

No. 112

MATERIALS: 4 tubes of Mogor Gimp, Cotton Stuffing.

Needle: No. 3 Steel Crochet Hook.

Gauge: 7 stitches equal 1 inch. Crown: Chain 5, join with slip st. 1st row: ch. 4, 8 d.c. in ring with 1 ch. between each st.

2nd row: 2 d.c. in each space of previous row with ch. between each st.

3rd row: Increase 1 d.c. in every second space (chain between stitches).

Increase 10 times on each row until circle measures 6 inches in diameter, next row 1 d.c. in each space with ch. 1 between d.c., fasten off.

Brim: Ch. 38-join with slip st. to form a ring.

1st row: 1 s.c. in each ch. st. 2nd, 3rd row: 1 s.c. in each s.c.

4th row: 1 s.c. in each of the next 12 s.c. of previous row. 1 d.c. in each of the next 26 s.c. of previous row. (These 4 rows form the pattern of the brim.) Continue working this pattern until outside brim measures 261/2 inches.

Fill brim solid with cotton and join by sewing both ends to each other and attach to crown.

Hair Band: Chain 10, 1 d.c. in 3 st. from hook, and 1 d.c. in each chain, chain 3, turn, work strip for 131/2 inches, and fasten ends 4 inches from center back on each side.

No. 112 - Envelope Bag

MATERIALS: 6 tubes Mogor Gimp, Silk Lining, Clip.

Gauge: 4 patterns equal one inch. Needle: No. 4 Steel Hook.

Start front edge beneath flap, chain 70.

1st row: s.c. in 3rd chain, d.c. in same st., * skip 1 ch. s.c. and d.c. in next ch. Repeat from * to end of row, making 34 patterns, ch. 1, turn.

2nd row: * Skip next st., s.c. and d.c. in next st. * and repeat from * across, chain 1, turn. Repeat this until 7 rows of patterns are made.

8th row: Increase one pattern on each side (work a pattern st. in 1st st. usually skipped and repeat at end of

9th-17th rows: Same as 2nd row.

18th row: Same as 8th row.

Work this way until work measures 63/4 inches and mark with thread for center bottom.

Now work back of bag for 63/4 inches, decreasing in corresponding places.

Flap:

1st row: Decrease one pattern on each side, and decrease one pattern on every 7th row (4 times in all) and work until flap measures 41/2 inches. Finish with s.c. around flap of bag.

Chain 9 and work pattern for 61/2 inches (make 2).

Back Strap: Ch. 7 and work in pattern until piece measures 51/2 inches.

Sew in Gussets at sides and attach strap to back of bag. Finish with clip or any desired trimming.
