2 "$
FINISHED SIZE: 11-3\4" X 42"
Please note: I found it easier to string about fifty beads at a time onto the yarn, work the pattern until all the beads are gone, fasten off, re-string more beads, join where I left off.

## WRAP:

With needle on yarn, string pearls, remove needle.
ROW 1: With white yarn and $H$ hook ch-26, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, (sk $2 \mathrm{ch}, 5$ dc next ch, sk 2 ch , sc next ch) 4 times, turn.
ROW 2: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, (slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, 5 dc next sc), sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, 5 dc next sc, rep bet (), sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, 3 dc last st, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, 5 dc next sc, sc next dc, sk next st, 5 dc next dc, sc next dc, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}$ ) across ending with sc last st, turn.
ROW 4: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, (sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc, slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc) twice, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 3$ dc last st, ch-1, turn.
ROW 5: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) 3 times, 5 dc next sc, sc next dc, sk next dc, 5 dc next dc, sc next dc, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn.
ROW 6: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, (sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5$ dc next sc, slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc) 3 times ending with 3 dc last sc, ch-1, turn.
ROW 7: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, 5 dc next sc, * sc next dc, sk next dc, 5 dc next dc, sc next dc, * ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) 3 times, 5 dc next sc, rep bet ${ }^{* *}$, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn.
ROW 8: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, (sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc, slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc) across ending with 3 dc last sc, ch-1, turn.
ROW 9: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) across ending with sc last st, turn.
ROW 10: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch- 3 , (slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, 5 dc next sc) across ending with 3 dc last sc, ch-1, turn.

ROW 11: Rep row 9. ROW 23: Rep row 9.

ROW 95: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, sk next sc, sk next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ dc next dc, sk next 3 dc, sk next sc, sk next dc, sc next dc, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $\left.3^{\mathrm{rd}} \mathrm{dc}\right) 5$ times, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn.

ROW 96: Rep row 8.
ROW 97: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) 4 times, sk next 2 dc , sk next sc, sk next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next dc, sk next 2 dc , sk next sc, sk next dc, sc next dc, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, ch-1, turn.

ROW 98: Rep row 10.
ROW 99: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc, sk next 2 dc, sk next sc, sk next dc, 5 dc next dc, sk next 3 dc, sk next sc, sc next dc, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) twice, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn.

ROW 100: Rep row 10.
ROW 101: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) twice, sk next 2 dc, sk next sc, sk next dc, 5 dc next dc, sk next 3 dc, sk next sc, sk next dc, sc next dc, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn.

ROW 102: Ch-3, work 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}$, ( 5 dc next sc, slide bead, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) twice, 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 3$ dc last st, ch-1, turn.

RND 103 (EDGING): Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 5 dc next sc, sc $3^{\text {rd }}$ dc) 3 times, 5 dc next sc, sc last st, turn piece so you are now working across one long side, * 5 dc in side of dc(row), sc in side of next dc(row), * rep bet ** across side, turn to work bottom foundation ch row 1 , (sc in bottom of $5 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in bottom of next sc) across short side ending with sc, turn piece and work bet $* *$ across last long side ending with 5 dc last dc(row), sl st top beg sc, turn.

RND 104: Ch-3, work 2 dc same st as beg ch-3, (sc $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ next sc) around ending with 2 dc in same st as beg ch-3, sl st top beg ch-3, fasten off.

To make wrap larger add additional rep of pattern: Row $9 \backslash$ Row $8 \backslash$ Row $9 \backslash$ Row 10 making sure to end on a beaded row then pick up at row 95 and finish piece. To make wrap smaller remove one or more rep of pattern, then pick up at row 95 and finish piece.

## DECORATIVE MOTIF:

String 120 pearl beads onto white yarn, remover needle.
With white yarn and H hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.
RND 1: Ch-1, (sc, slide bead, sc in ring) 5 times, sl st top beg sc, turn. (10 sts)
RND 2: (Slide 5 beads, sl st next 2 sts) around, turn. ( 5 lps )
RND 3: Press beaded lps to bk of work, ch-1, (2 sc next st, sc next st) around, sl st top beg sc, turn. (15 sts)
RND 4: sl st next st, (slide 5 beads, sl st next 2 sts) around, turn. (7 lps)
RND 5: Press beaded lps to bk of work, ch-1, sc next sc, (2 sc next st, sc next st) around, sl st top beg sc, turn. (22sts)

RND 6: (slide 5 beads, sl st next 2 sts ) around, turn. ( 11 lps )
RND 7: Press lps to bk of work, sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.
Sew motif to center front of wrap. Sew snap to close wrap.
