Kippah In Solomon's Knot Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS: 2-3 oz baby weight yarn any color and size J crochet hook.

FINISHED SIZE: Will fit most adults

KIPPAH:

With yarn and J hook ch-3, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-3, work 11 dc in ring, sl st top beg ch-3, turn. (12 sts)

RND 2: Ch-3, 2 dc ea st around, sl st top beg ch-3, turn. (24 sts)

RND 3-4: Ch-3, (2 dc next st, dc next st) around, sl st top beg ch-3, turn. (36 sts)(54 sts)

RND 5: Ch-3, dc ea st around, sl st top beg ch-3, turn.

<u>RND 6:</u> * Solomon knot, sk next 2 sts, sc next st * rep bet ** to last 8 sts; (Solomon knot, sk next 3 sts, sc next st) twice, turn.

<u>RND 7:</u> Make 2 Solomon knots that are 2 sts(sc) long, sc next sc on knot previous row, * 2 knots, sk next 2 sc groups, sc in 1st sc of next 2 sc groups previous row * rep bet ** around, turn.

RND 8: Make 2 knots, sc 1st sc of next sc group, * 2 knots, sc in sc bet next 2 knots * rep bet ** around, turn.

RND 9: Ch-4, sc 1st sc, (ch-4, sc next sc) around, ending with sl st top beg sc, turn.

RND 10: Ch-1, hdc ea st work 3 hdc in ea ch-4 lp around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. (70 sts)

RND 11-12: Hdc ea st around, sl st top beg hdc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 12 fasten off.

Great plain or add beading along rnd 12 or add beads bet knots.

Ch = Chain
St = Stitch
Sl St = Slip Stitch
Sc = Single Crochet
Hdc = Half Double Crochet
Dc = Double Crochet
Lp = Loop
Rnd = Round

Beg = Beginning Rep = Repeat

Bet = Between

Sk = Skip

Dec = Decrease

Ea = Each

Tog = Together
